- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 3.4%** in Claiborne County, TN from 10,434 to **10,792**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 0.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 50.6% to 48.0% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Claiborne County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.0% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Household and Institutional Furniture and Kitchen Cabinet Manufacturing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Colleges, Universities, and Professional Schools.

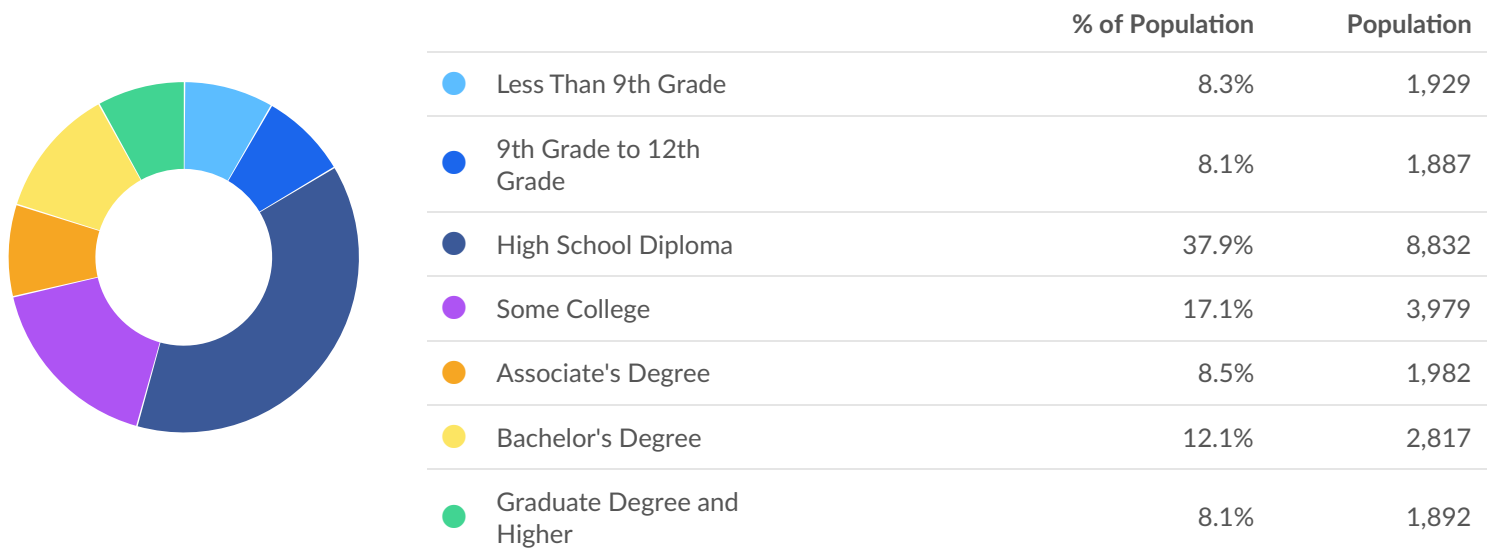

Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



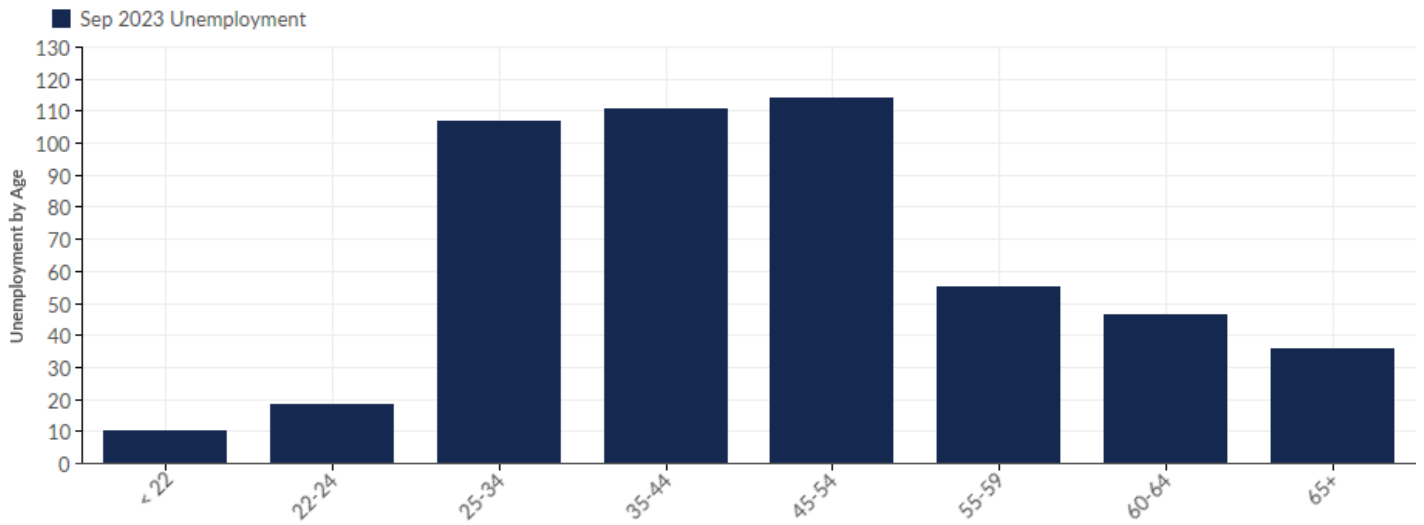
Educational Attainment

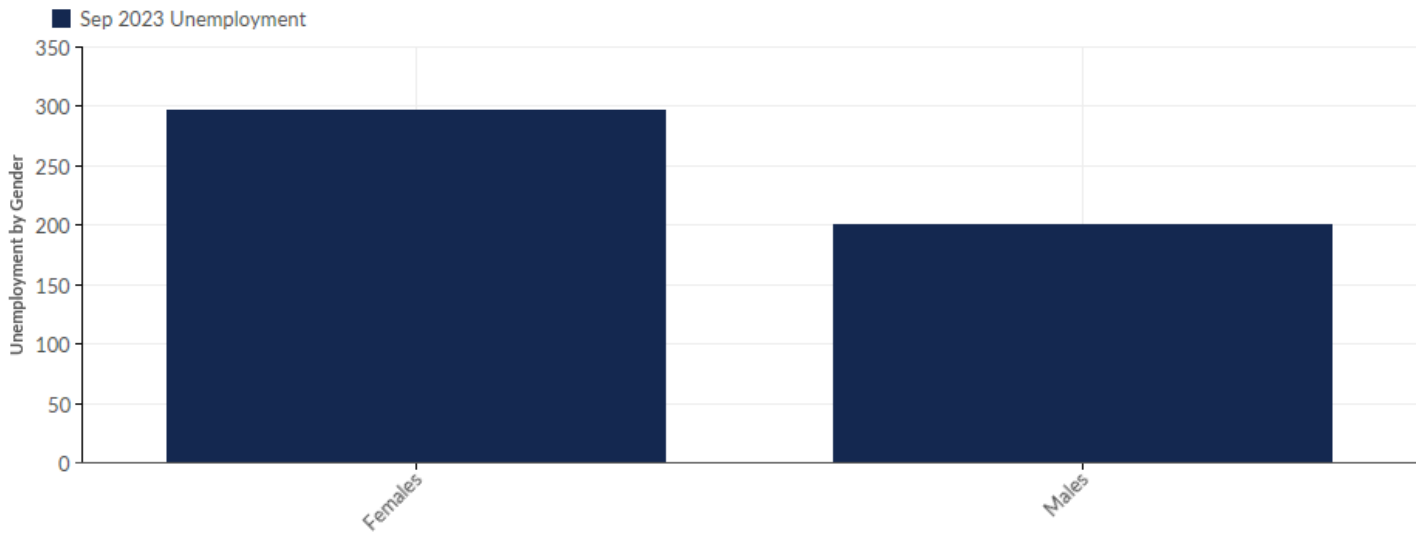

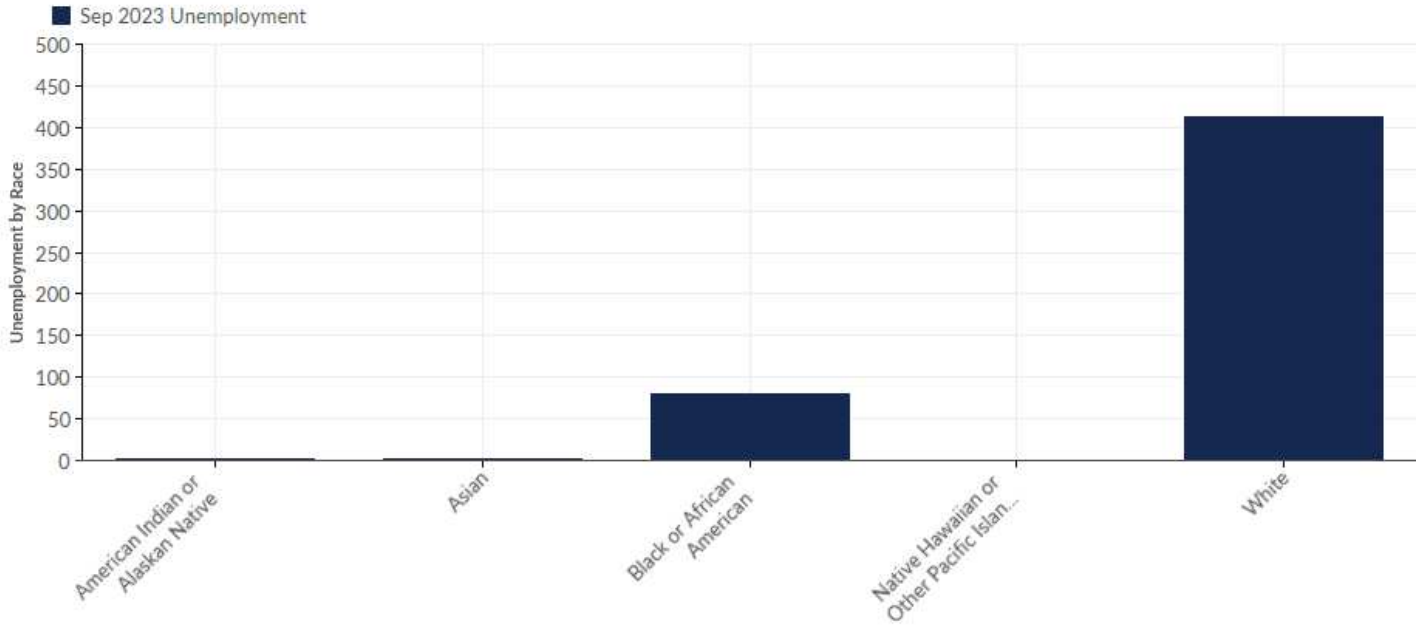

