- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **increased by 1.4%** in Scott County, TN from 5,994 to **6,080**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 1.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 47.9% to 45.3% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.4% of Scott County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.4% below the national average), and **6.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

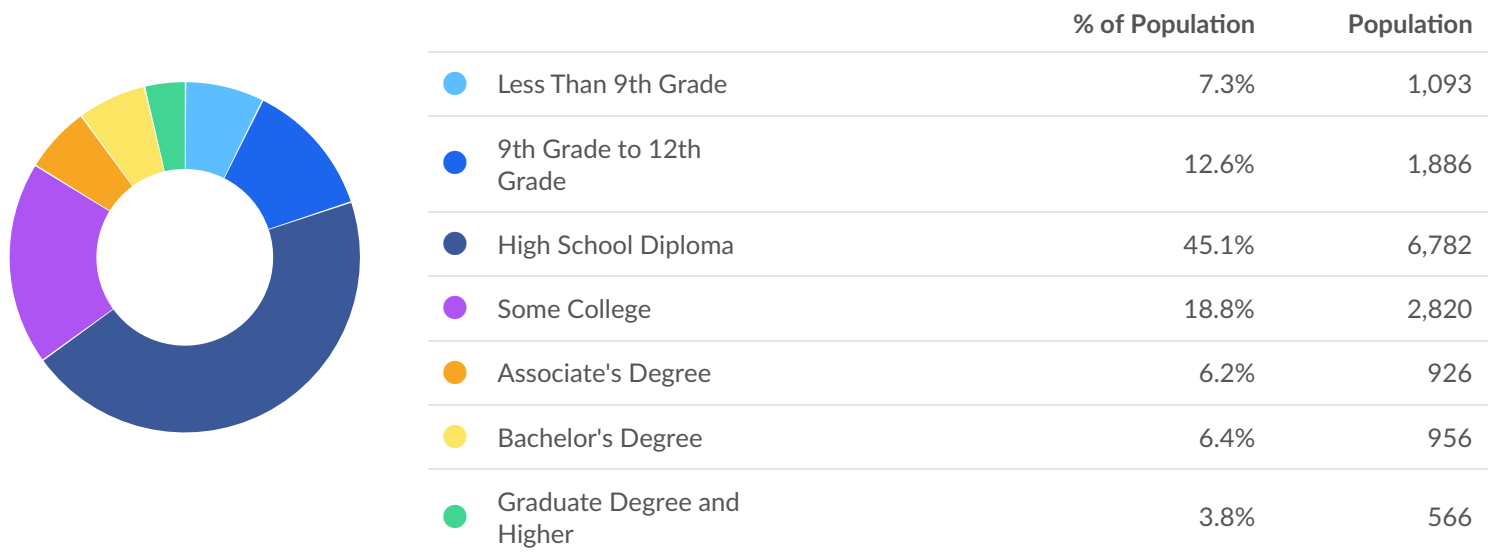

Dec 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



