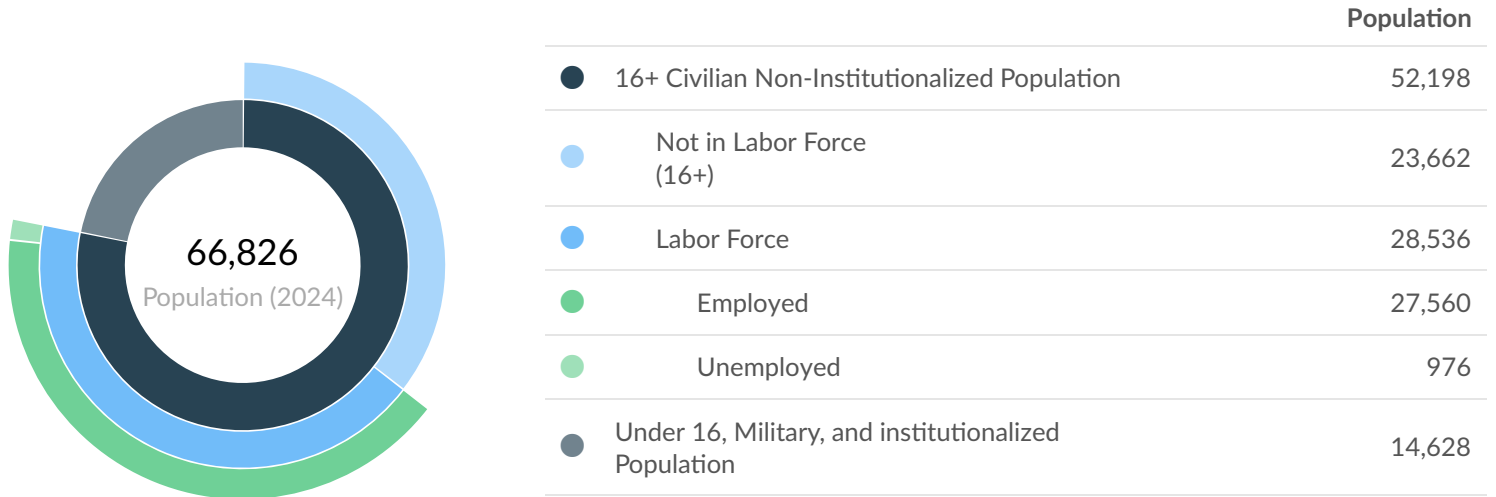
Median household income is **\$25.5K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 3.0%** since 2019, growing by 1,953. Population is expected to **increase by 4.5%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 3,005.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 4.9%** in Hamblen County, TN from 35,296 to **37,033**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 1.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 55.0% to 54.7% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.3% of Hamblen County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.1% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Employment Services.