Unemployment by Gender



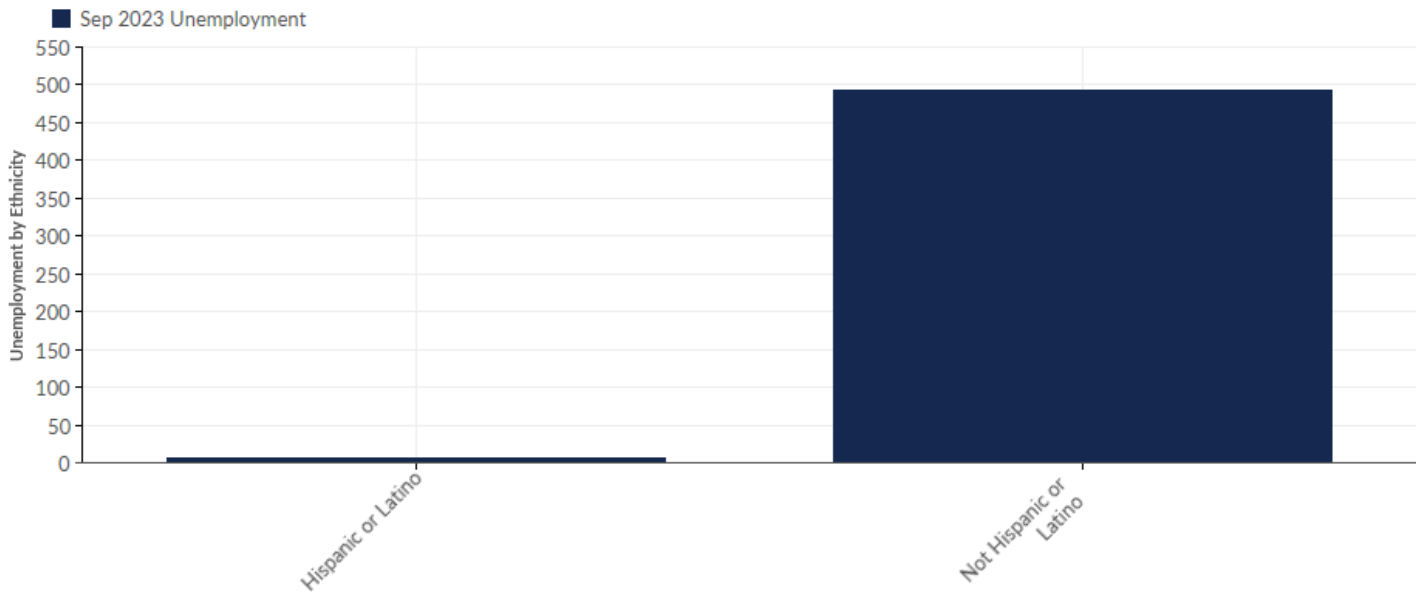

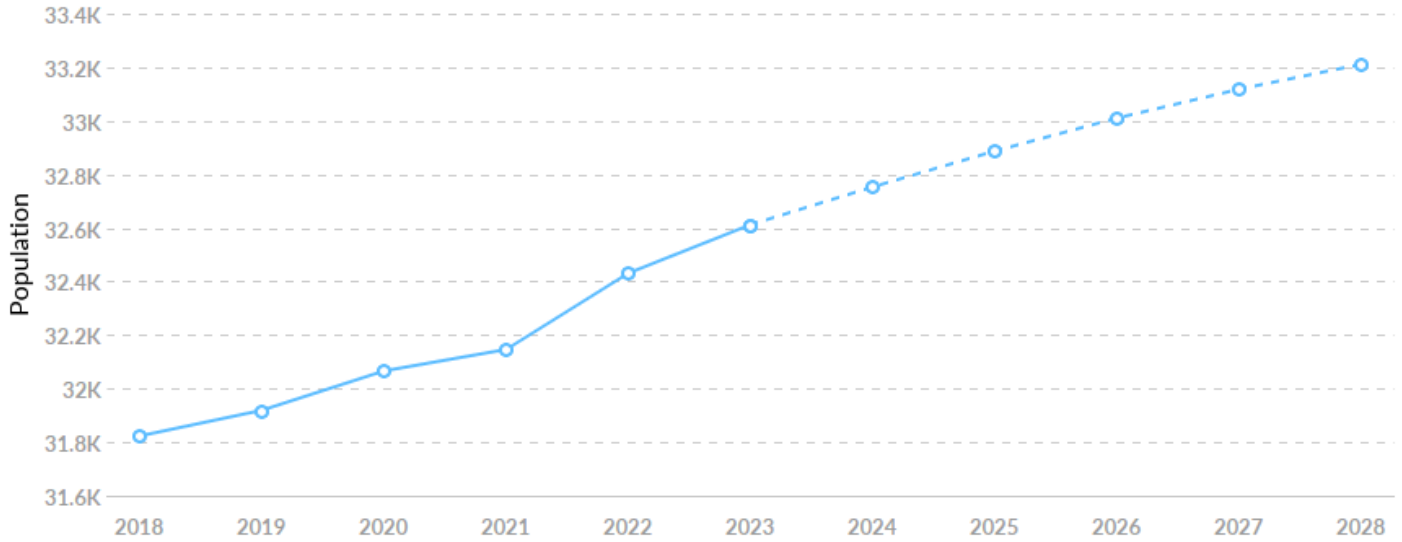

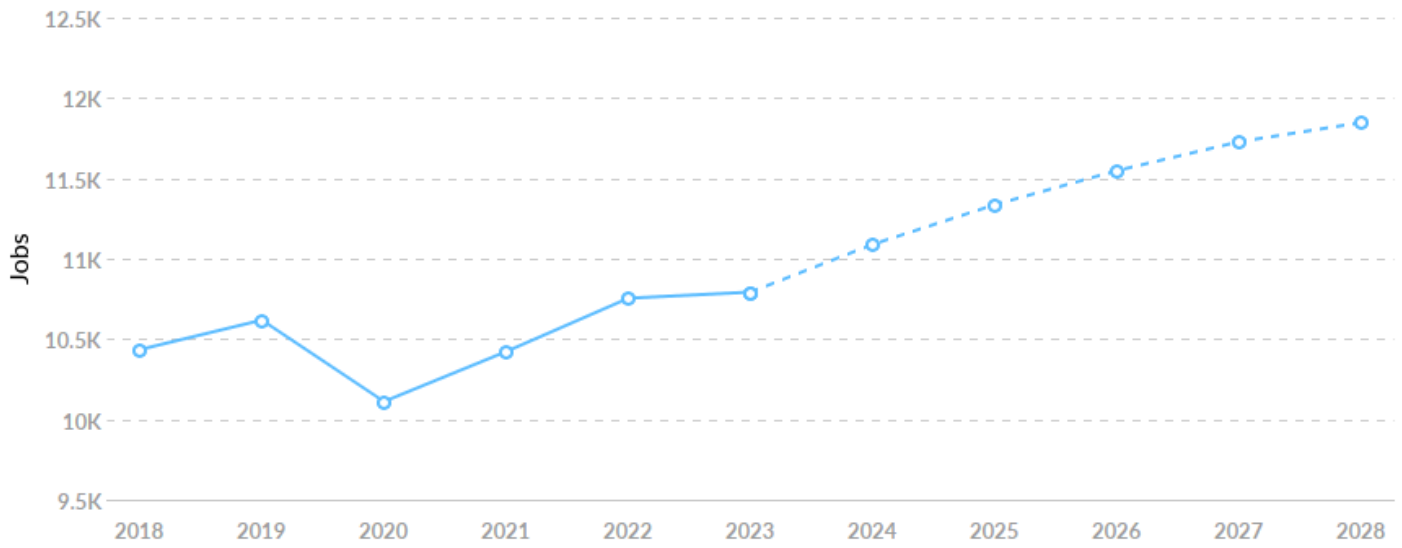

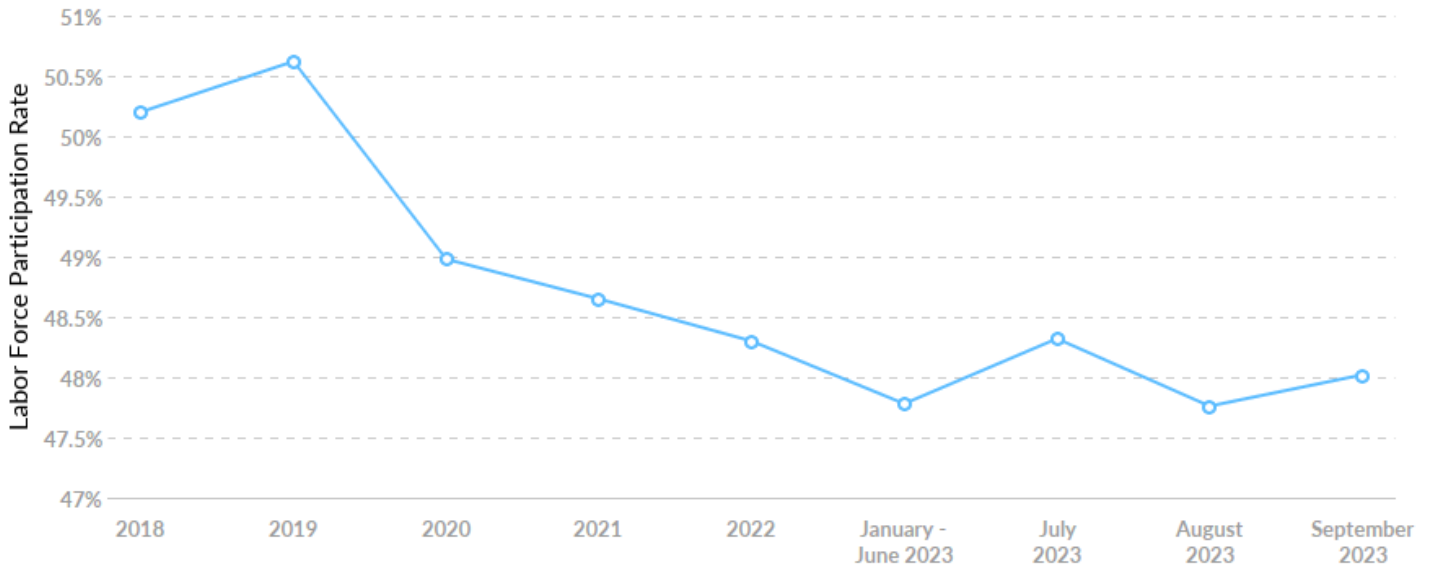
Job Trends

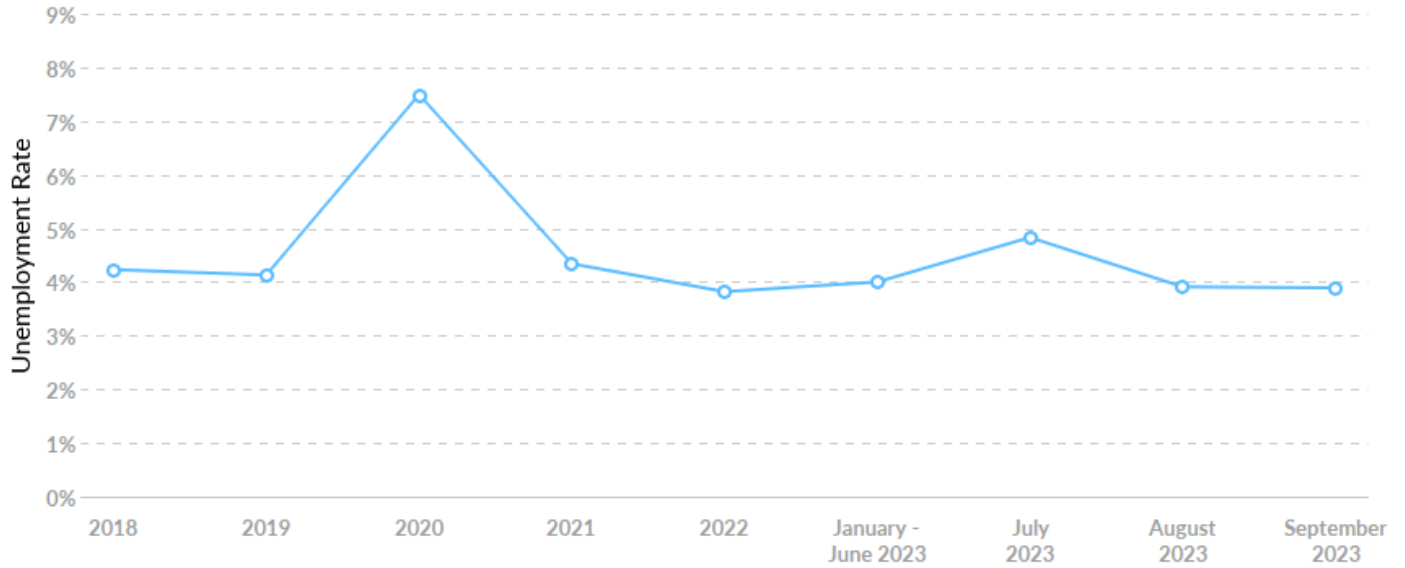

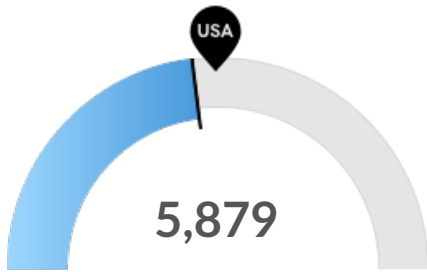
Unemployment Rate Trends

Claiborne County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.89%, **decreasing from 4.23%** 5 years before.



