- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 7.1% since 2018, growing by 3,849. Population is expected to increase by 8.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 4,816.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 6.0% in Jefferson County, TN from 15,607 to 16,551. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 1.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.4% to 52.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.8% of Jefferson County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.4% below the national average), and **9.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are General Freight Trucking, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity






Population Trends





Jefferson County, TN had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.71%, increasing from 3.65% 5 years before.






Millennials

Jefferson County, TN has 9,954 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,752.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Jefferson County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 17,460 people 55 or older, while there are 21,168 here.




Racial Diversity


Jefferson County, TN has 2.52 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration




