- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **increased by 9.8%** in Anderson County, TN from 41,648 to **45,744**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 2.4% by 7.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 54.9% to 55.8% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.3% of Anderson County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.5% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Other Fabricated Metal Product Manufacturing, Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

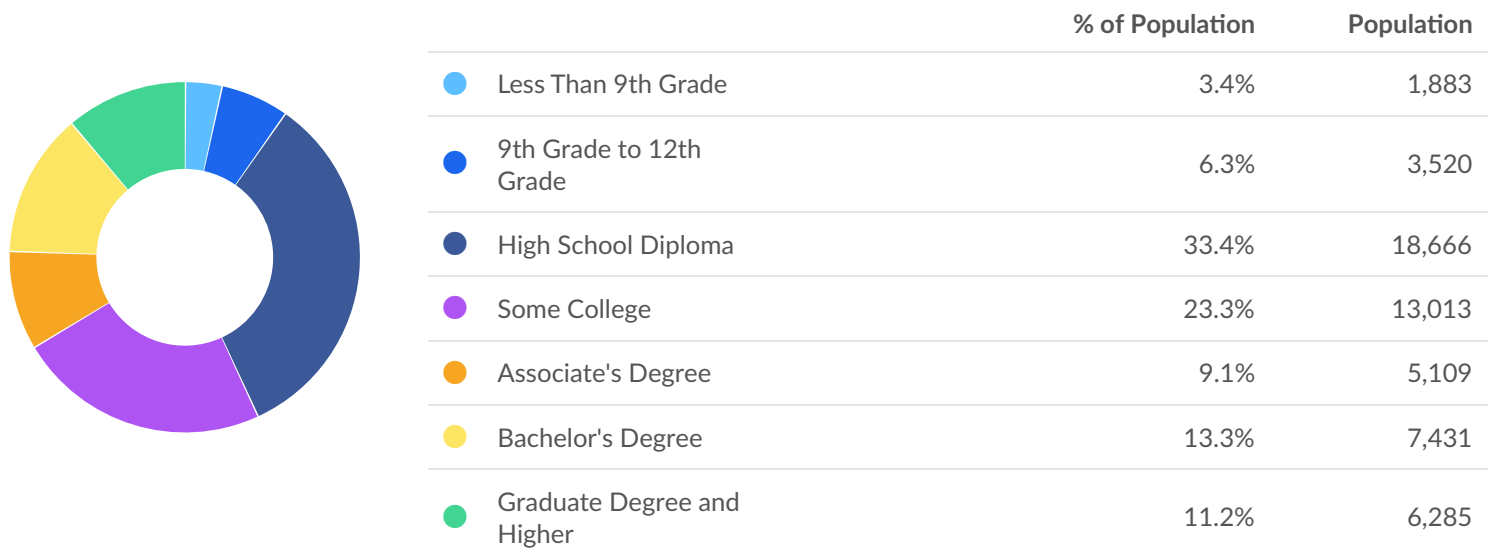

Dec 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



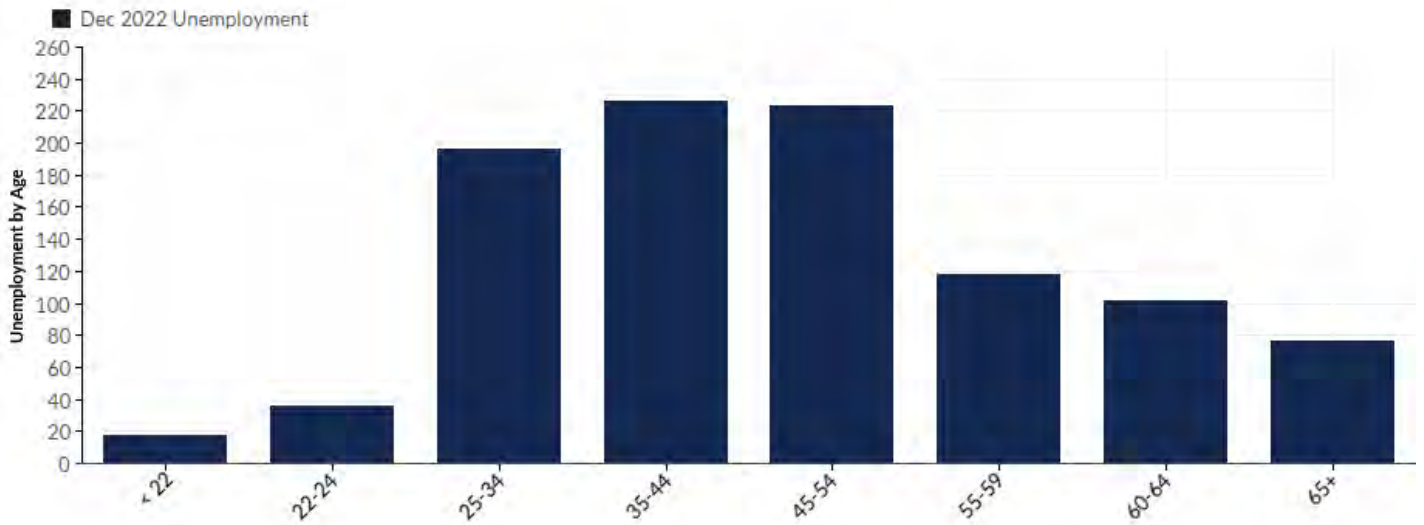
Educational Attainment

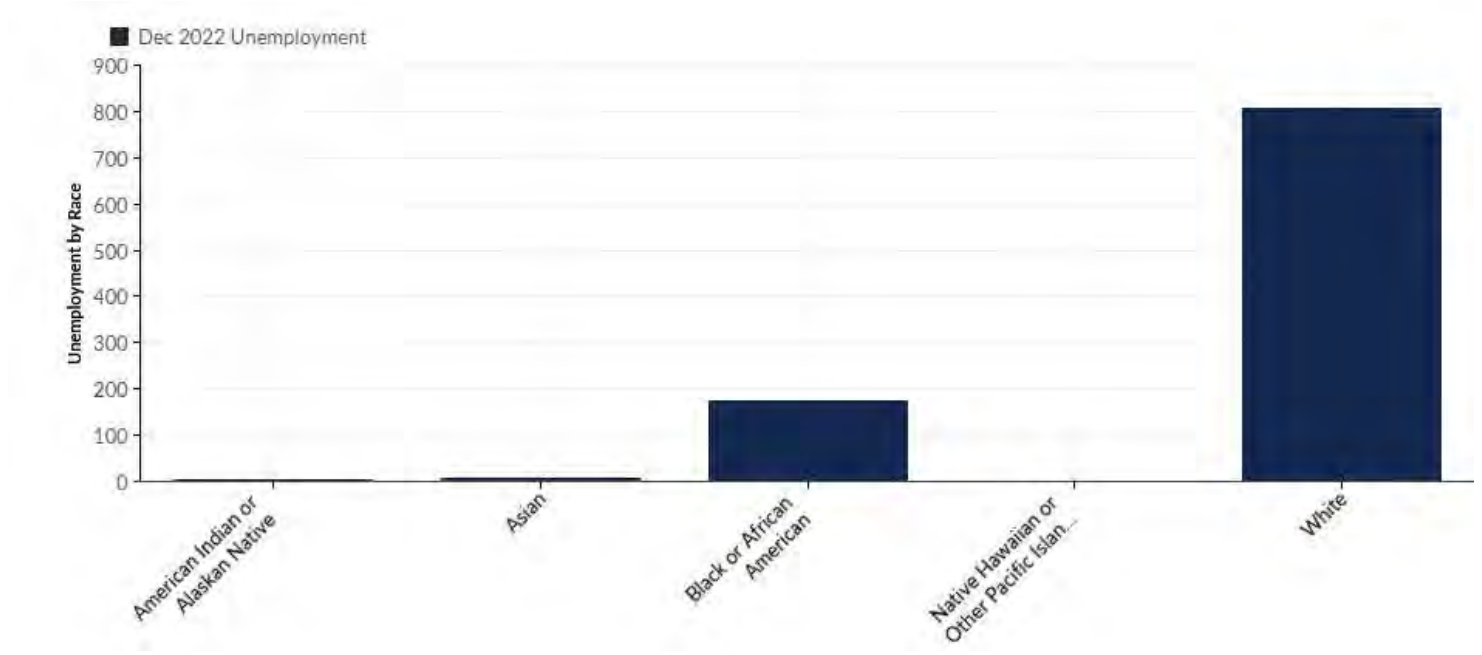

Unemployment by Gender



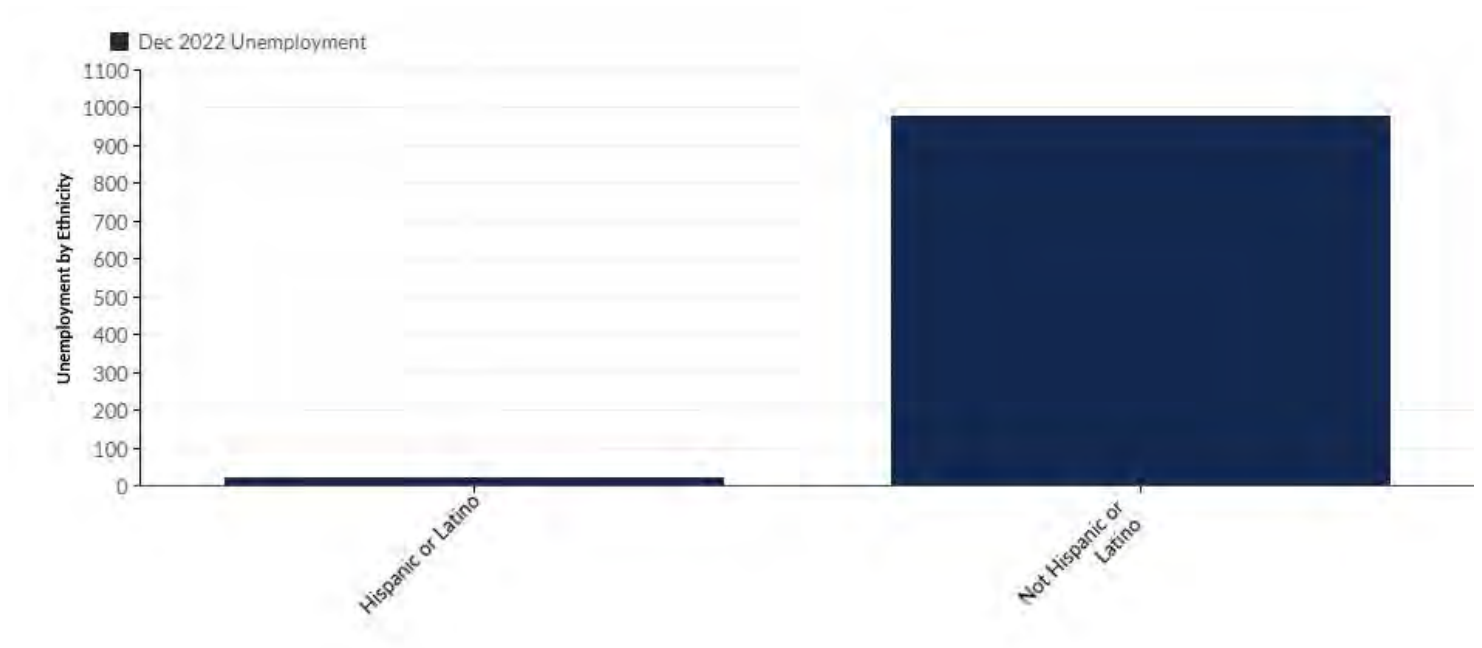

