
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 4.1% since 2018, growing by 2,212. Population is expected to increase by 3.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,675.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 7.7% in Roane County, TN from 20,523 to 22,103. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 53.0% to 53.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.4% of Roane County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.7% below the national average), and **9.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Scientific Research and Development Services, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Roane County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.81%, decreasing from 4.10% 5 years before.



Millennials


Roane County, TN has 9,084 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,200.






Veterans

Roane County, TN has 4,601 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,838.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Roane County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 16,507 people 55 or older, while there are 21,544 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Roane County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 22,652 racially diverse people, while there are 4,506 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration













Educational Pipeline

In 2022, there were 1,122 graduates in Roane County, TN. This pipeline has shrunk by 17% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate), and "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's).
