
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 0.6%** since 2018, falling by 251. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.1%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 419.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.6% in Campbell County, TN from 11,037 to 10,865. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 46.1% to 48.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.3% of Campbell County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.8% below the national average), and **6.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.













### **Job Trends**






Campbell County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 4.21%, decreasing from 4.76% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Campbell County, TN has 6,992 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,049.




#### **Veterans**

Campbell County, TN has 2,593 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,069.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Campbell County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 11,863 people 55 or older, while there are 13,829 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

#### **Property Crime**


Campbell County, TN has 12.71 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 12.12 per 1,000 people.








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**