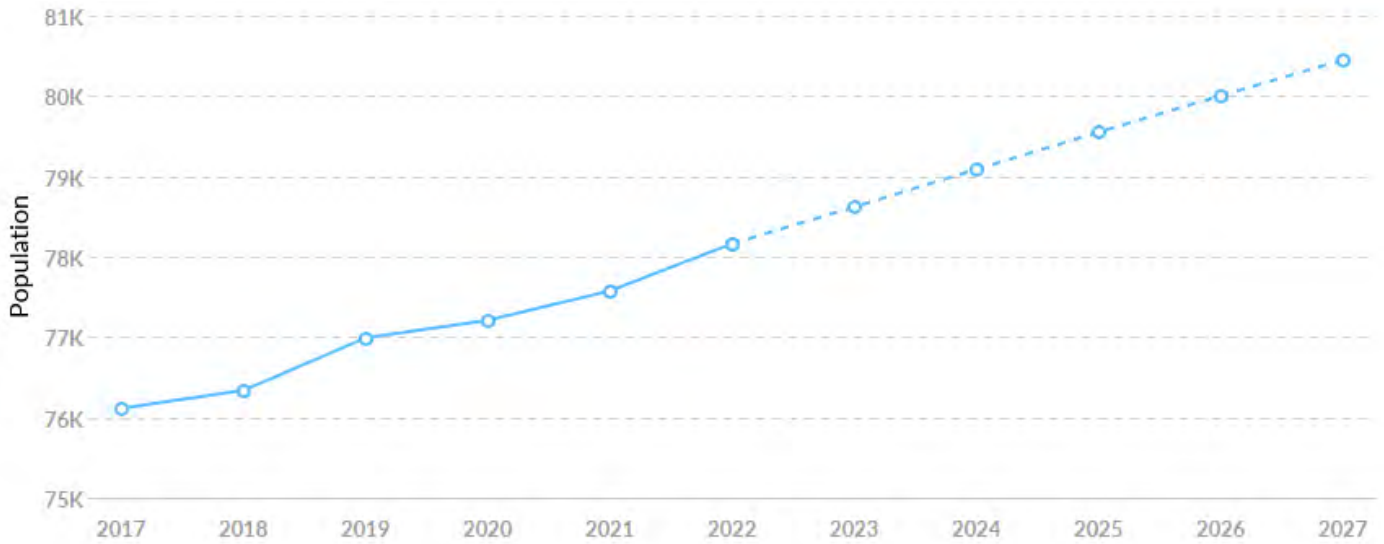

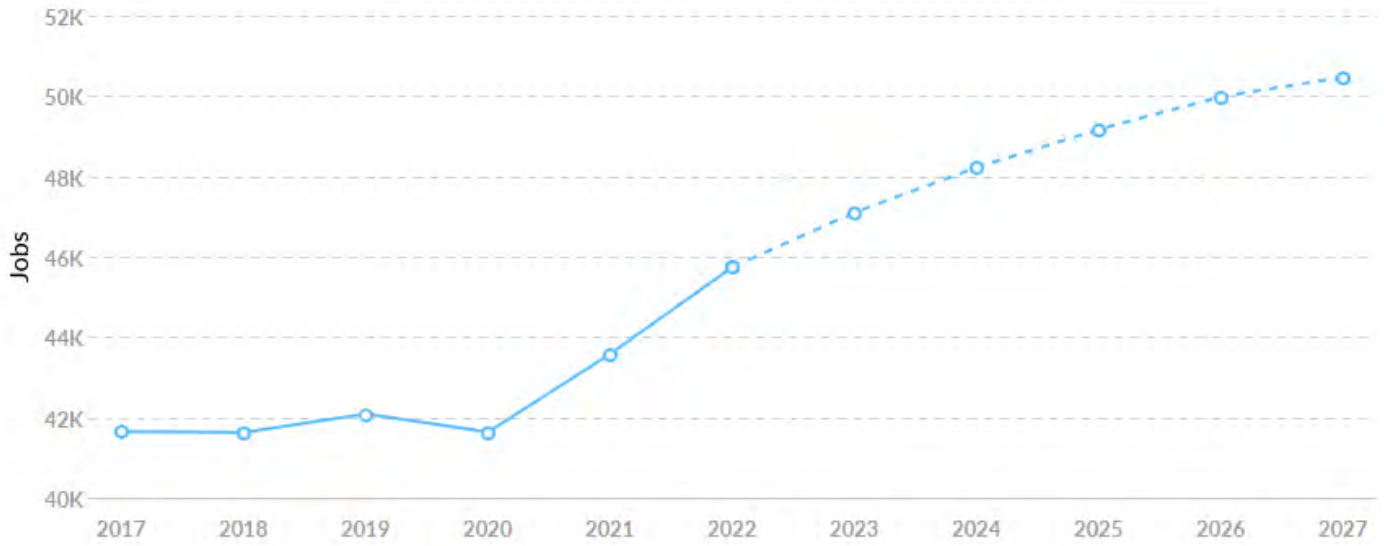

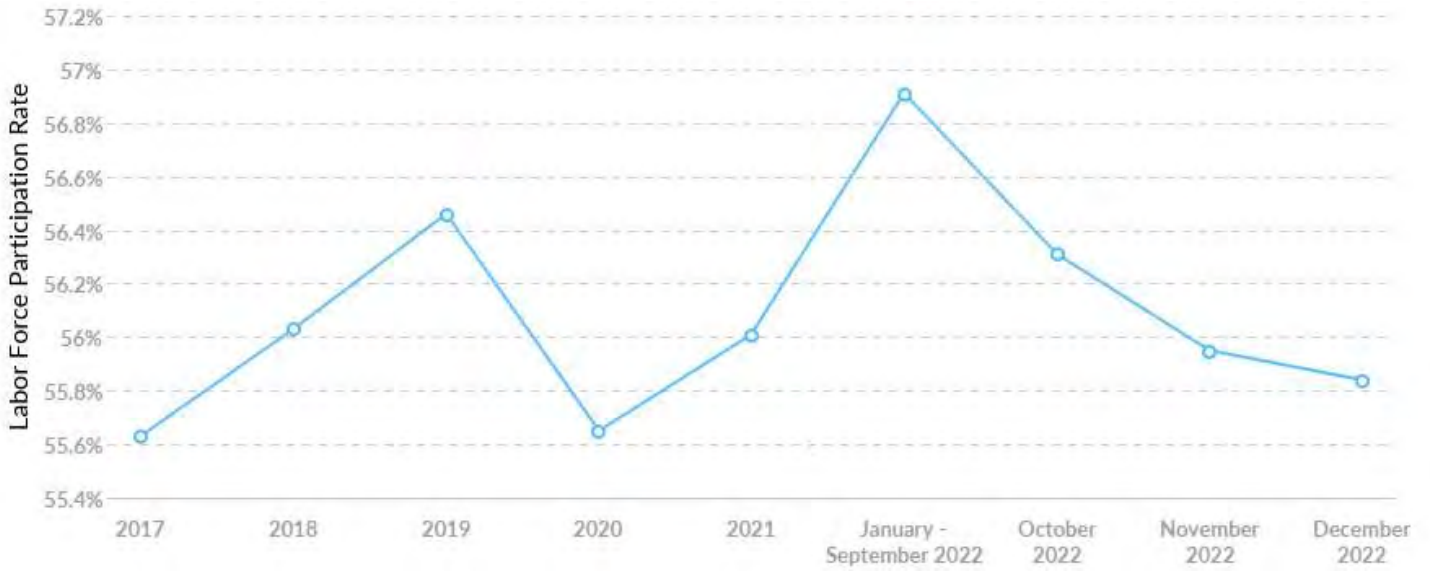
Job Trends

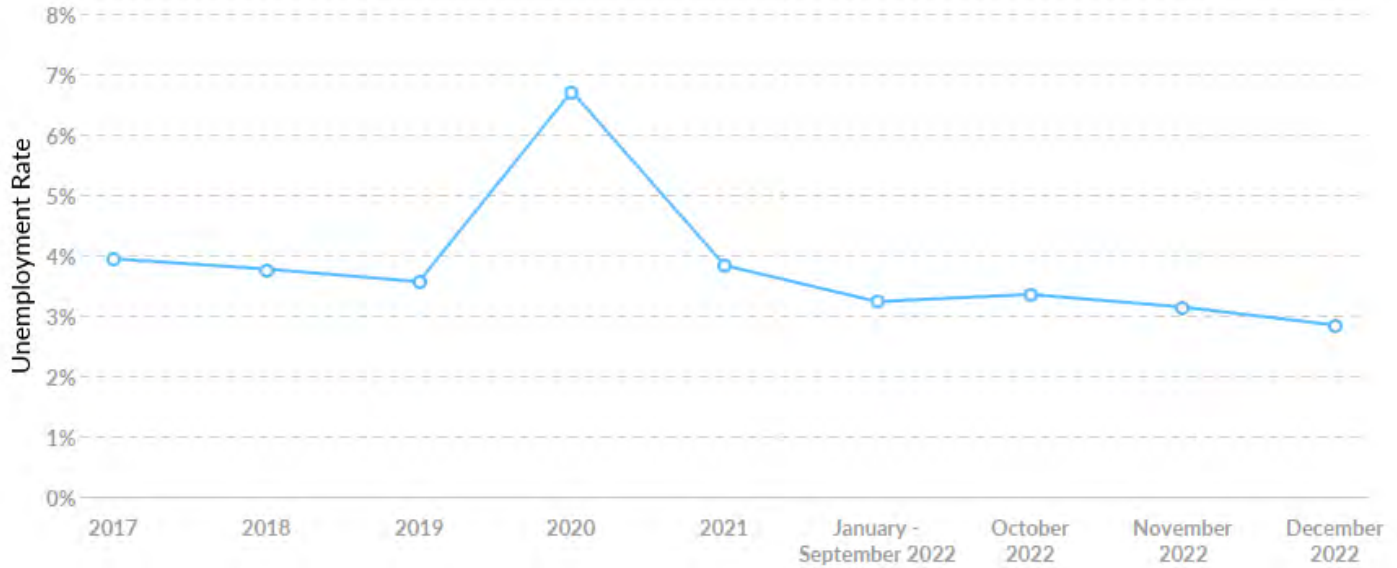

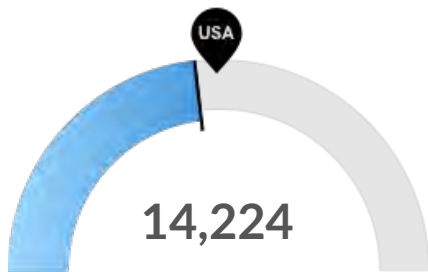

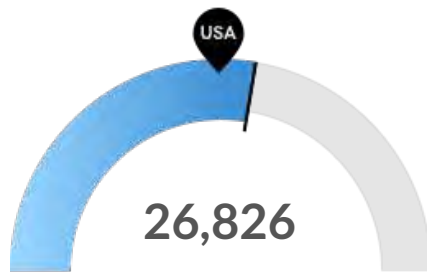

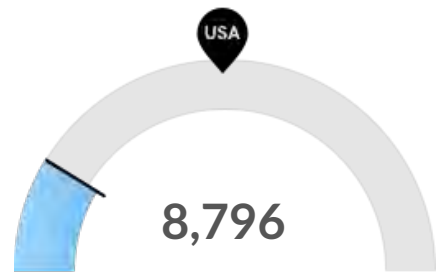
Anderson County, TN has 14,224 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 15,846.