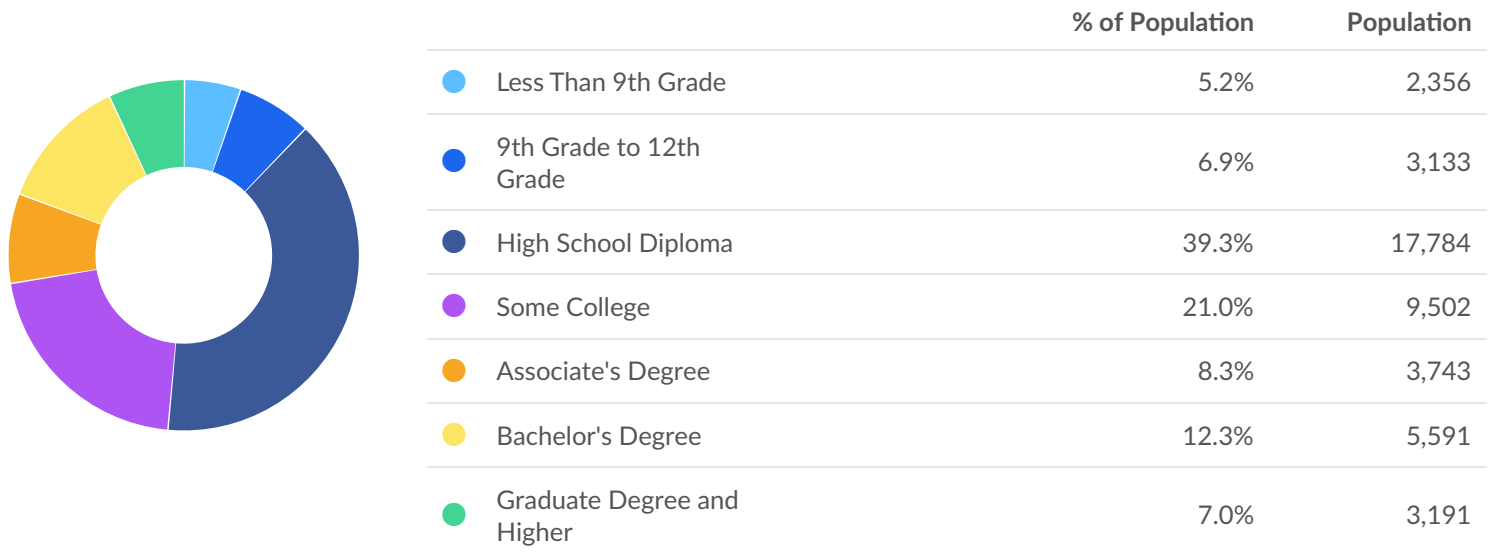

Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



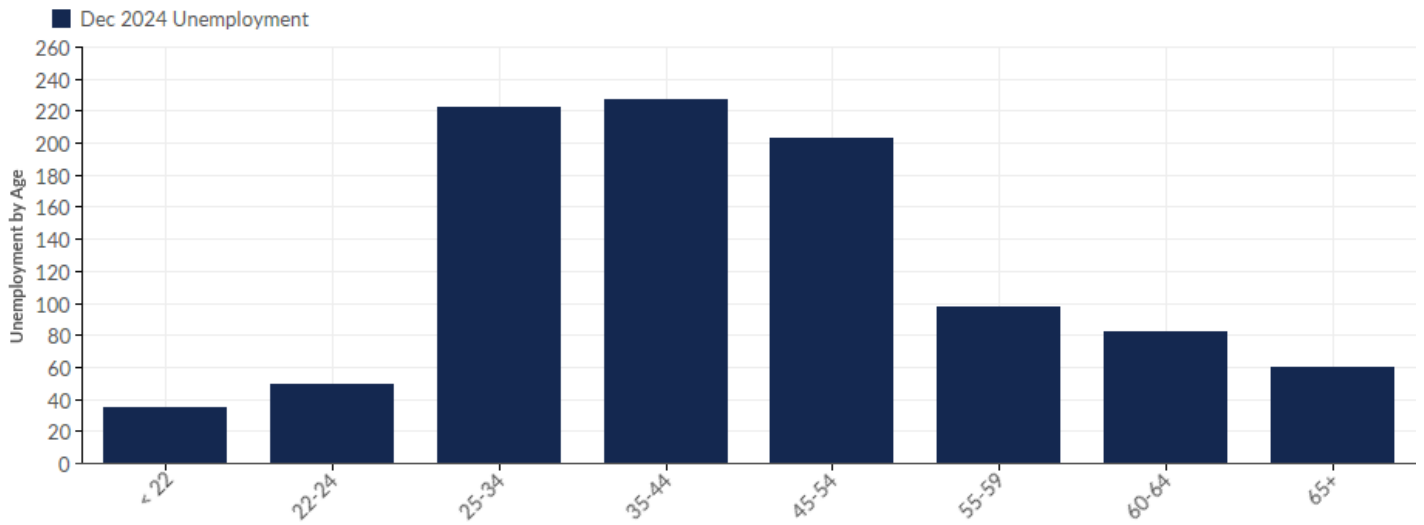
Educational Attainment

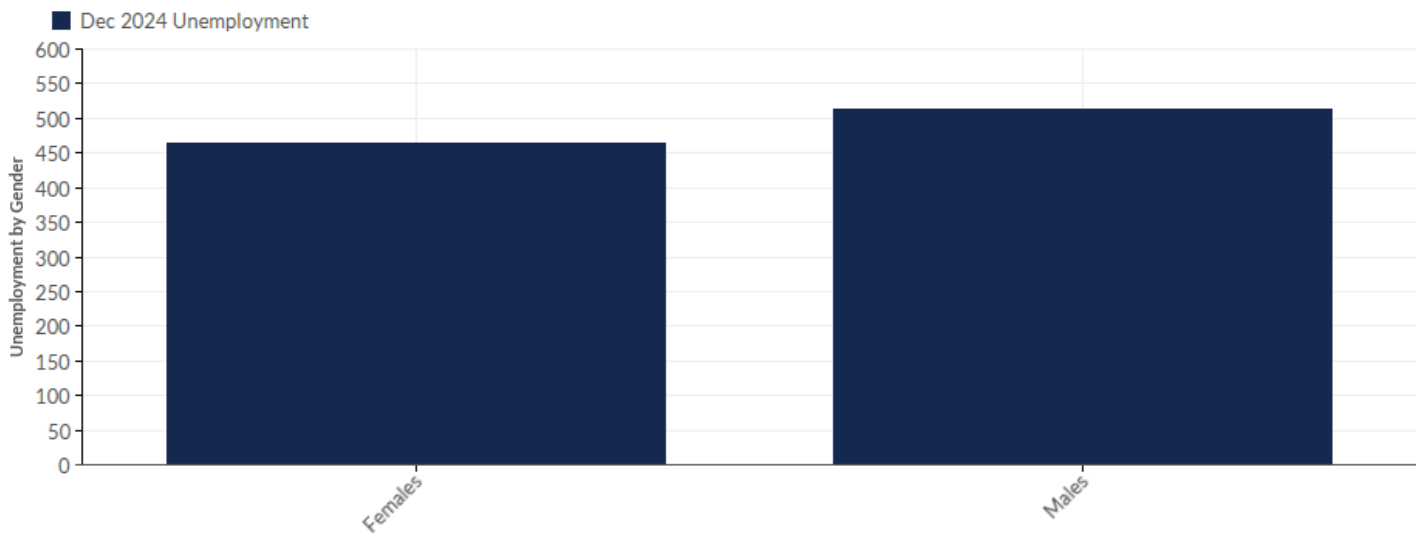

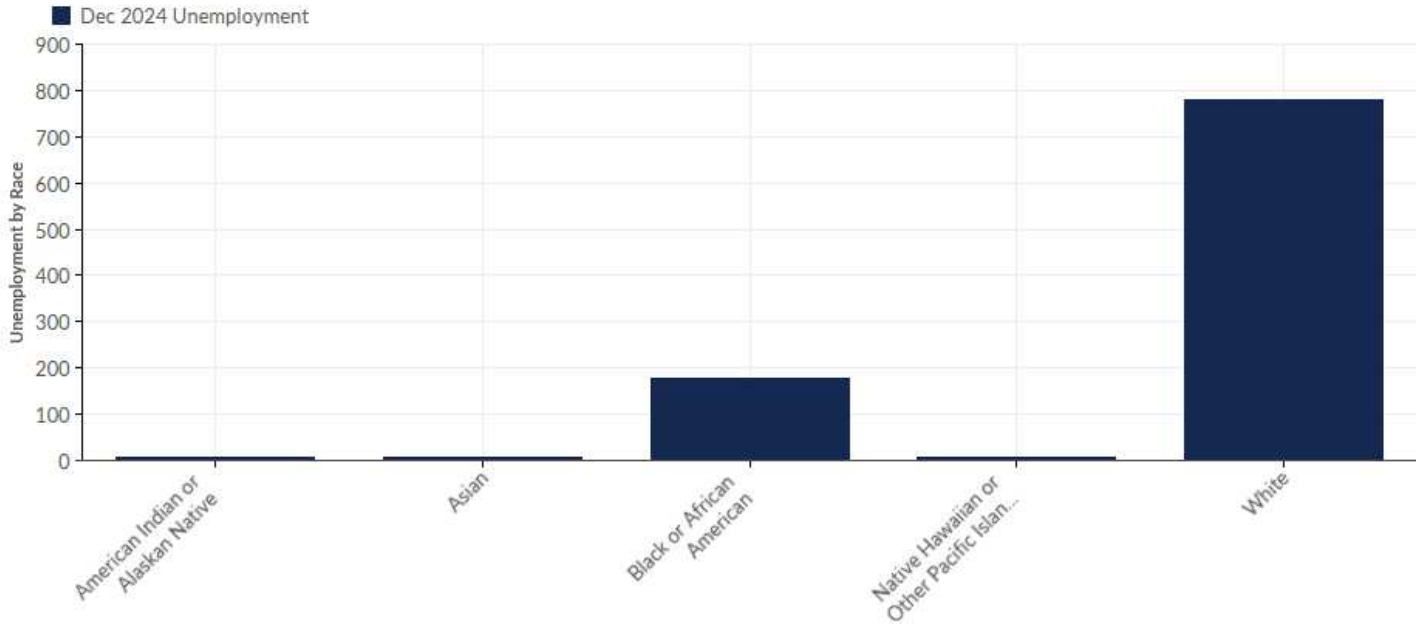

Unemployment by Gender



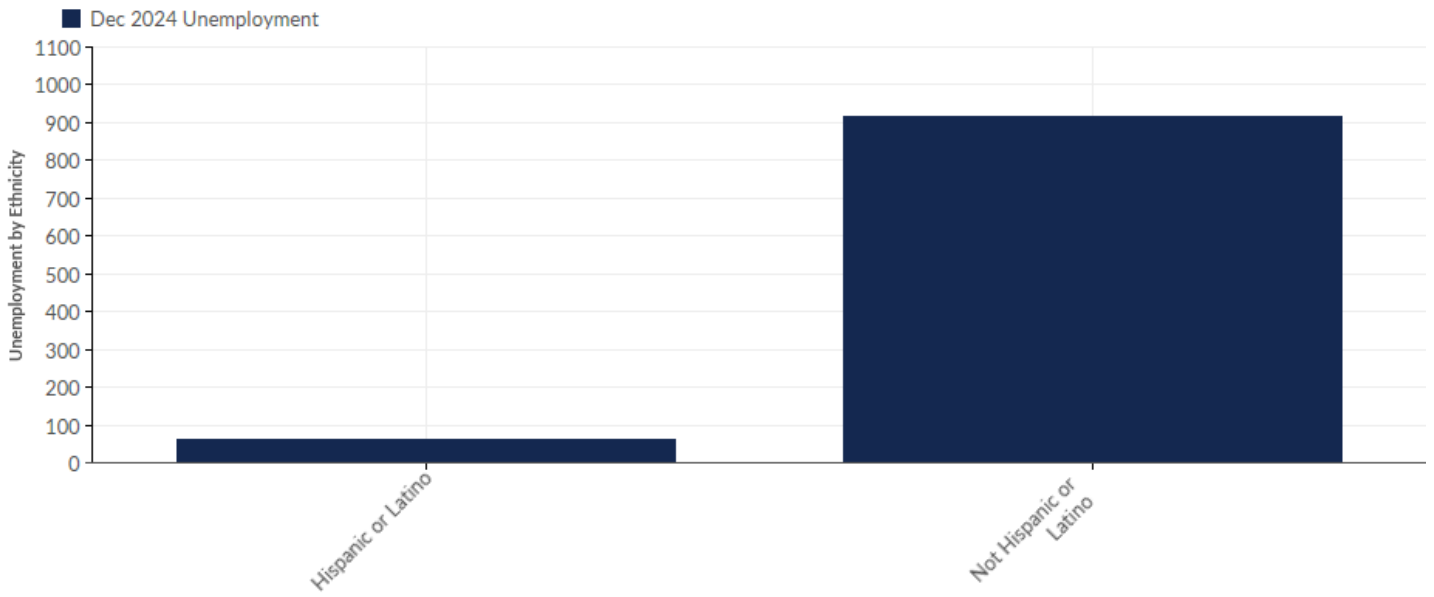

Unemployment by Ethnicity

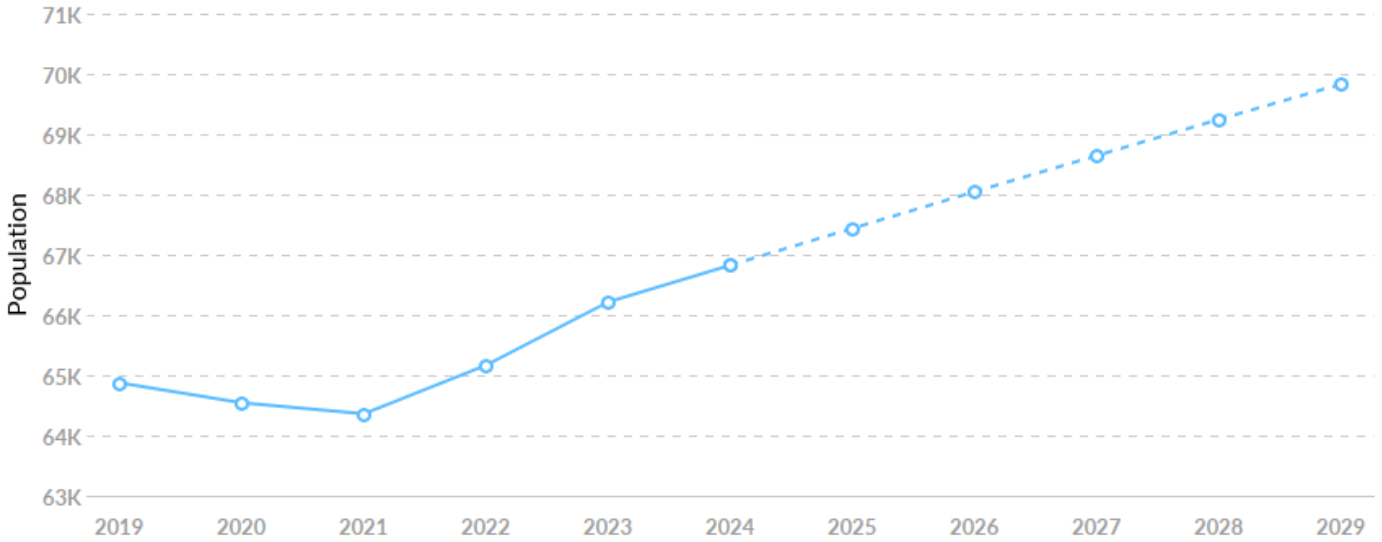

Population Trends

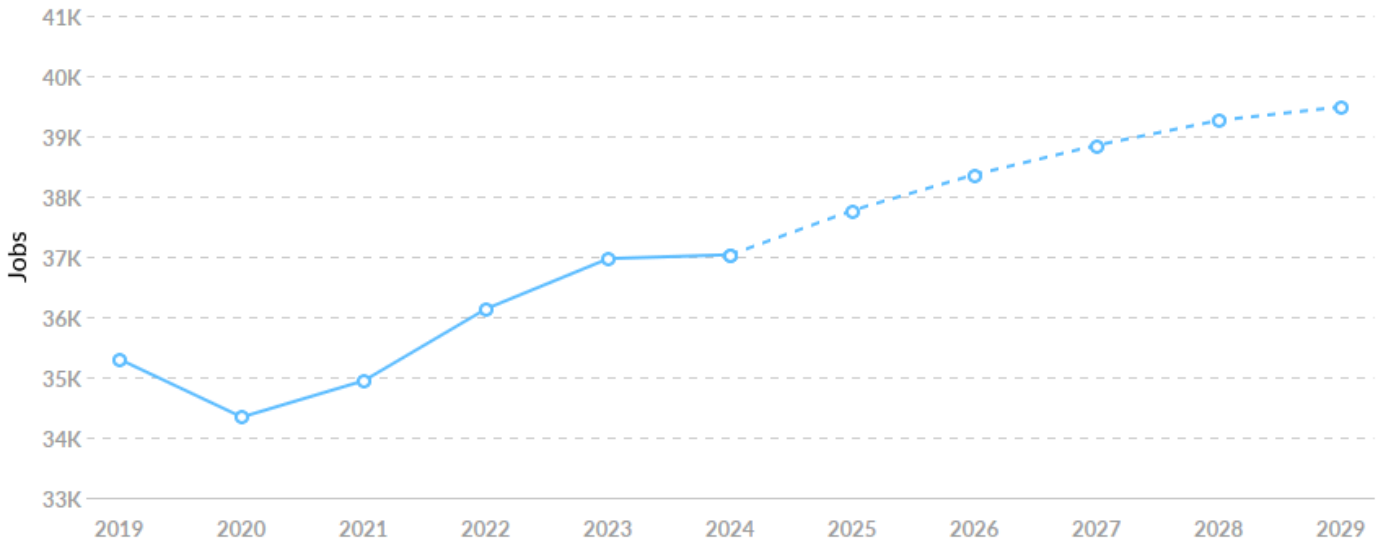

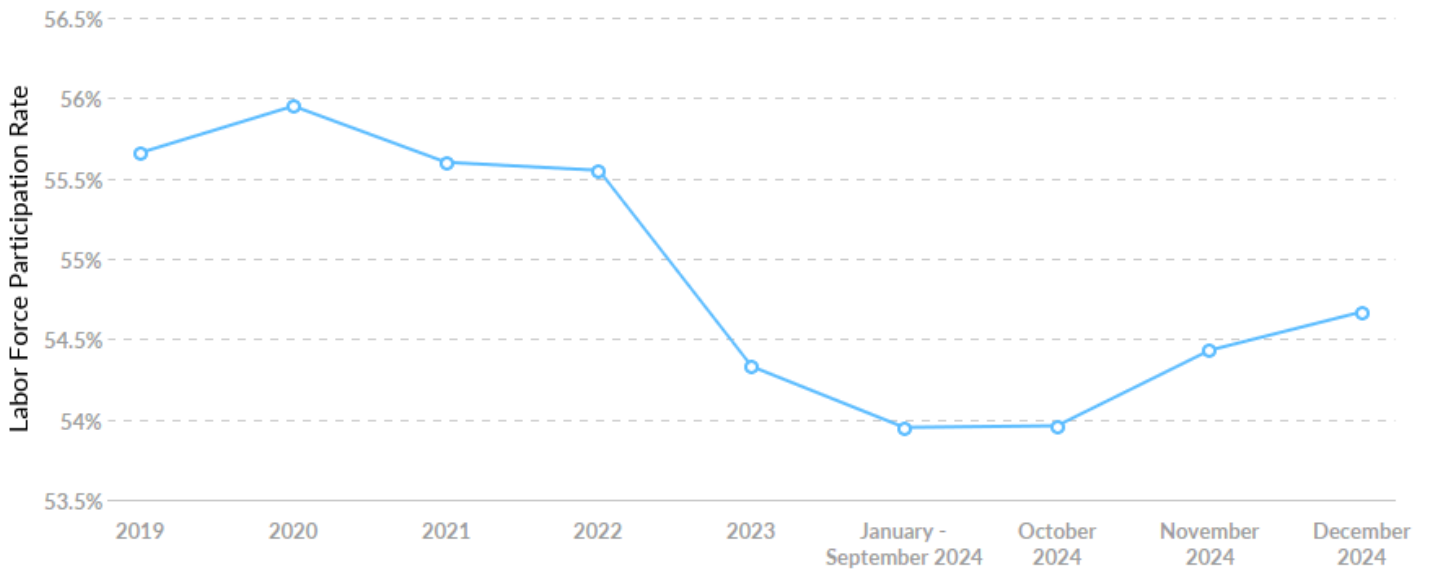
Job Trends

