
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 3.2% since 2019, growing by 1,011. Population is expected to increase by 3.0% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,003.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 2.4% in Claiborne County, TN from 10,440 to 10,191. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 6.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 51.4% to 47.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, 9.9% of Claiborne County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (11.6% below the national average), and 9.1% hold an Associate's Degree (0.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Household and Institutional Furniture and Kitchen Cabinet Manufacturing, and Colleges, Universities, and Professional Schools.






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Claiborne County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 5.01%, decreasing from 7.34% 5 years before.




Millennials

Claiborne County, TN has 6,052 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,635.




Veterans

Claiborne County, TN has 1,652 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,615.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Claiborne County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 9,857 people 55 or older, while there are 11,318 here.




Violent Crime

Claiborne County, TN has 6.68 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.02 per 1,000 people.












Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings









Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 1,413 graduates in Claiborne County, TN. This pipeline has shrunk by 2% over the last 5 years.
