
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 7.6% since 2019, growing by 10,198. Population is expected to increase by 6.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 9,014.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 10.5% in Blount County, TN from 57,629 to 63,674. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 6.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.5% to 58.5% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.6% of Blount County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.9% below the national average), and **8.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (the same as the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.















### **Job Trends**






Blount County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 3.55%, decreasing from 6.31% 5 years before.

Blount County, TN has 25,438 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 28,742.






#### **Veterans**

Blount County, TN has 9,515 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 6,998.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Blount County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 42,702 people 55 or older, while there are 50,999 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Blount County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 58,912 racially diverse people, while there are 15,096 here.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**












### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