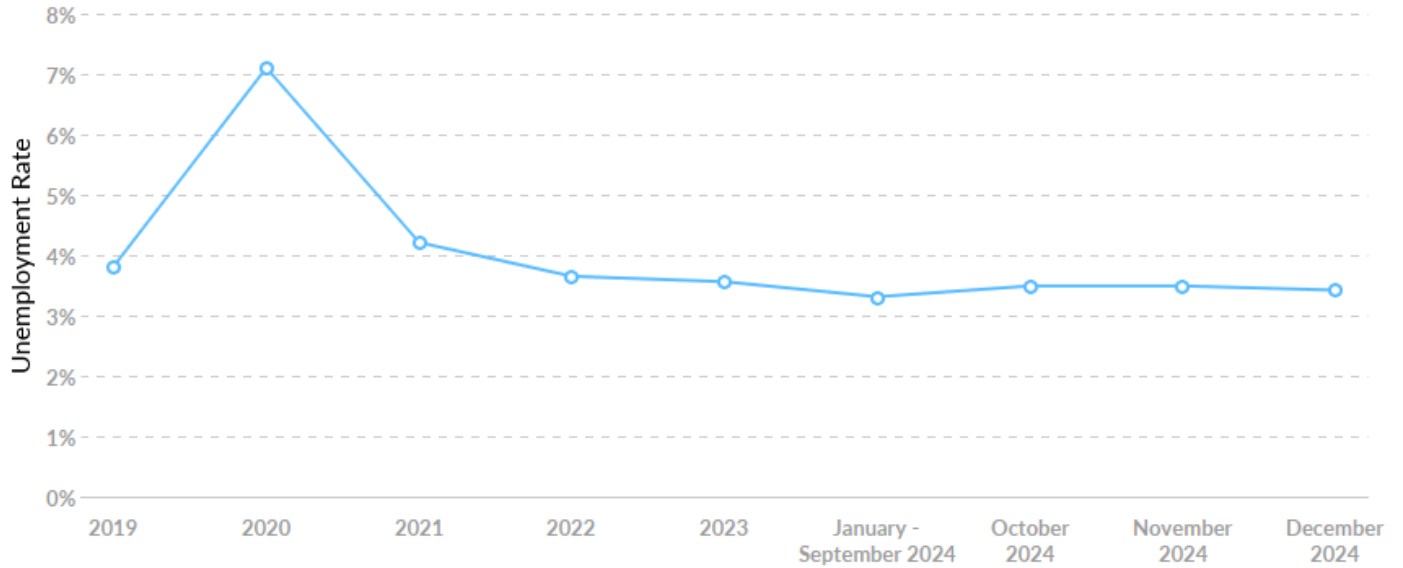

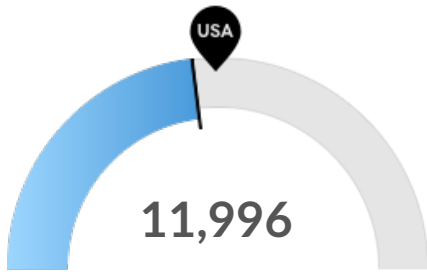
Unemployment Rate Trends

Hamblen County, TN had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 3.42%, **decreasing from 3.81%** 5 years before.



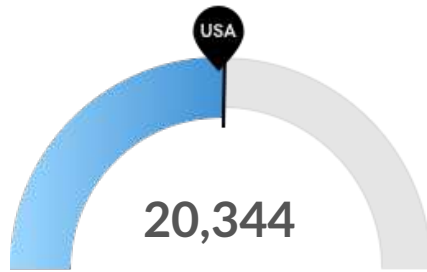

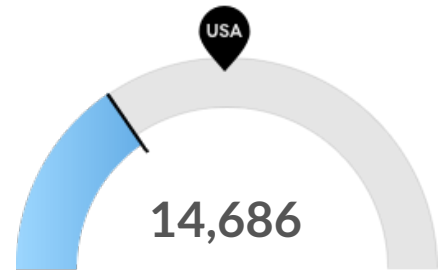
Millennials

Hamblen County, TN has 11,996 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 13,454.



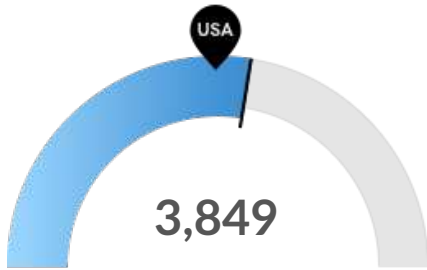
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Hamblen County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 19,989 people 55 or older, while there are 20,344 here.



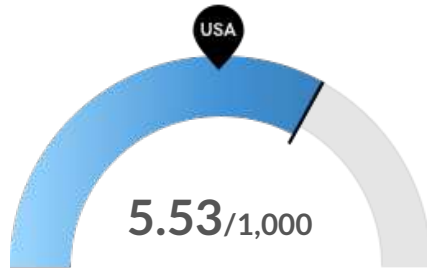
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Hamblen County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 27,577 racially diverse people, while there are 14,686 here.



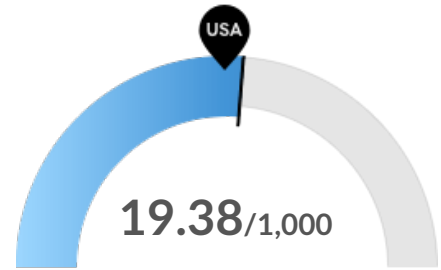
Veterans

Hamblen County, TN has 5.53 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