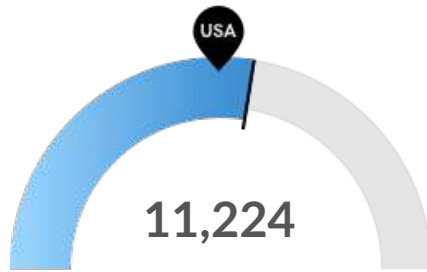

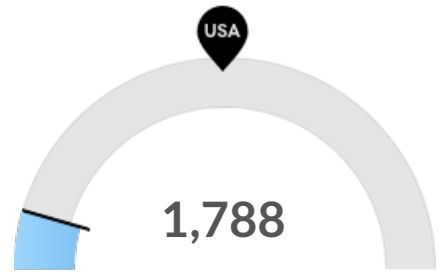
Millennials

Claiborne County, TN has 5,879 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,594.



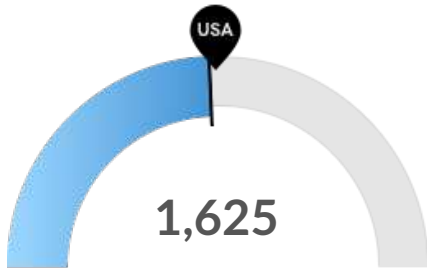
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Claiborne County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 9,719 people 55 or older, while there are 11,224 here.



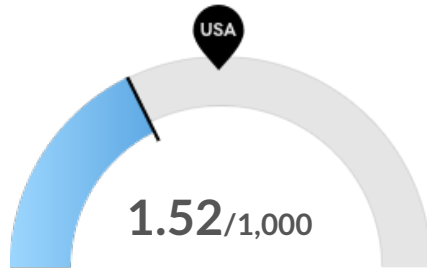
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Claiborne County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 13,337 racially diverse people, while there are 1,788 here.



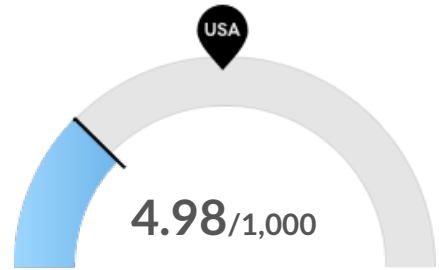
Veterans

Claiborne County, TN has 1.52 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.

