
Median household income is \$13.6K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 4.1% since 2018, growing by 3,148. Population is expected to increase by 2.9% between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,318.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 12.8% in Anderson County, TN from 42,837 to 48,327. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 9.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 56.5% to 56.5% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.3% of Anderson County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.8% below the national average), and **9.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Other Fabricated Metal Product Manufacturing, Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.













### **Population Trends**



### **Job Trends**






Anderson County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.38%, decreasing from 3.75% 5 years before.

Anderson County, TN has 14,847 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 16,046.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Anderson County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 32,452 racially diverse people, while there are 9,261 here.




#### **Veterans**

Anderson County, TN has 3.93 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**