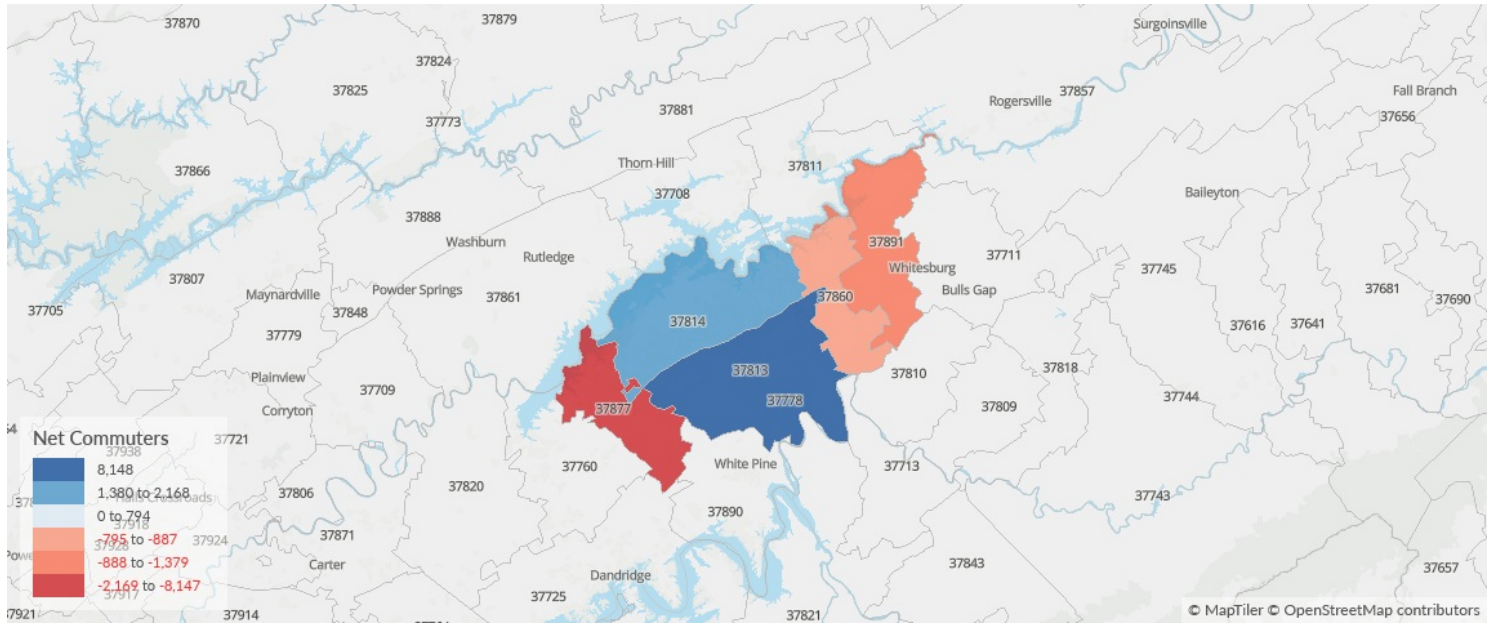


Property Crime

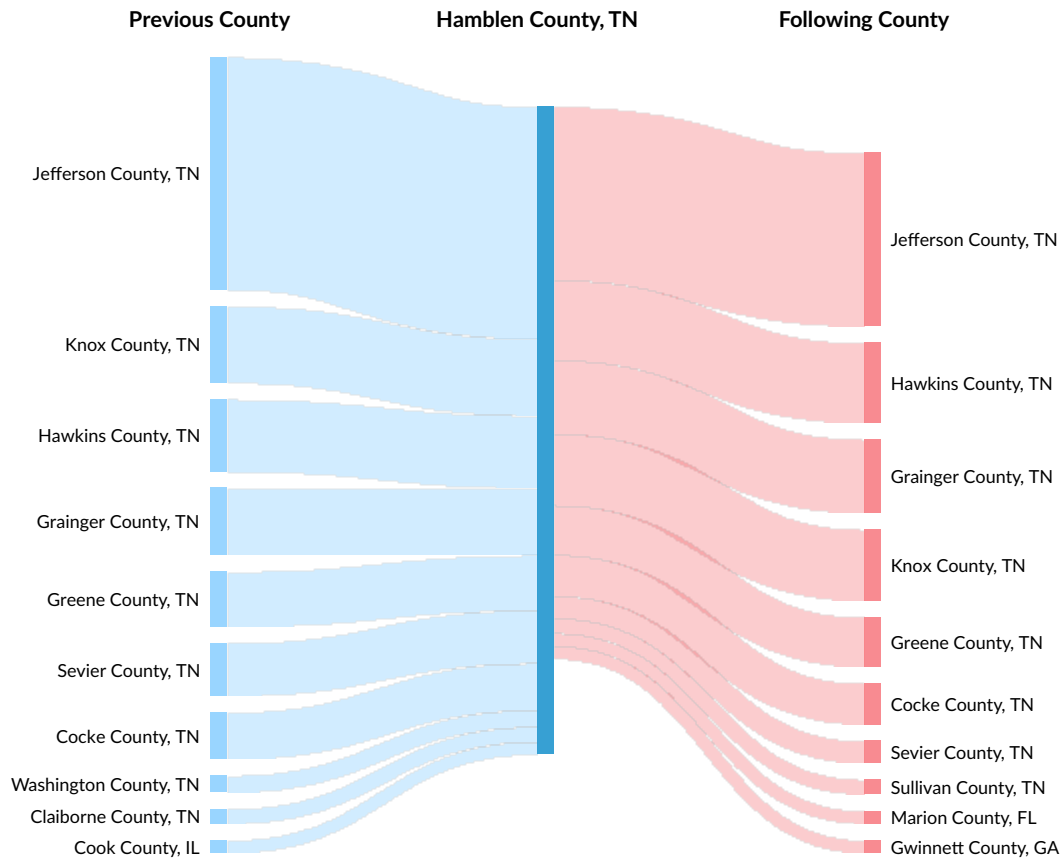

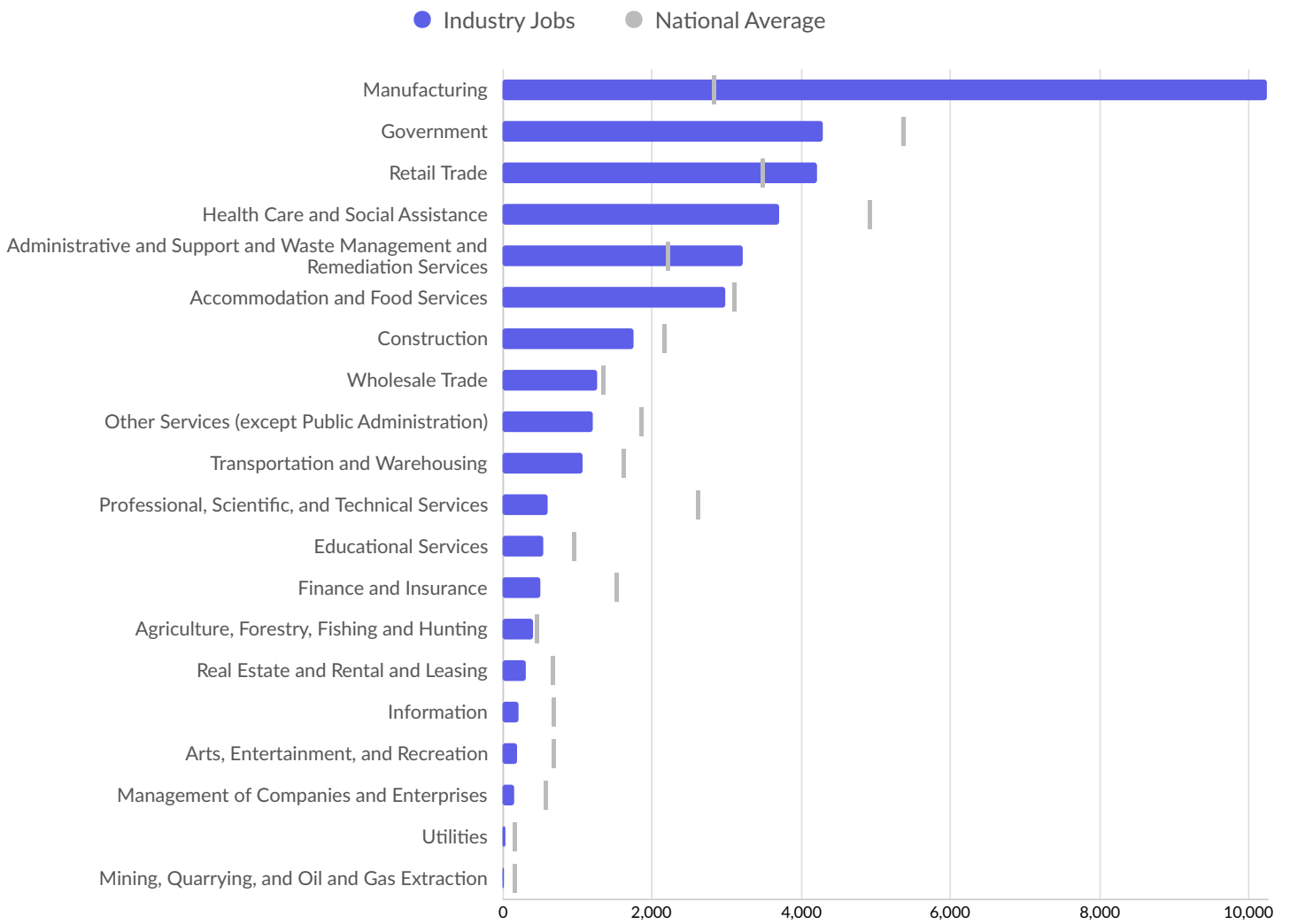

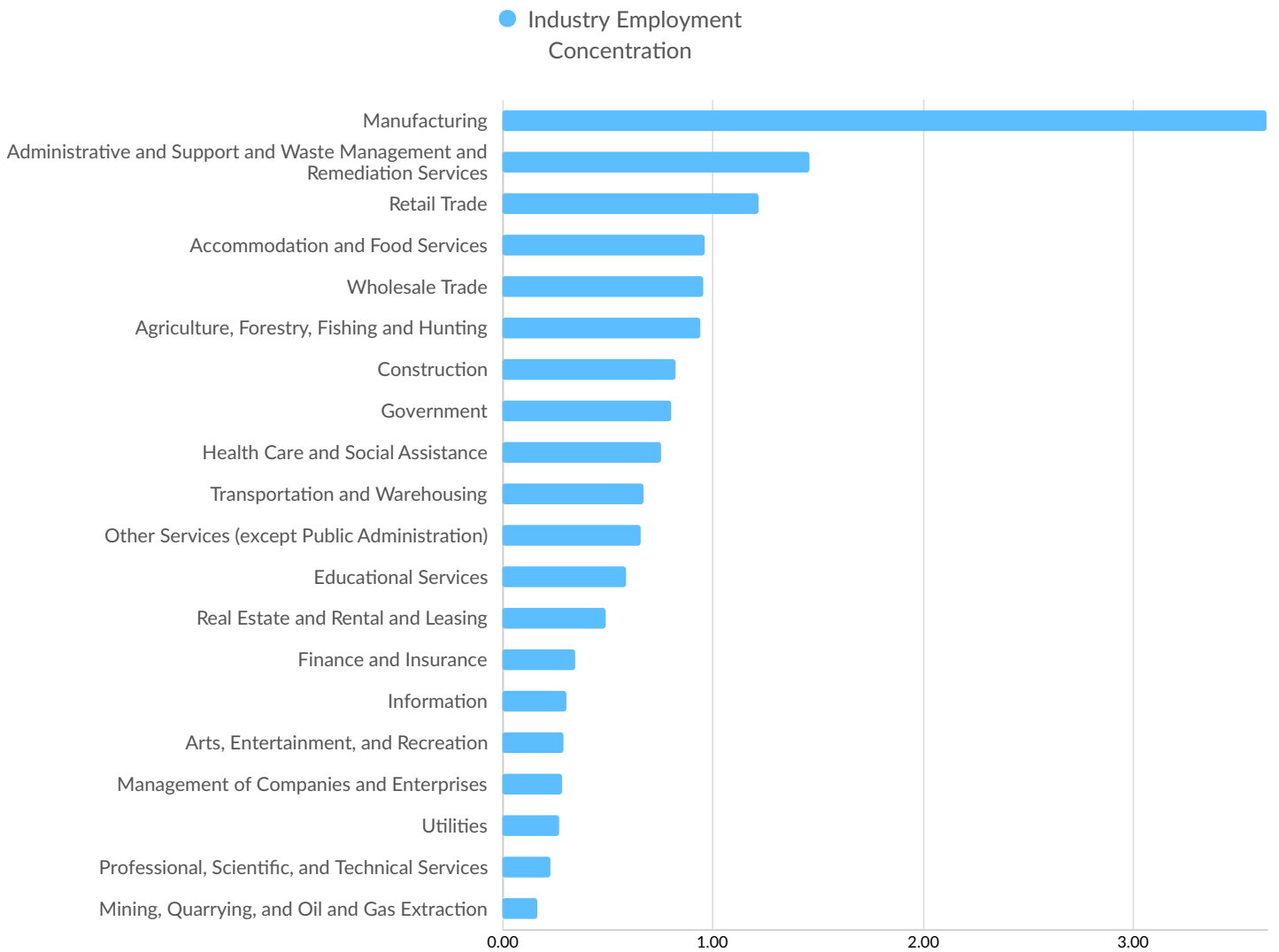

