- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 0.7% in Campbell County, TN from 11,037 to 10,959. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 45.1% to 46.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **7.7% of Campbell County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.4% below the national average), and **6.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender












Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Campbell County, TN has 7,295 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,173.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Campbell County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 12,142 people 55 or older, while there are 14,058 here.




Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Campbell County, TN has 2.5 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






