- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.0% since 2018, growing by 70,665. Population is expected to increase by 6.6% between 2023 and 2028, adding 81,573.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 8.4% in 15 County from 540,565 to 586,090. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 3.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 57.9% to 57.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.3% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.8% below the national average), and **8.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Gender


















Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