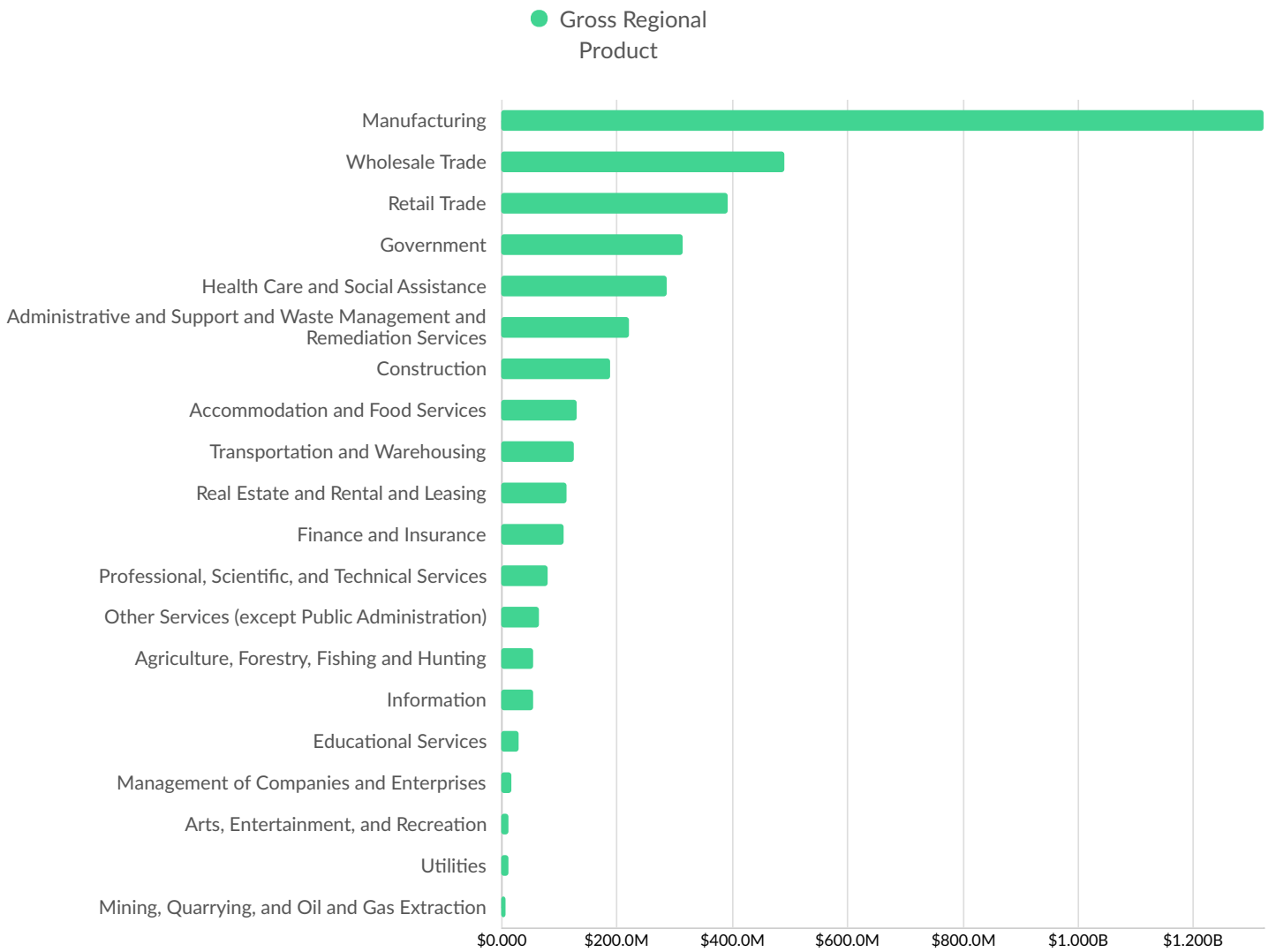
Top Growing Industries



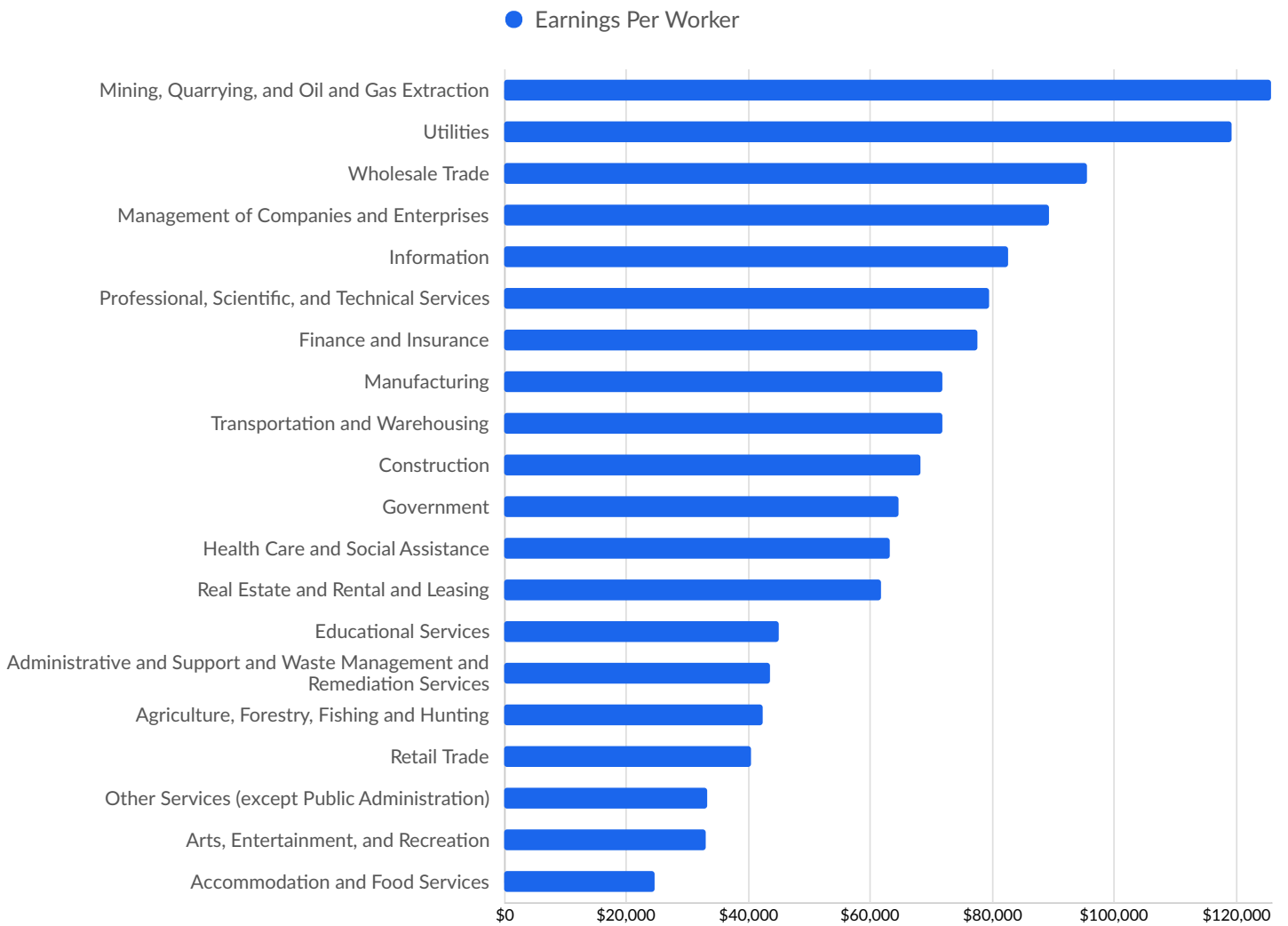
Top Industry Employment Concentration

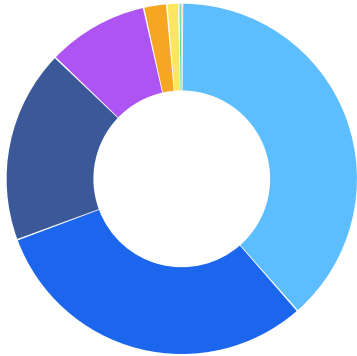

