
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 5.7% since 2019, growing by 4,400. Population is expected to increase by 6.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 5,207.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 14.8% in Anderson County, TN from 43,314 to 49,728. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 10.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.3% to 53.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.8% of Anderson County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.8% below the national average), and **10.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Other Fabricated Metal Product Manufacturing, Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.















#### **Job Trends**






Anderson County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 3.95%, decreasing from 6.90% 5 years before.







#### **Millennials**

Anderson County, TN has 5,693 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3.969.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Anderson County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 24,221 people 55 or older, while there are 27,098 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Anderson County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 33,415 racially diverse people, while there are 10,042 here.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**