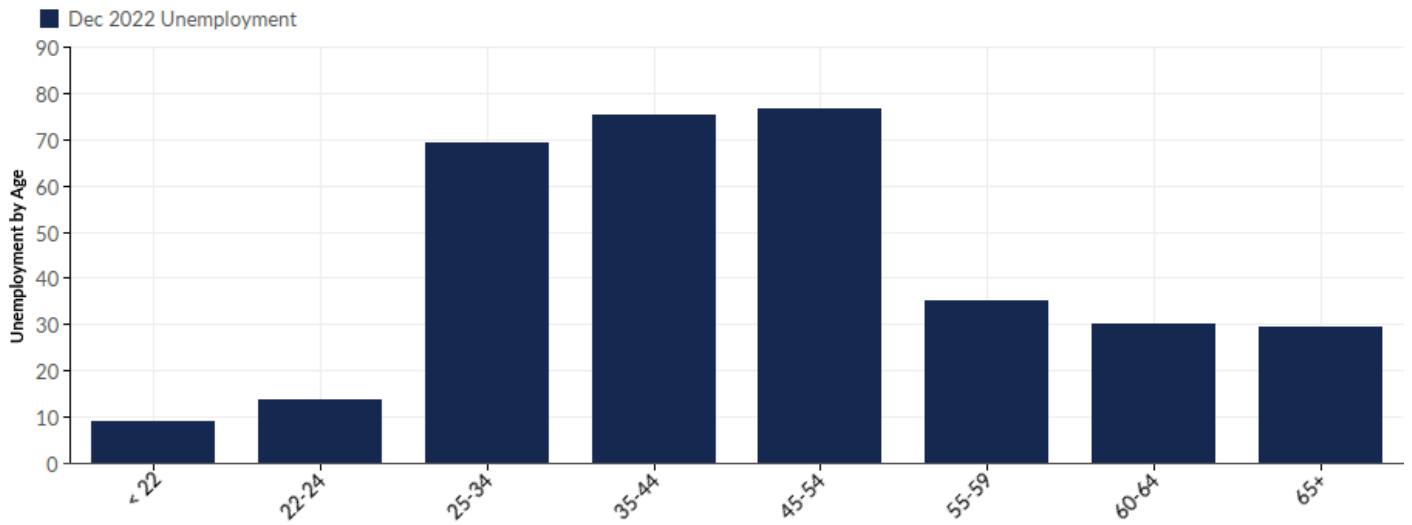
Educational Attainment

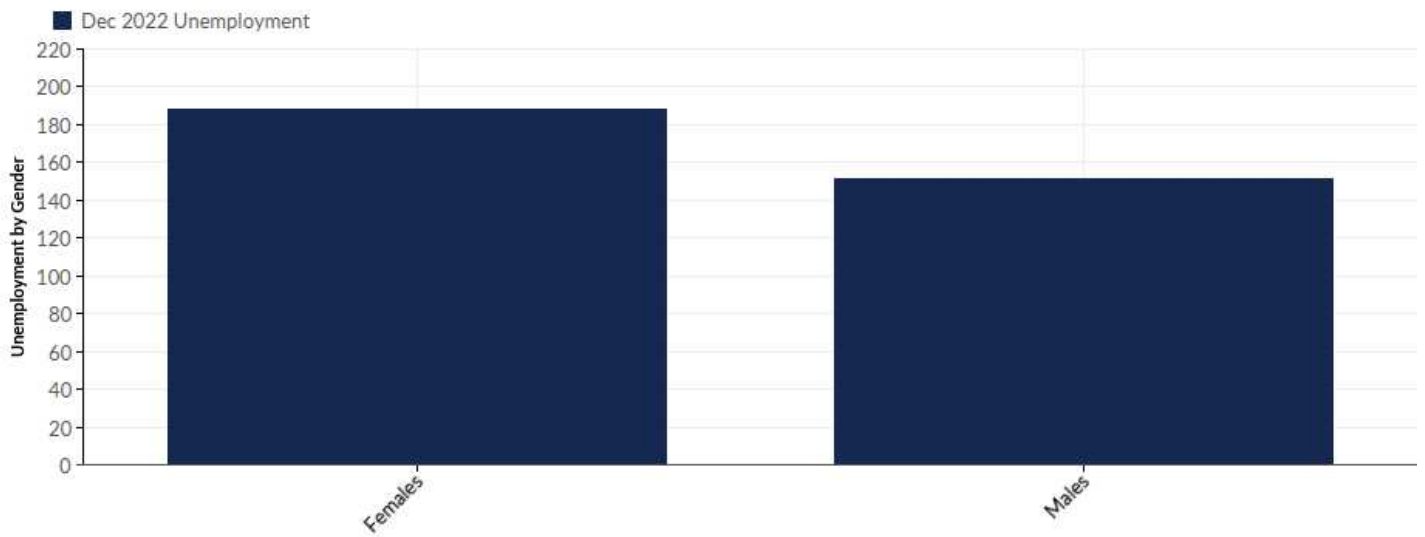

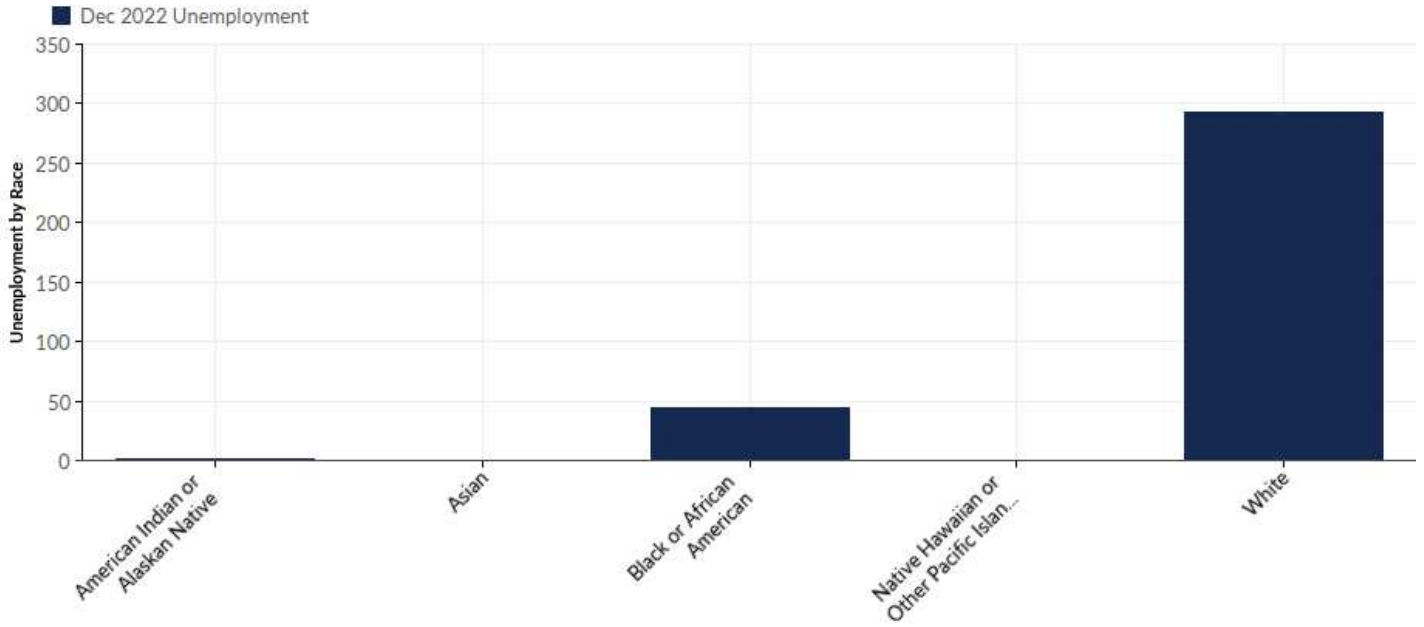

Unemployment by Gender