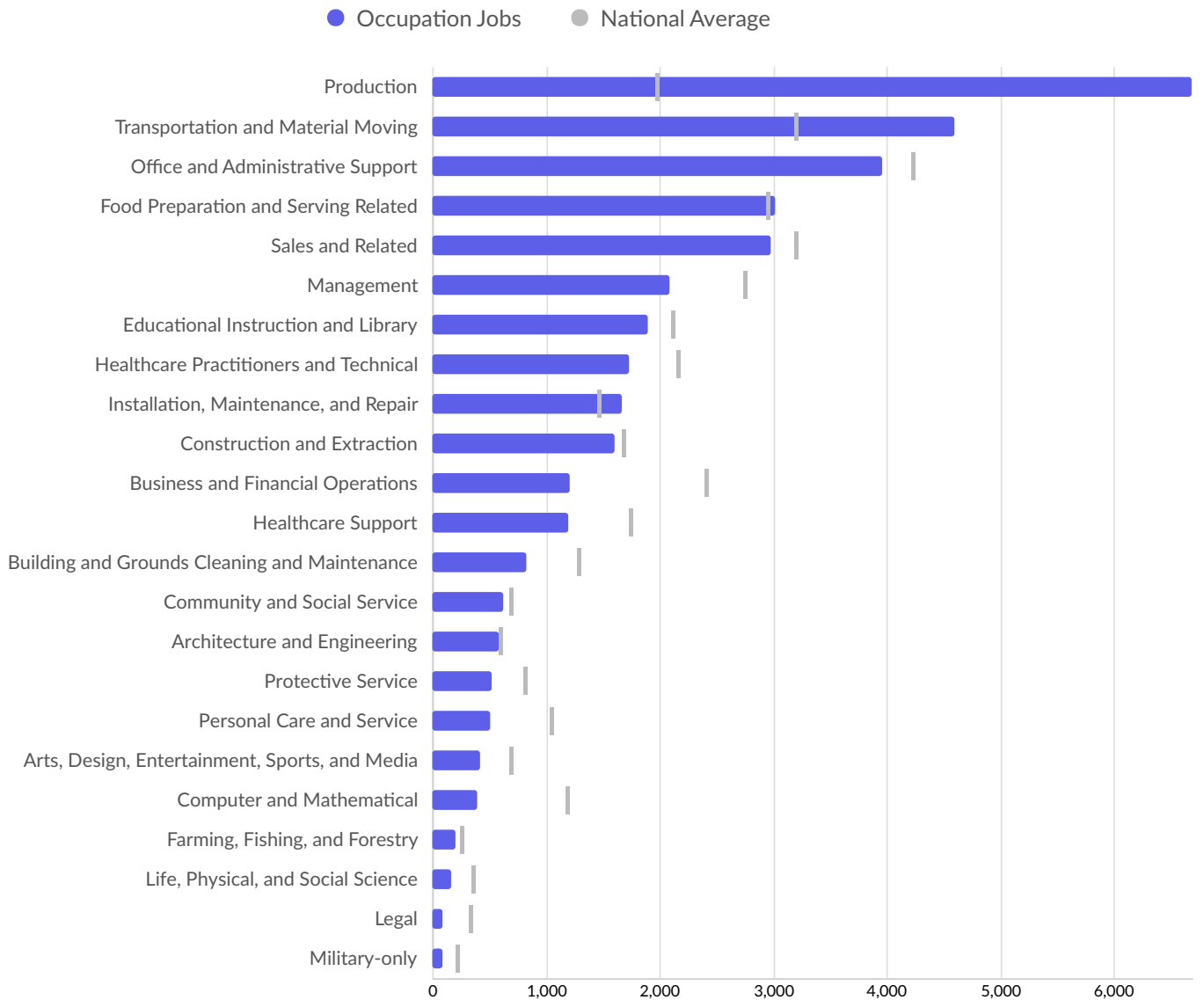

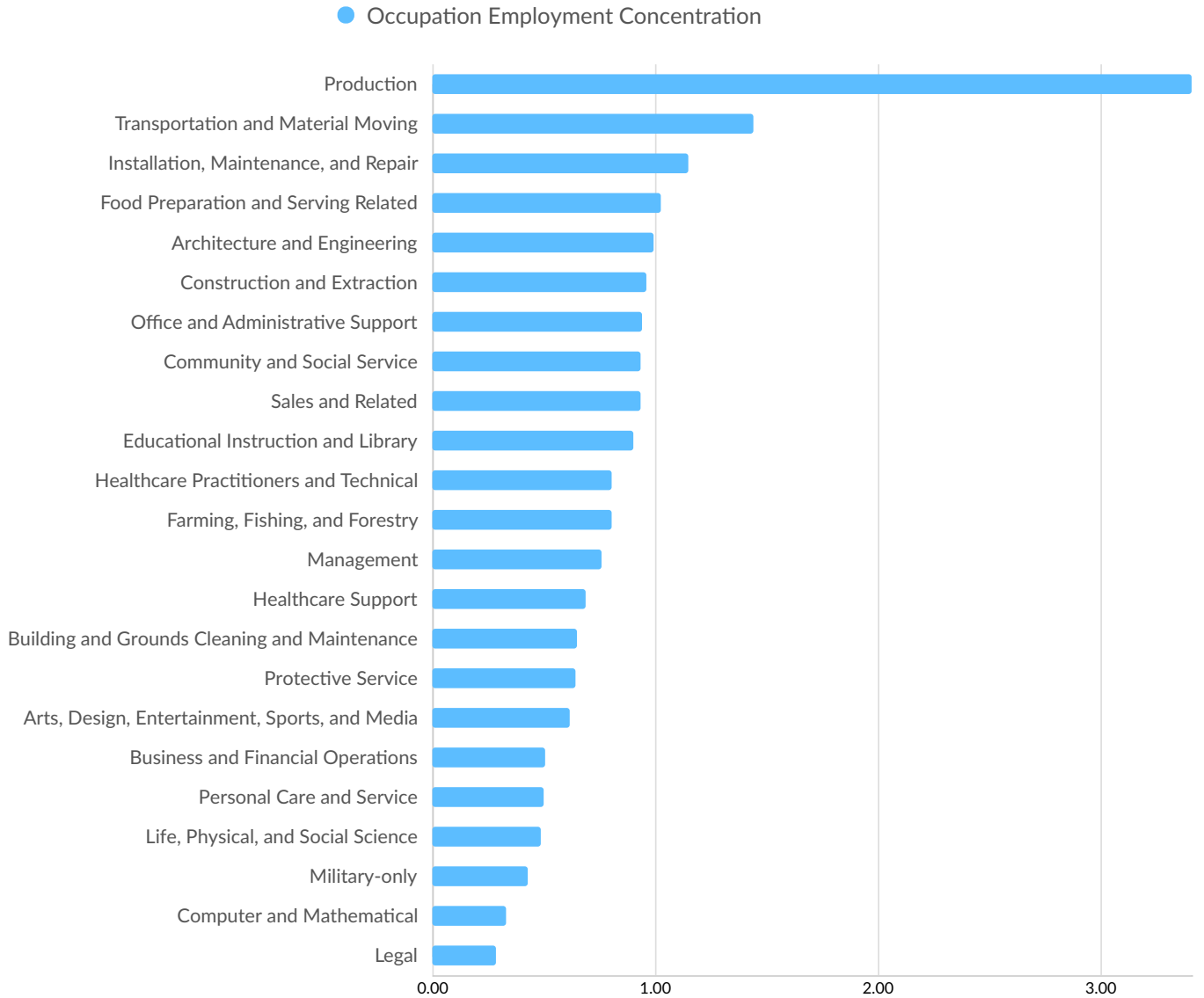
Largest Occupations



Top Growing Occupations



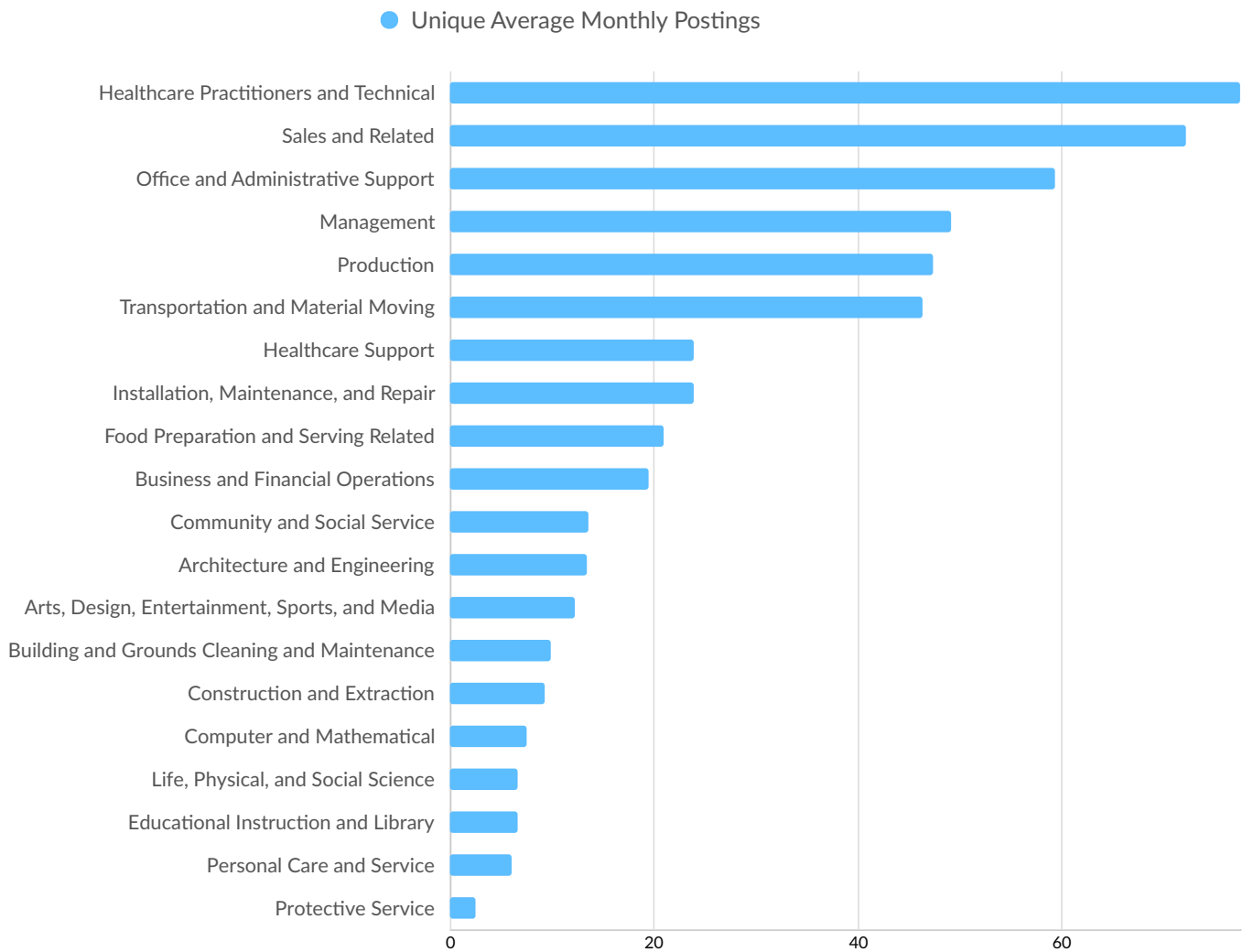