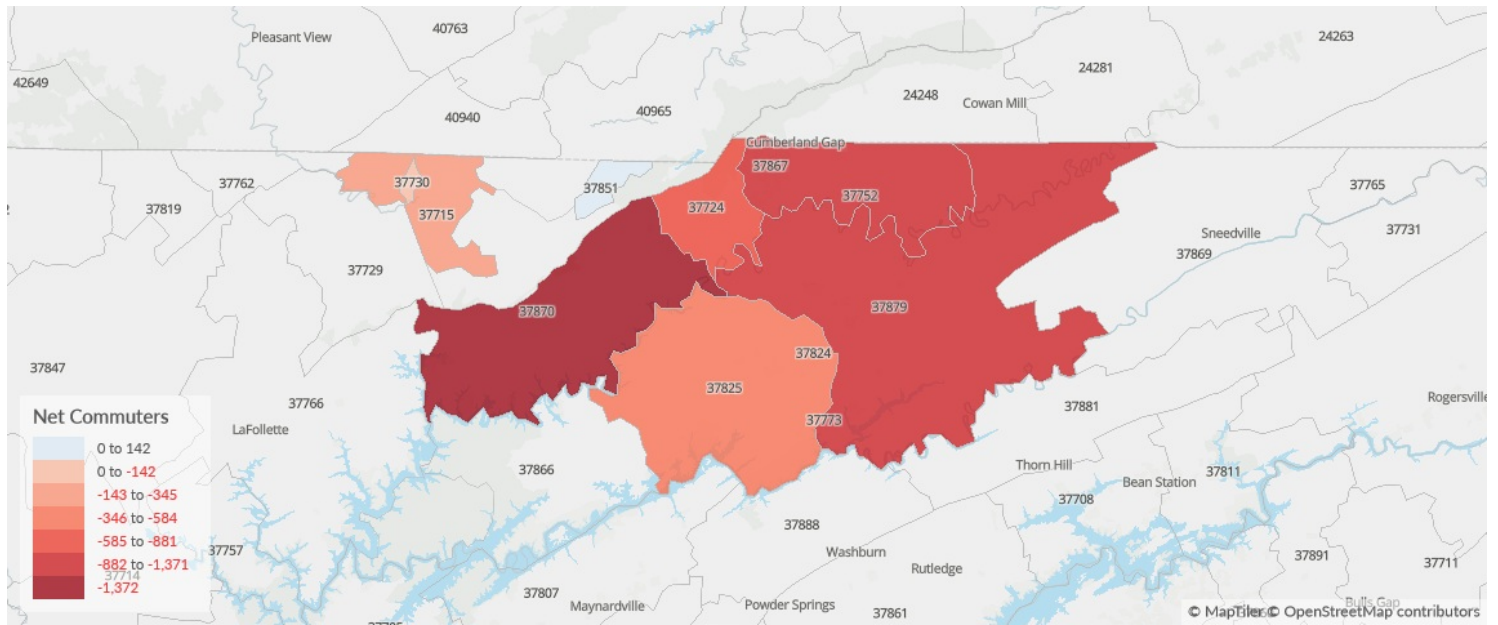


Property Crime

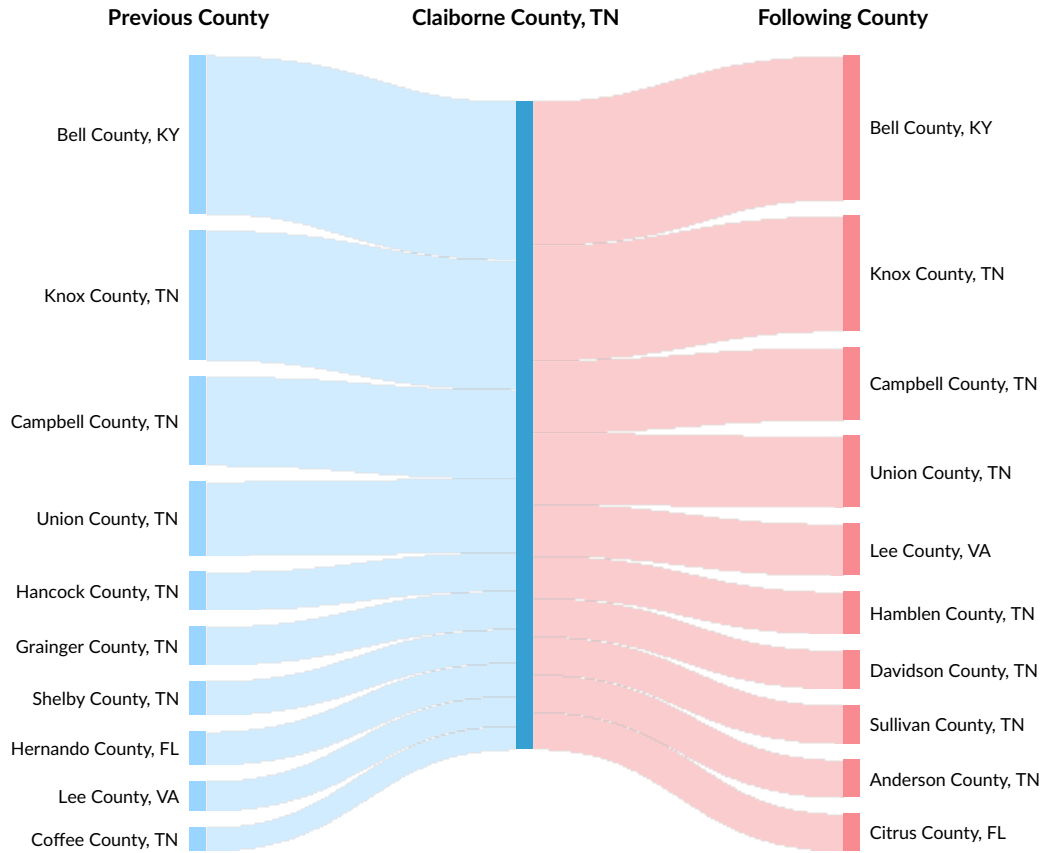

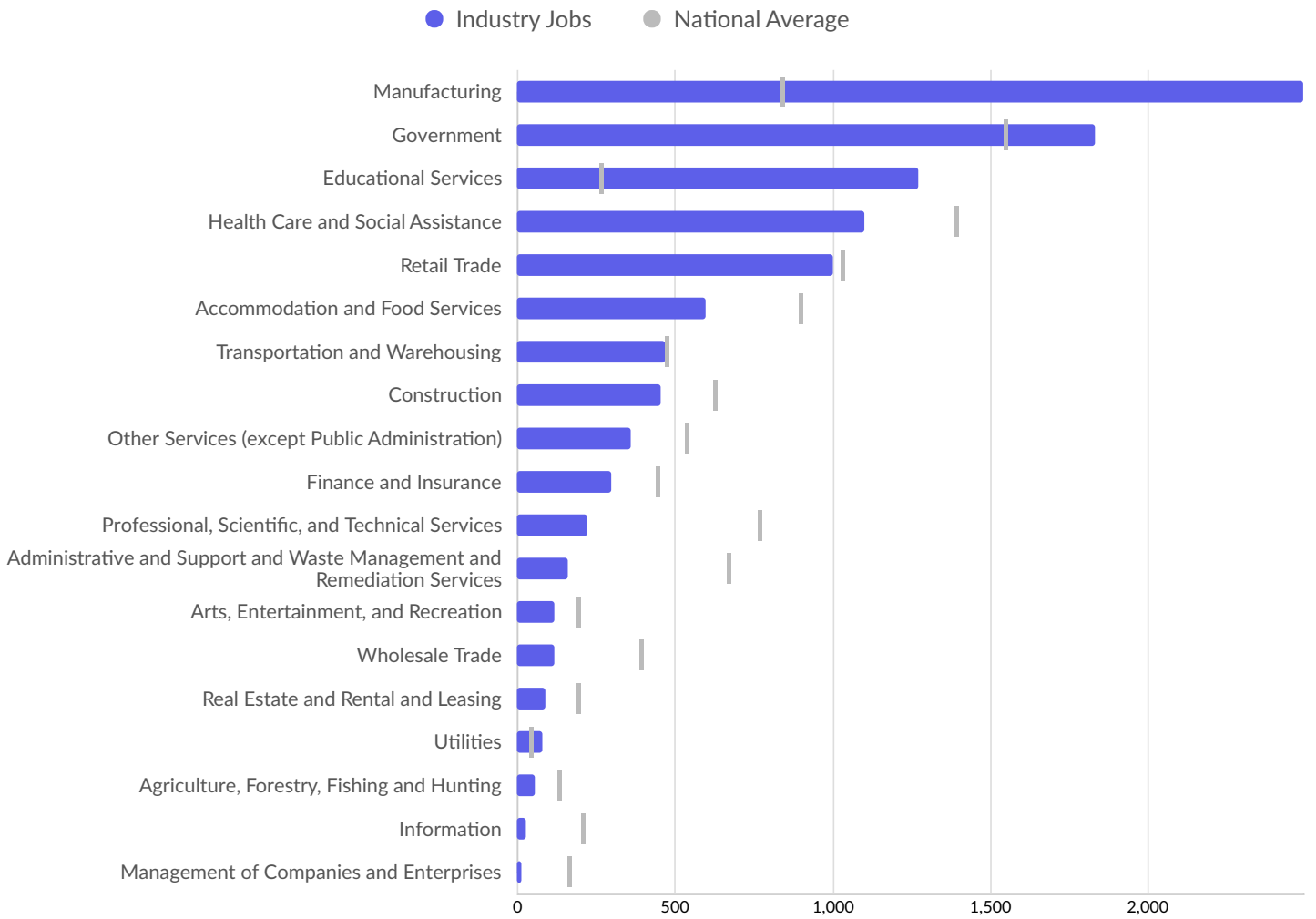