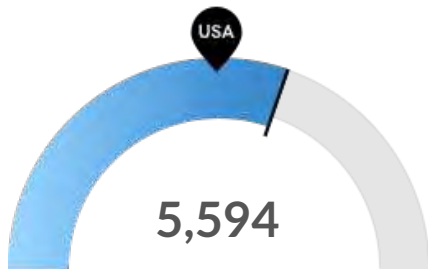
Retirement risk is high in Anderson County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 23,058 people 55 or older, while there are 26,826 here.

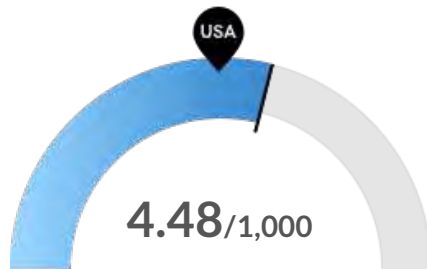

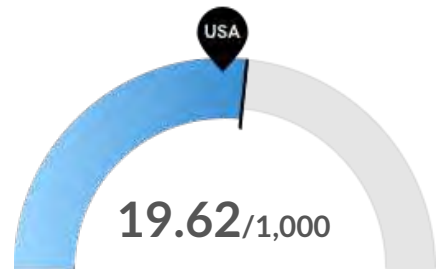

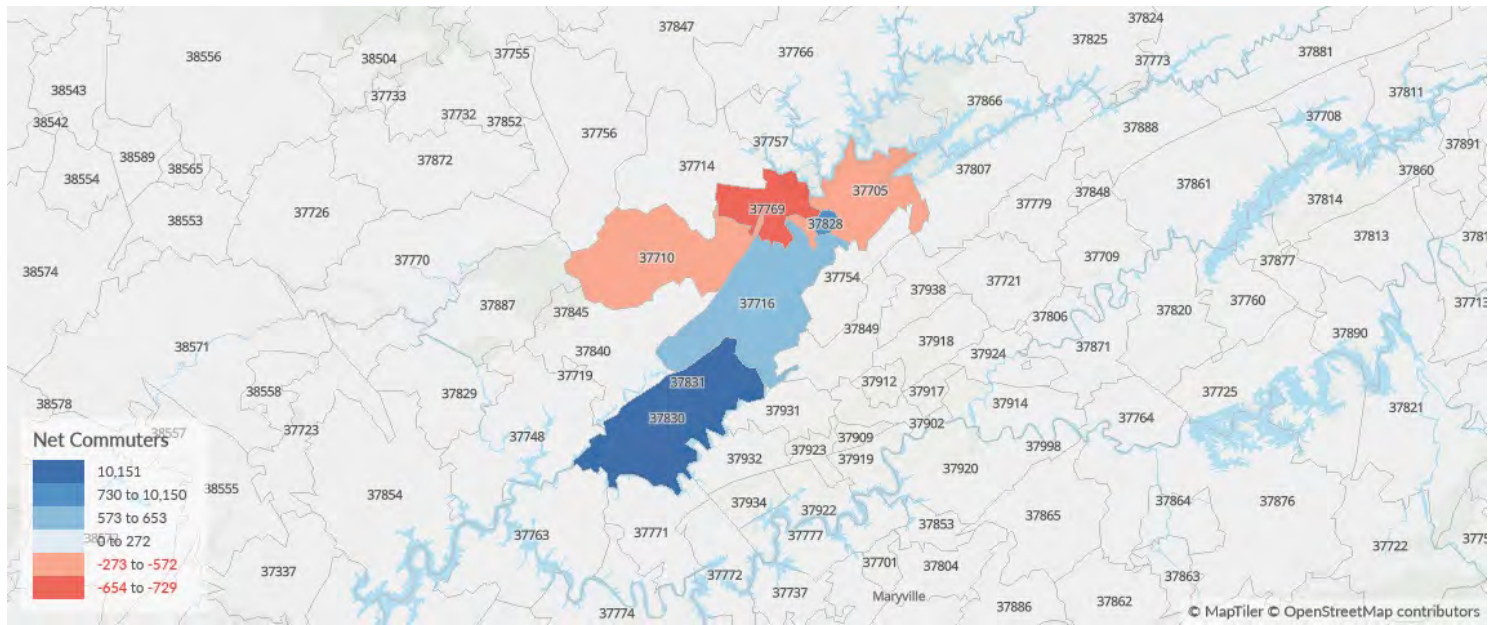

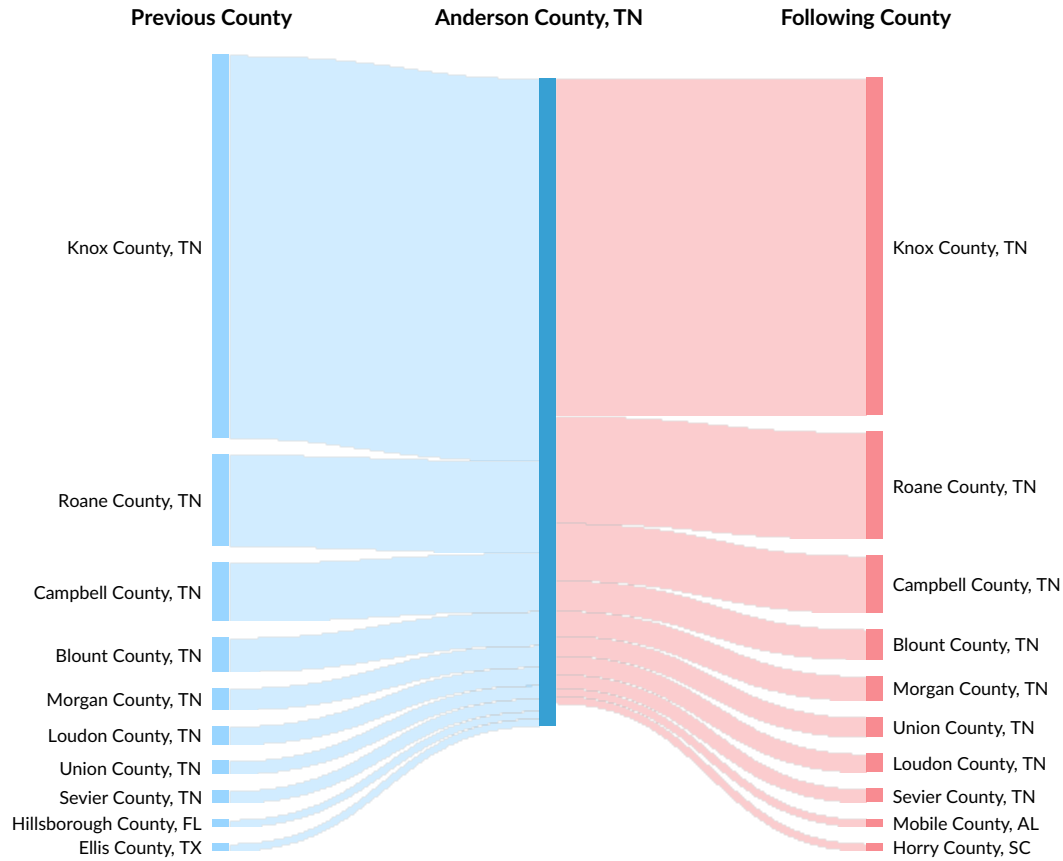