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



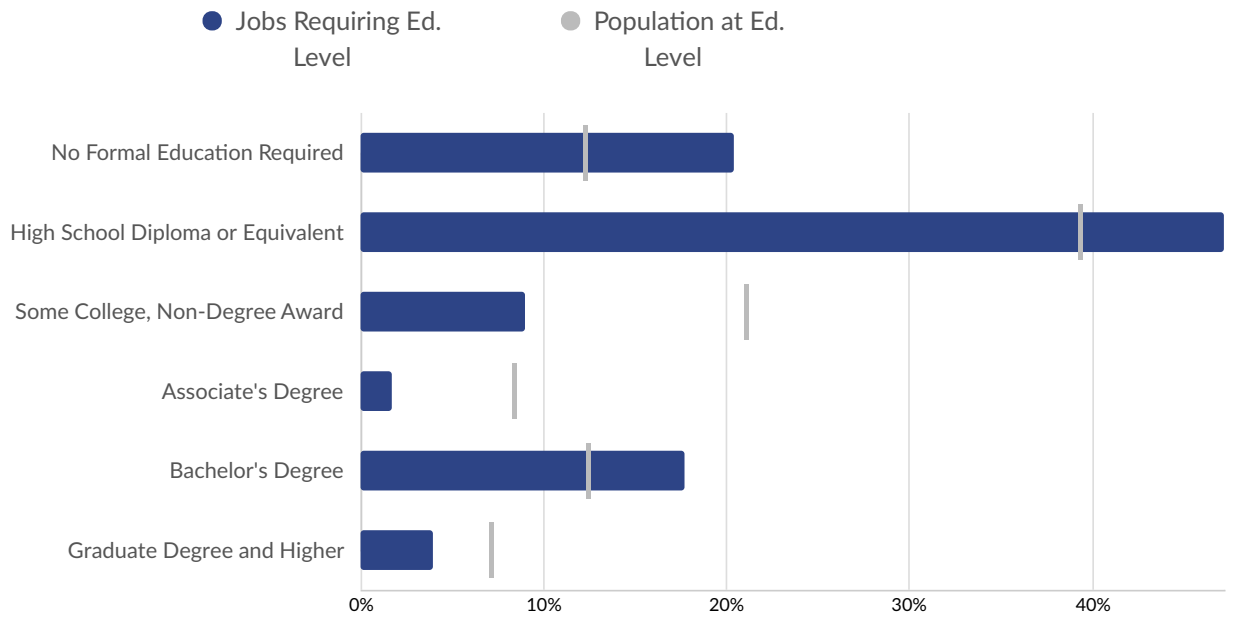
Top Occupation Earnings

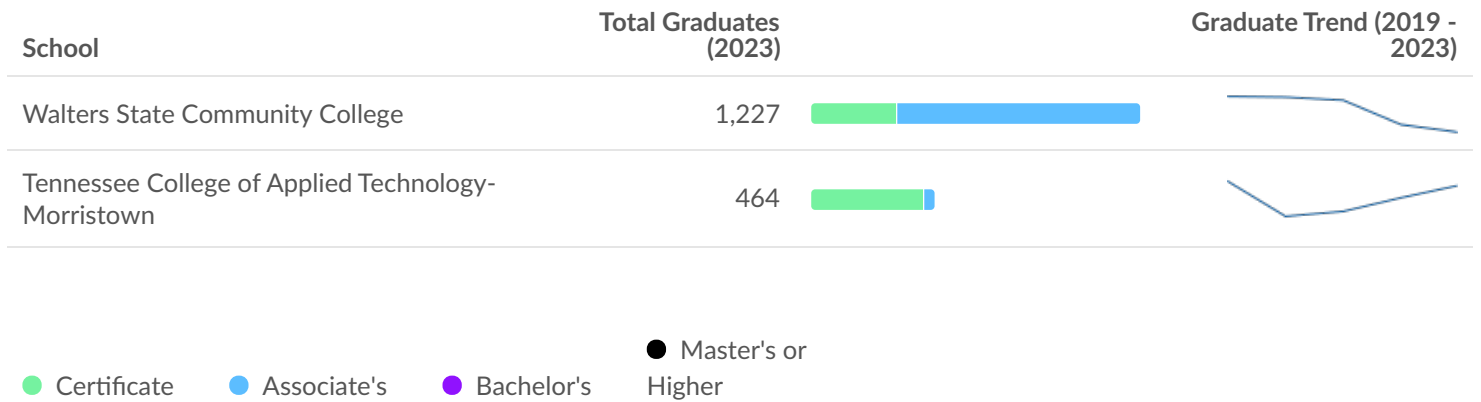