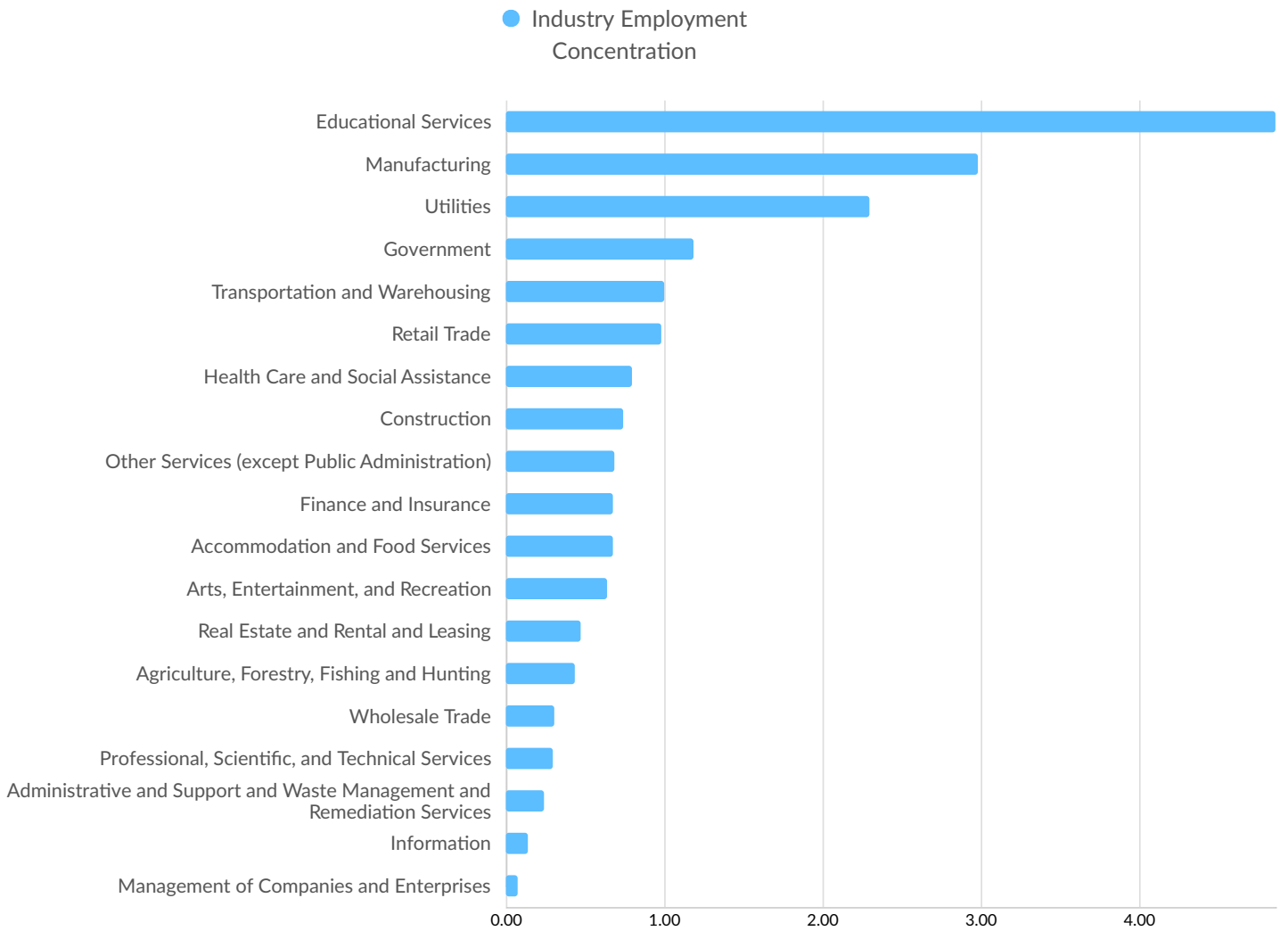

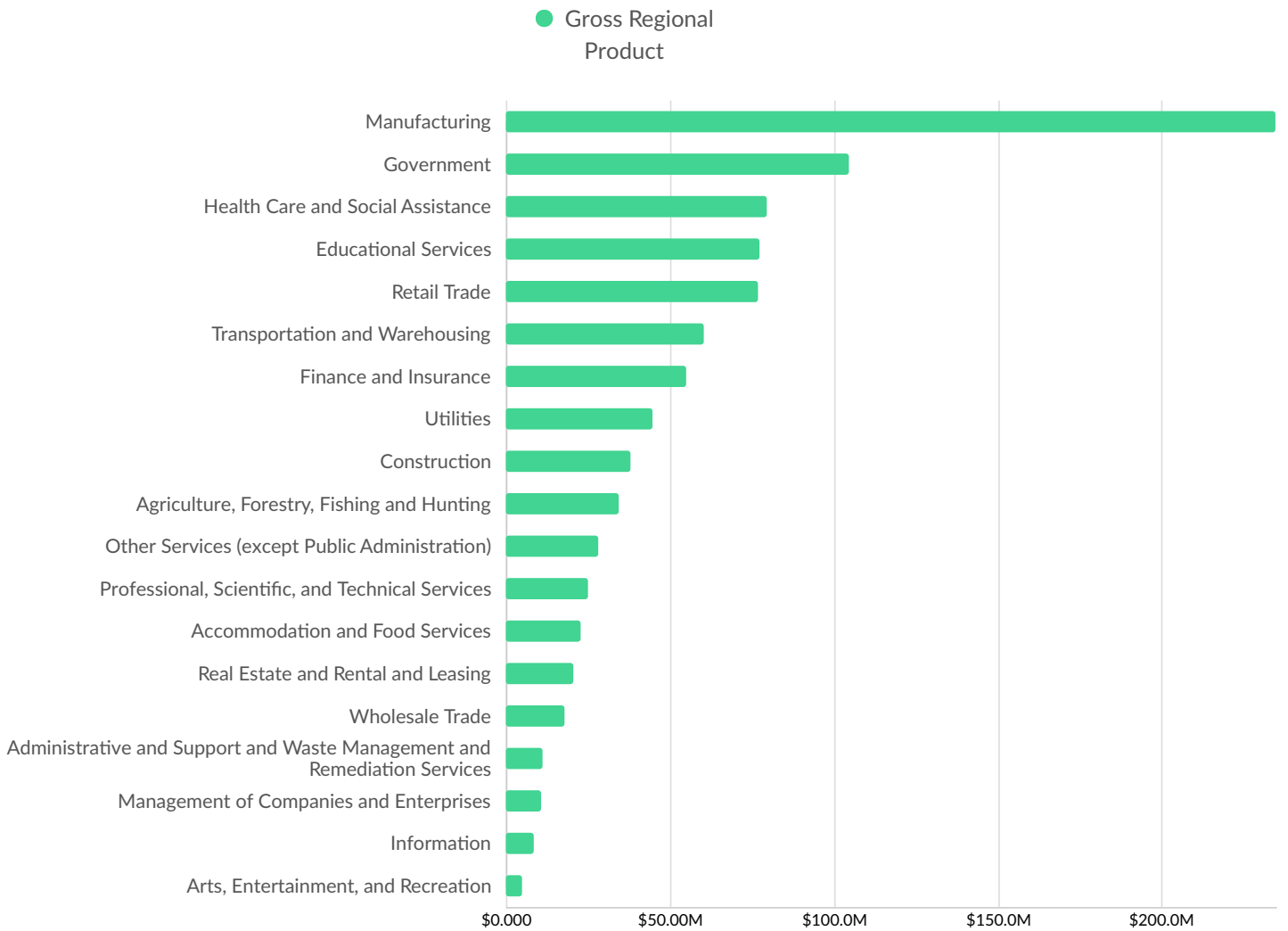
Top Growing Industries



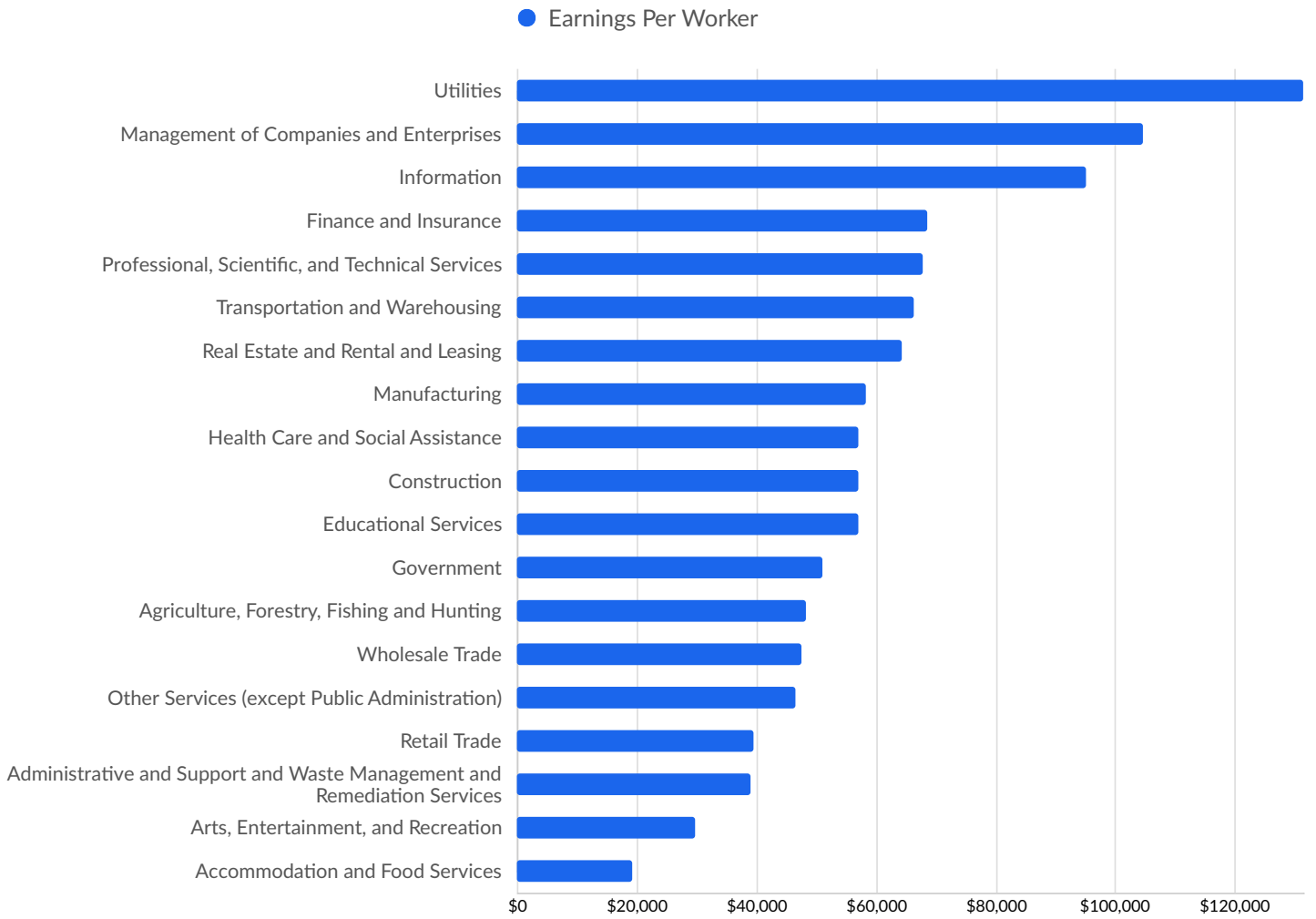
Top Industry Employment Concentration