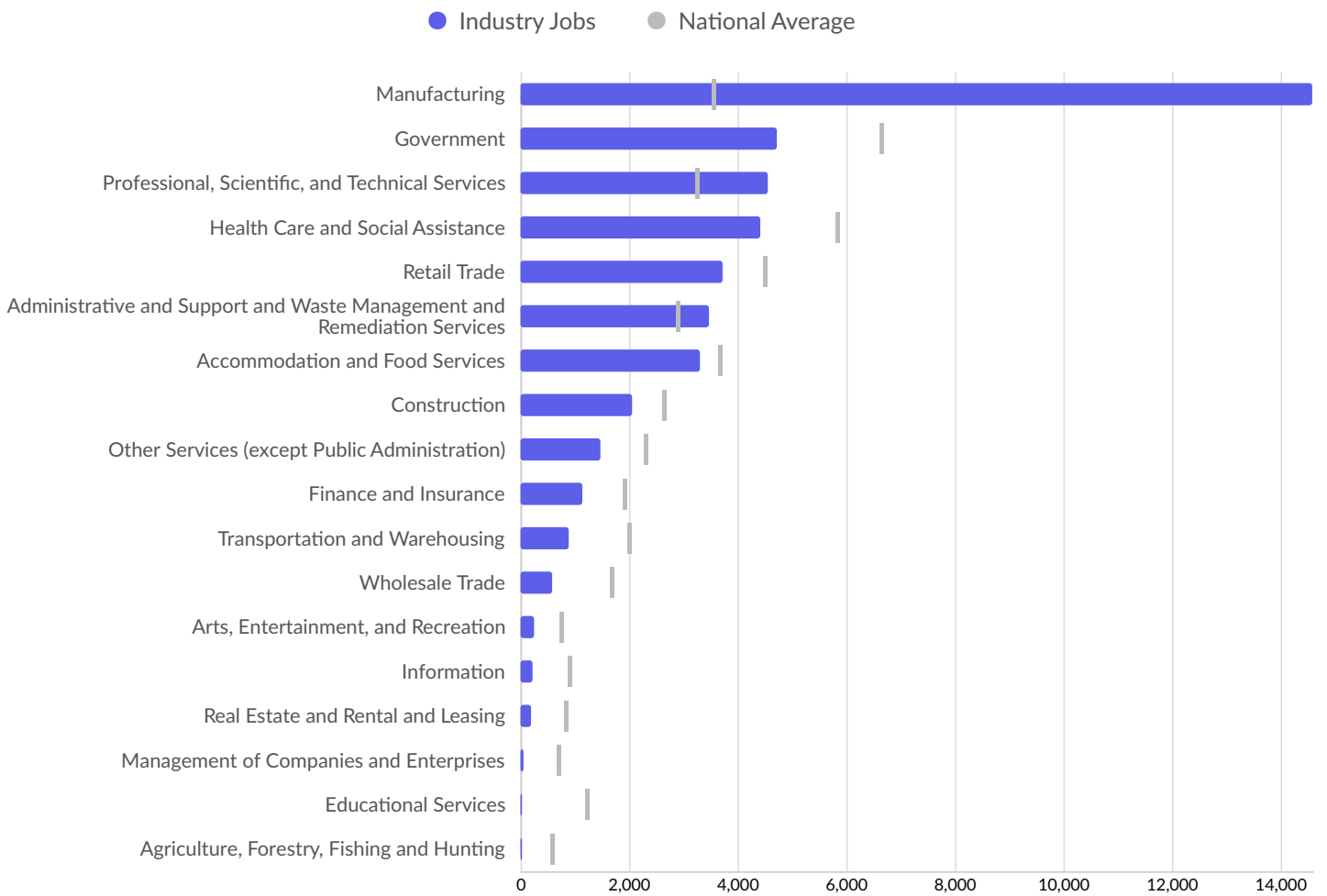

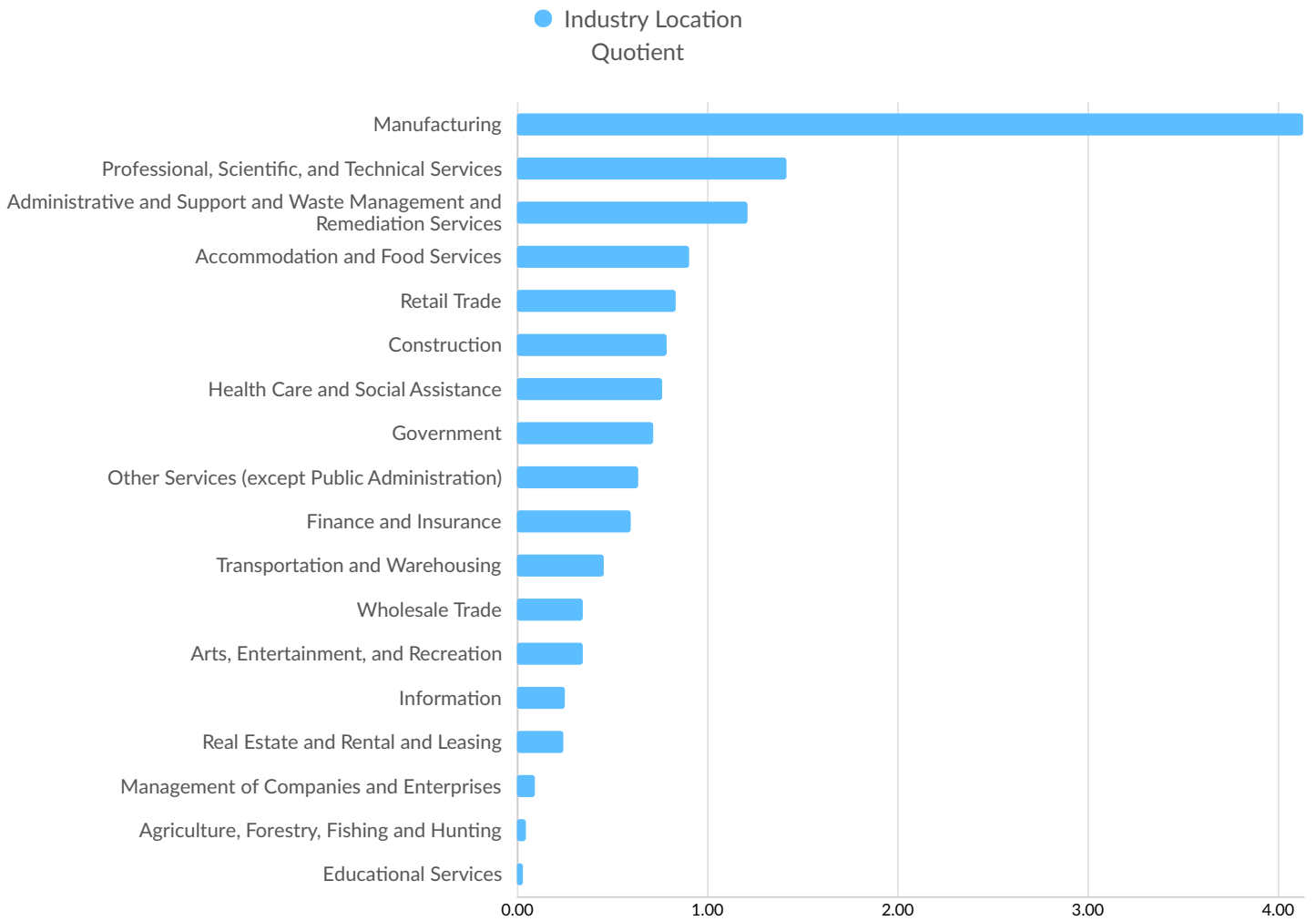

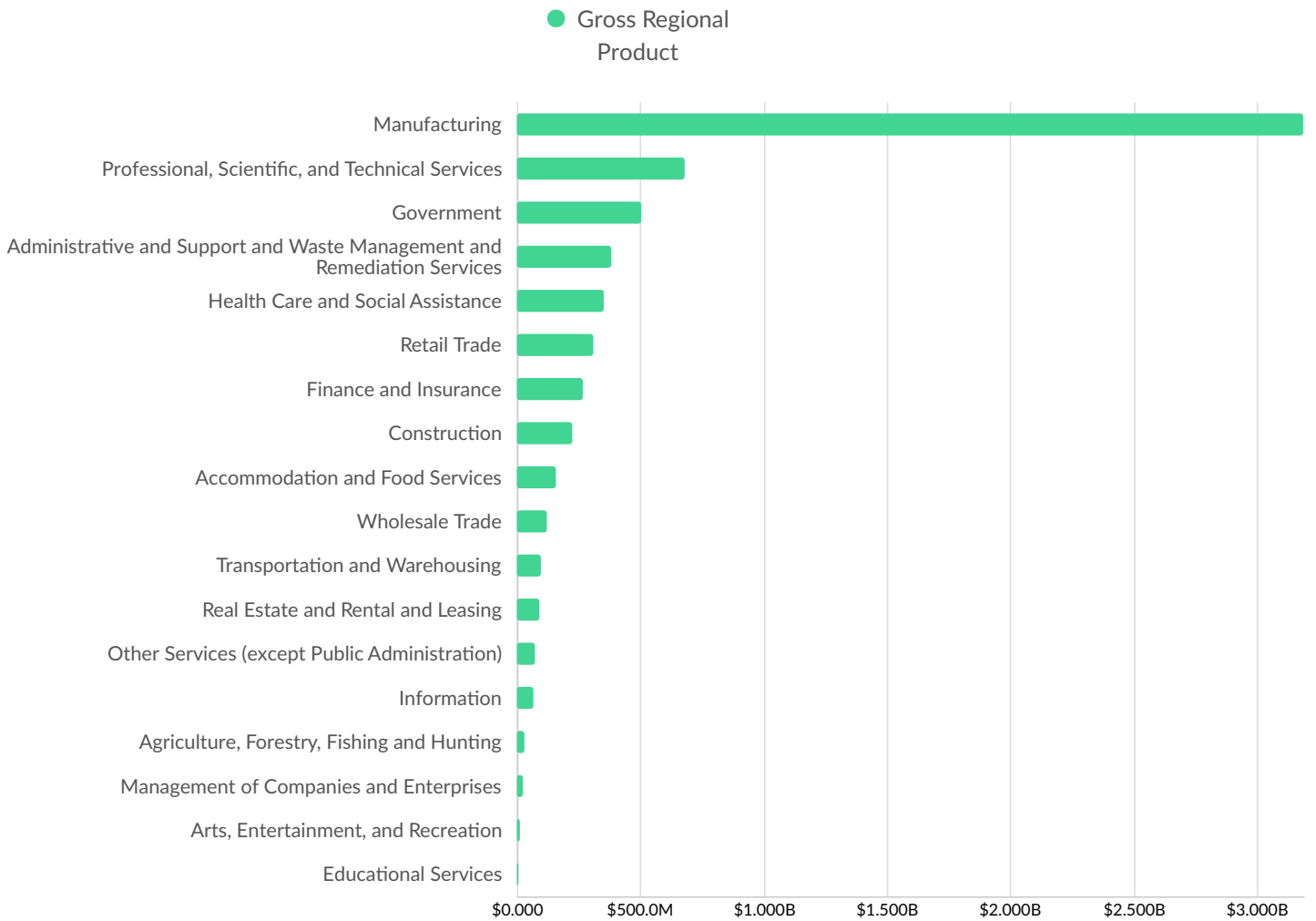
Top Growing Industries



