- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 7.6% since 2018, growing by 35,593. Population is expected to increase by 7.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 35,853.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 6.5% in Knox County, TN from 268,995 to 286,451. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 2.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.5% to 63.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.1% of Knox County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.0% above the national average), and **9.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.




Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Knox County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.97%, increasing from 2.93% 5 years before.



Millennials


Knox County, TN has 100,560 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 100,565.



Veterans


Knox County, TN has 28,662

veterans. The national average for an area this size is 25,557.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Knox County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 148,215 people 55 or older, while there are 141,410 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Knox County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 203,389 racially diverse people, while there are 92,706 here.




Property Crime









Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration







Educational Pipeline

In 2022, there were 13,532 graduates in Knox County, TN. This pipeline has grown by 13% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Bachelor's), and "Logistics, Materials, and Supply Chain Management" (Bachelor's).