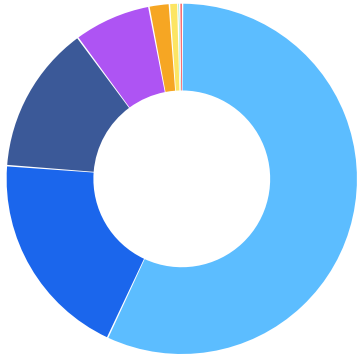

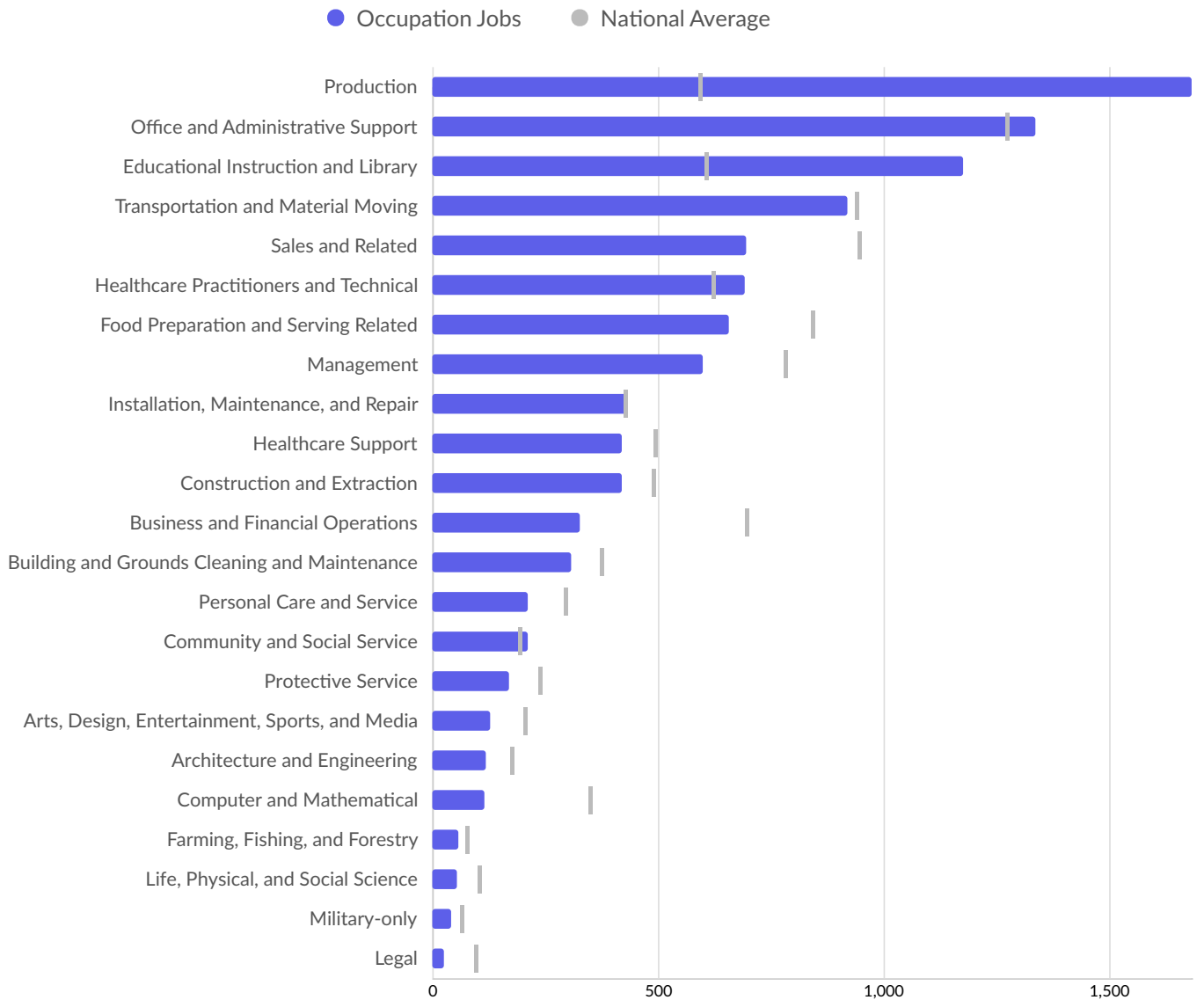

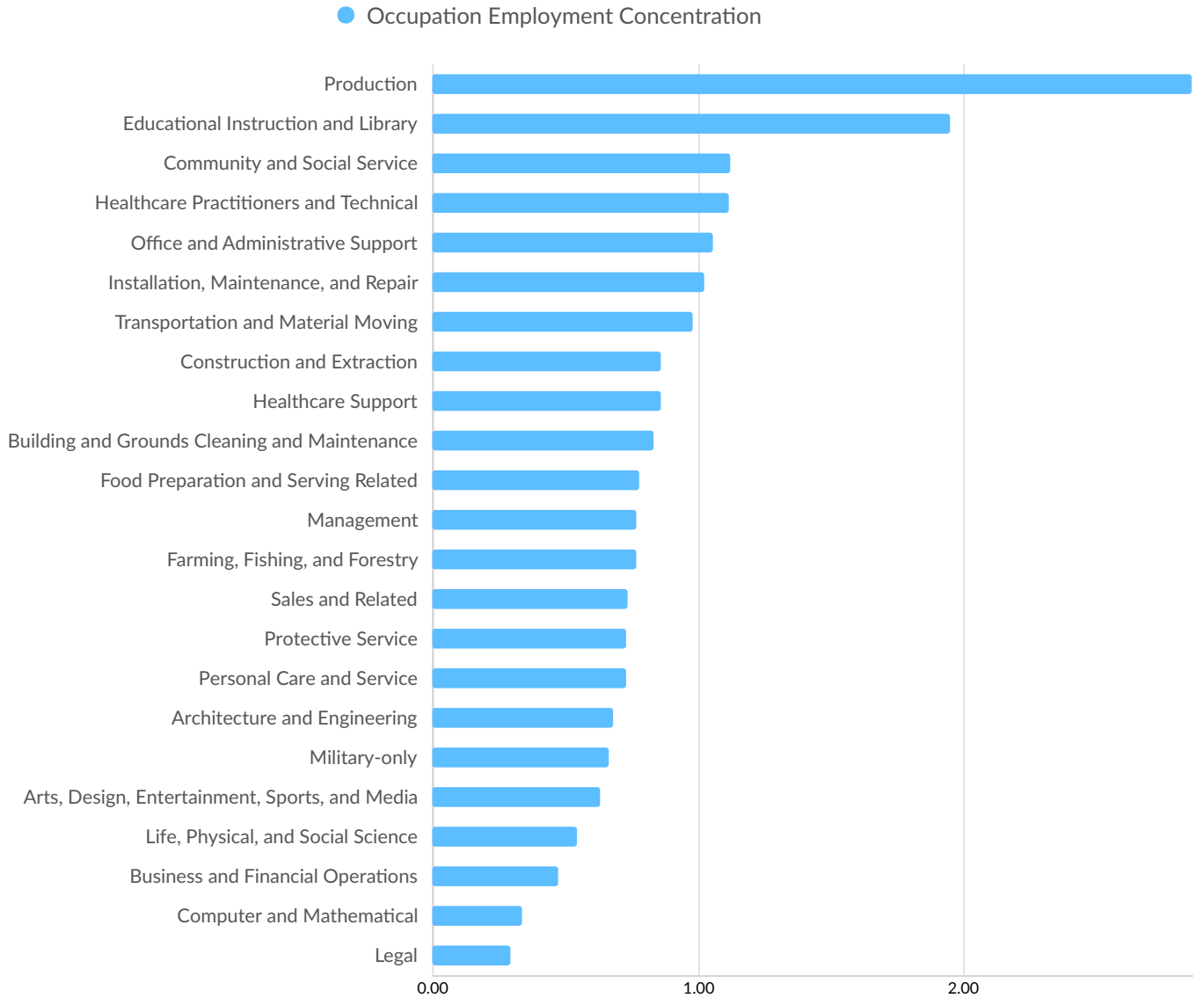

Top Growing Occupations