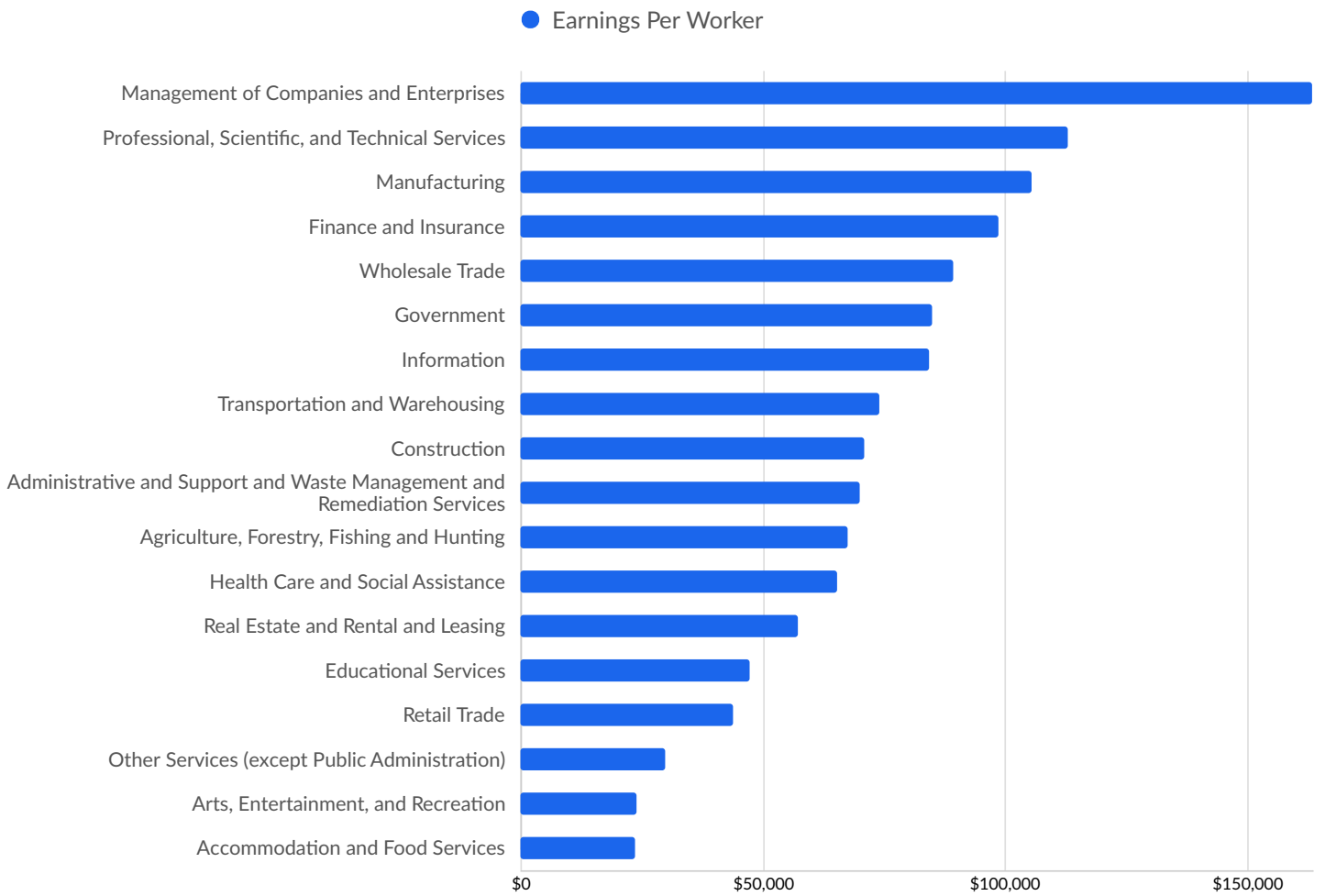
Top Industry Location Quotient

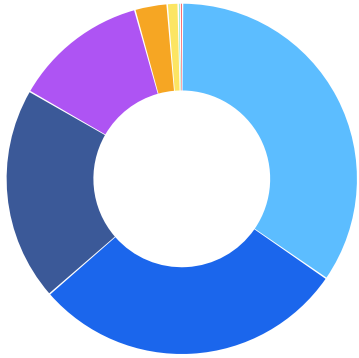

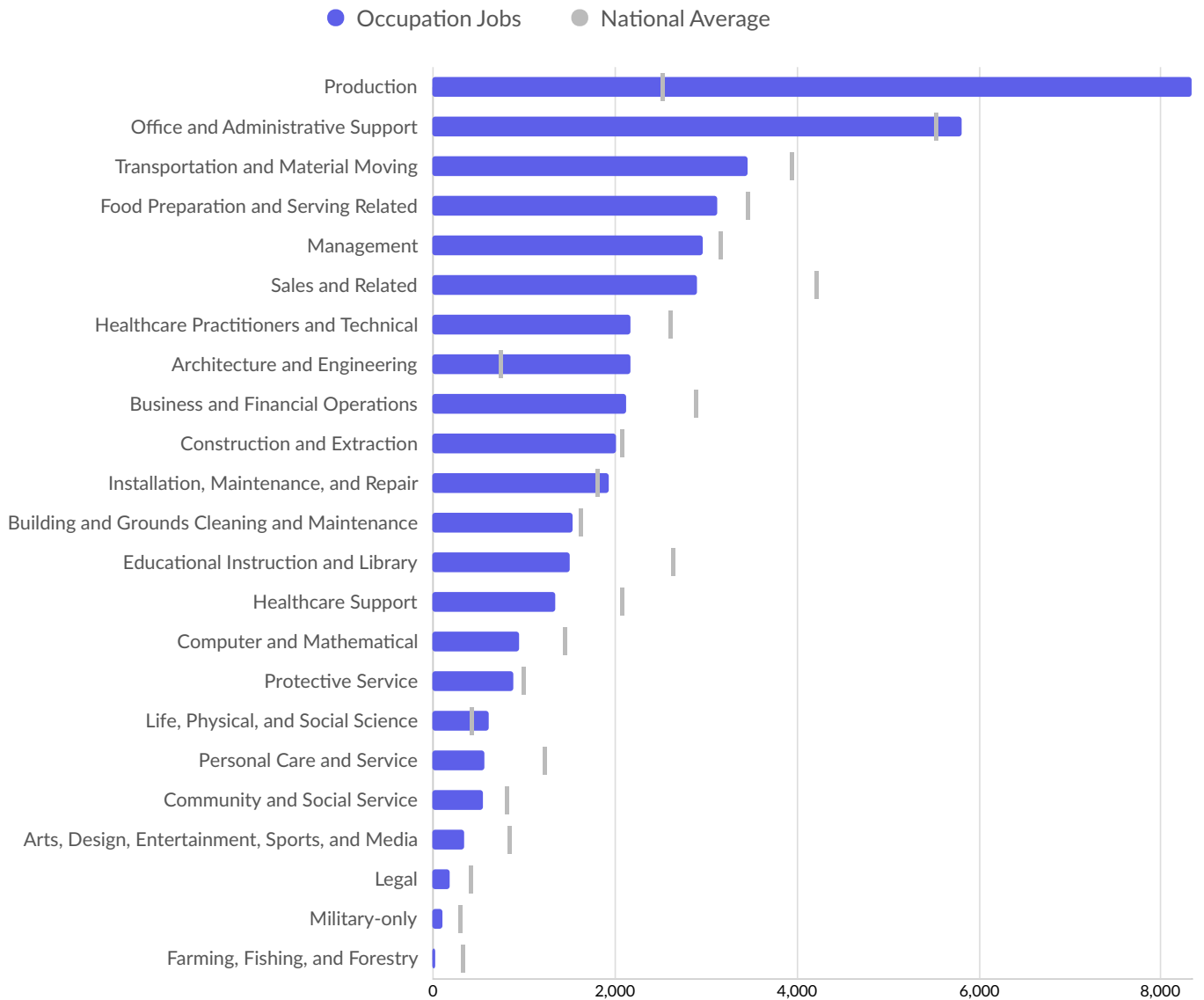

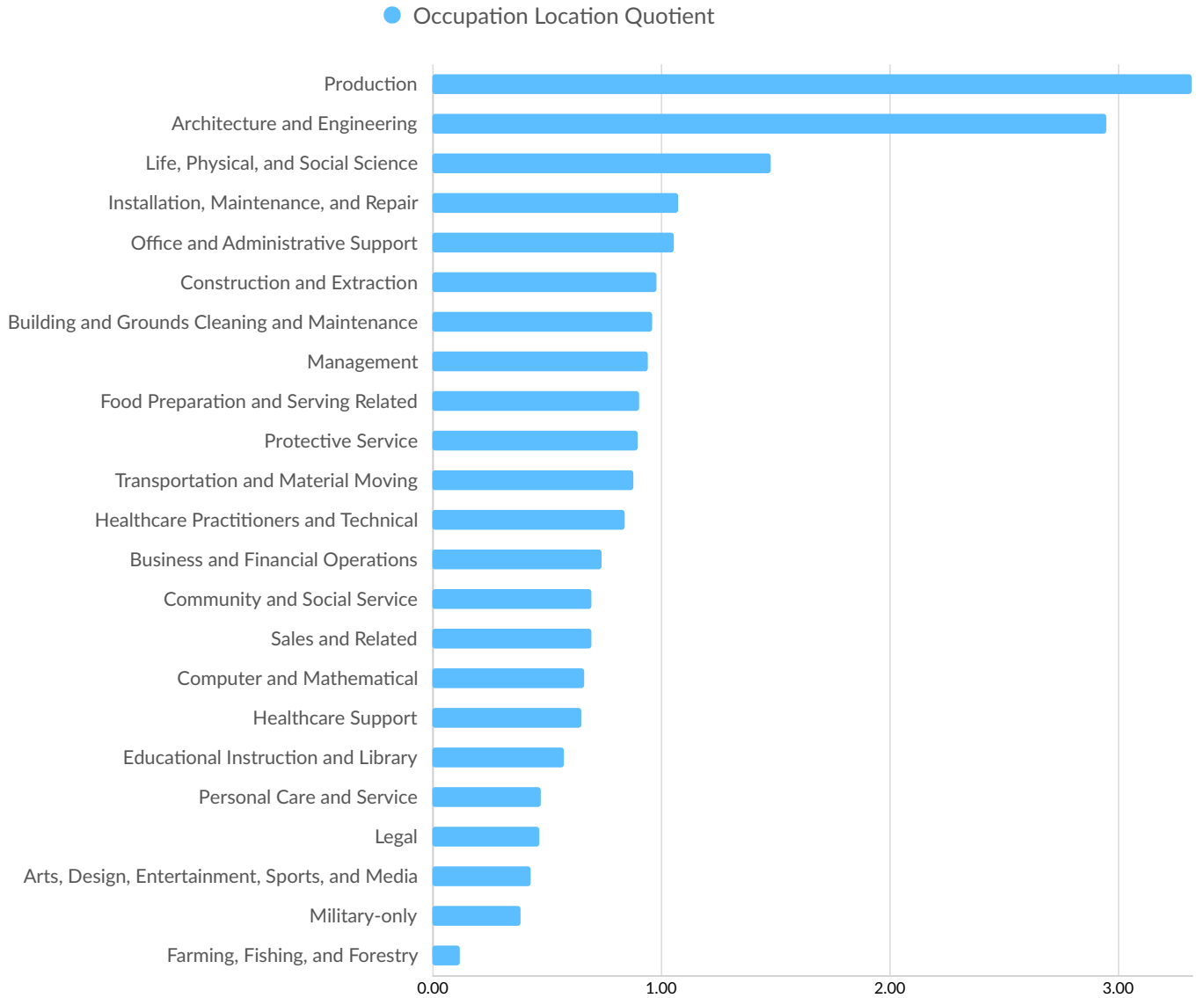
