- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 7.7% in Knox County, TN from 268,993 to 289,785. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 3.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.0% to 62.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.1% of Knox County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.0% above the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.




Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Knox County, TN had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.10%, increasing from 2.86% 5 years before.






Millennials

Knox County, TN has 102,318 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 101,728.




Knox County, TN has 28,282 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 25,327.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Knox County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 151,140 people 55 or older, while there are 141,926 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Knox County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 208,514 racially diverse people, while there are 99,972 here.




Property Crime








Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