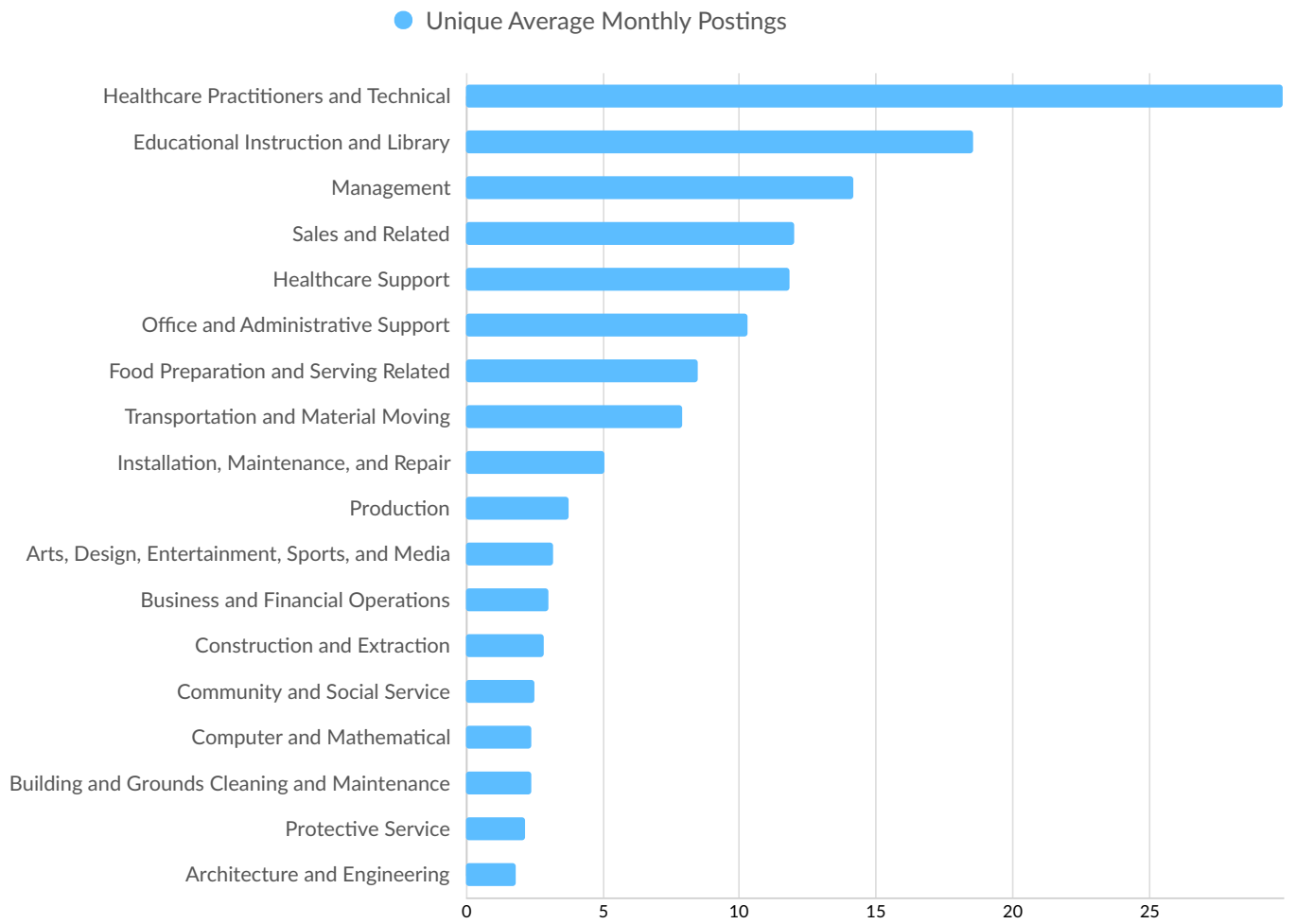
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



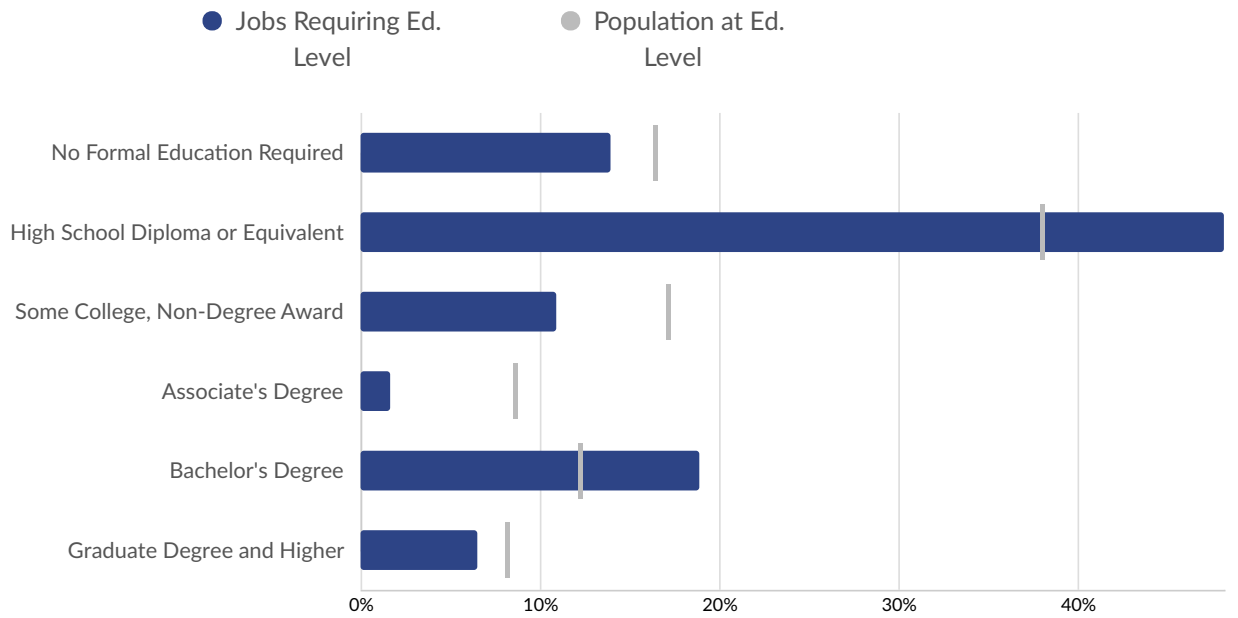
Top Occupation Earnings