Largest Occupations



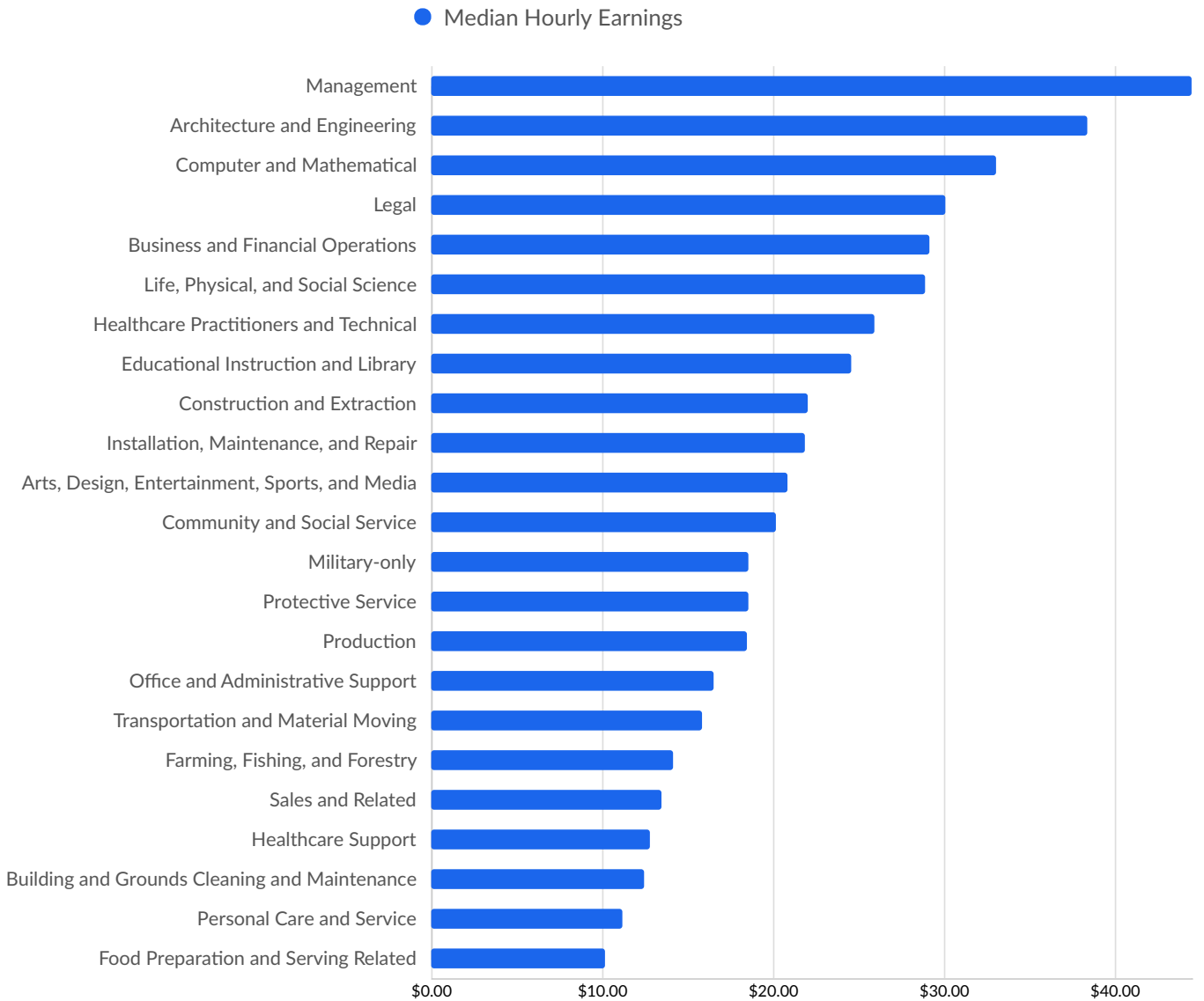
Top Growing Occupations



Top Occupation Location Quotient



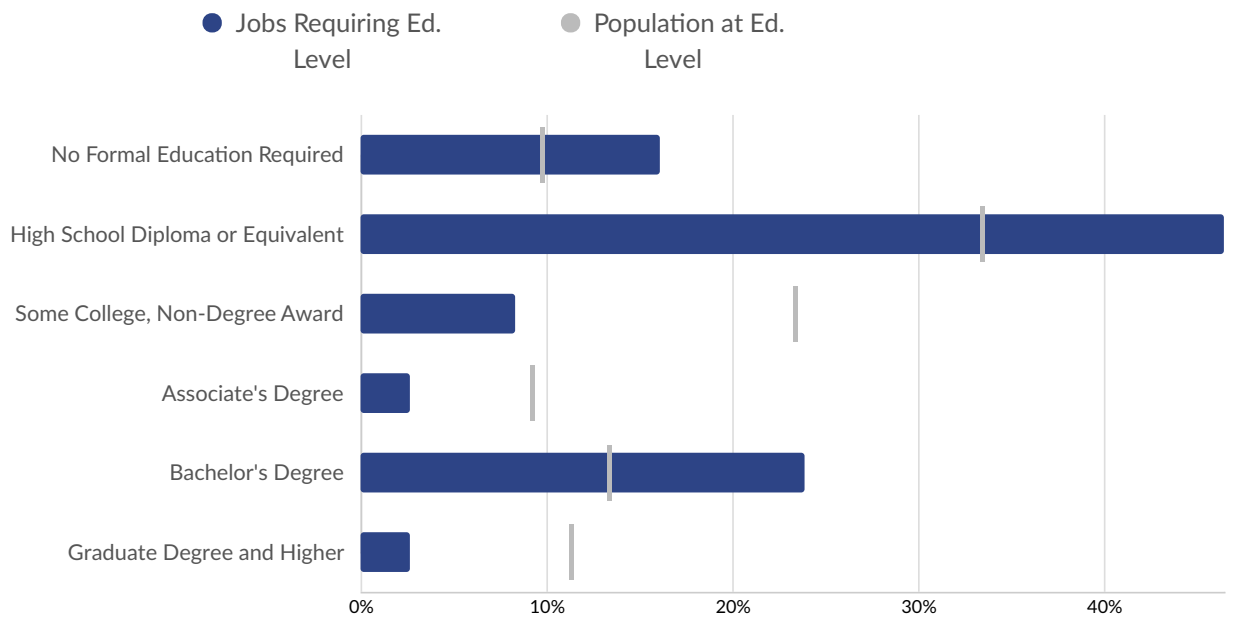