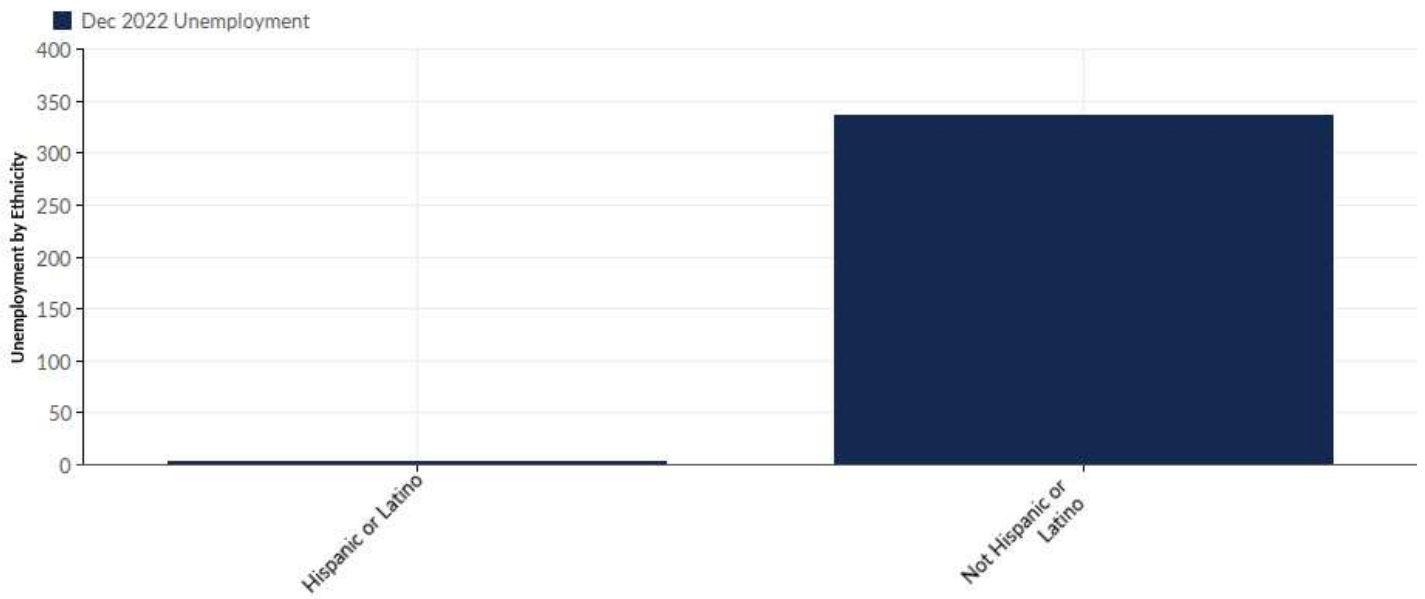

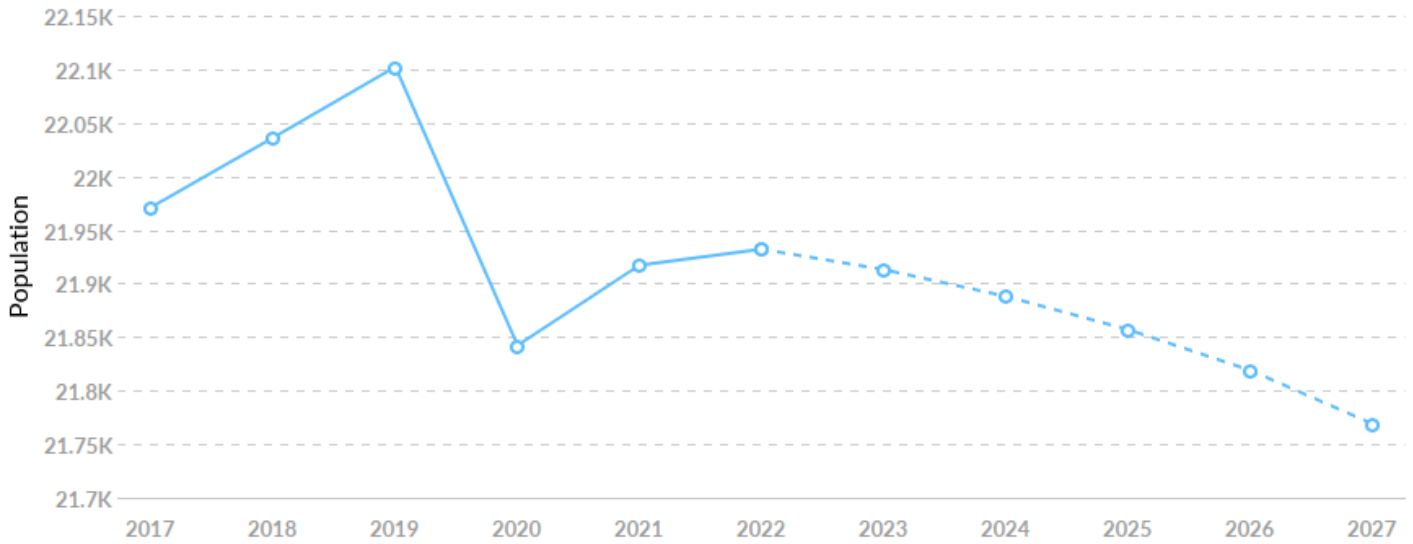

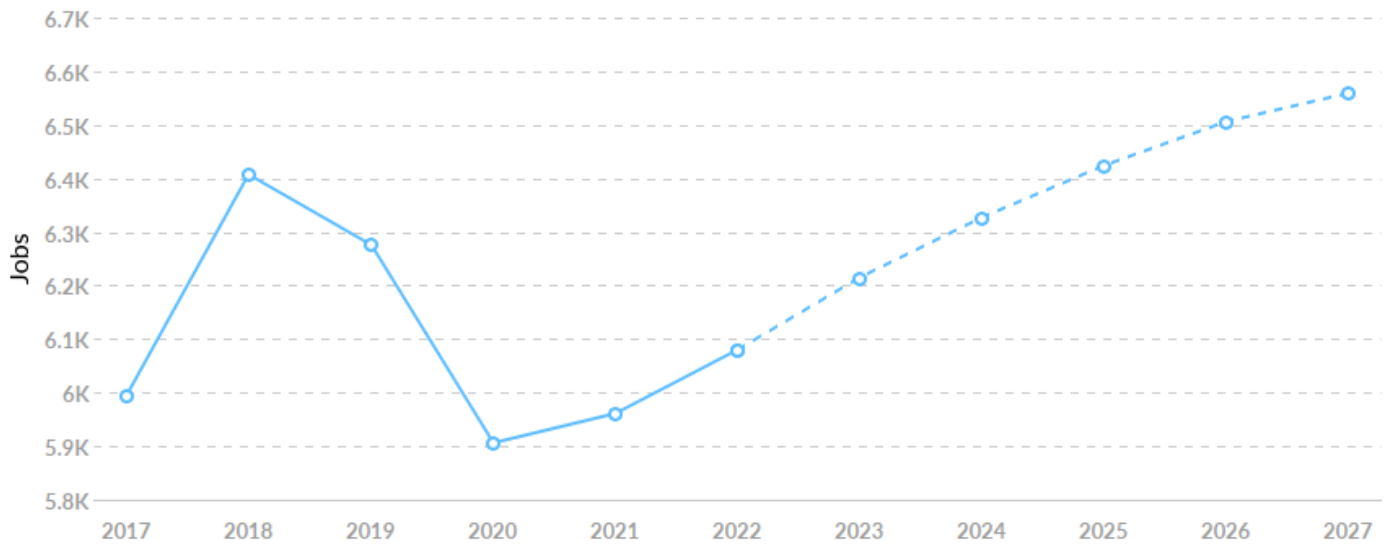

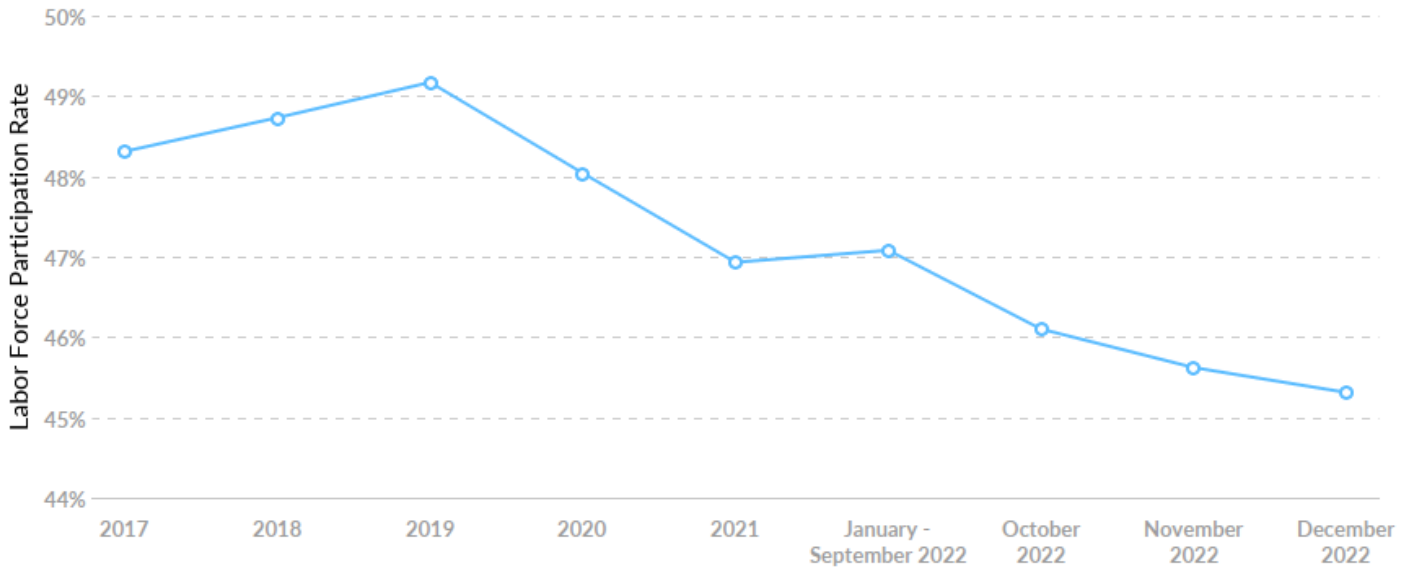
Job Trends

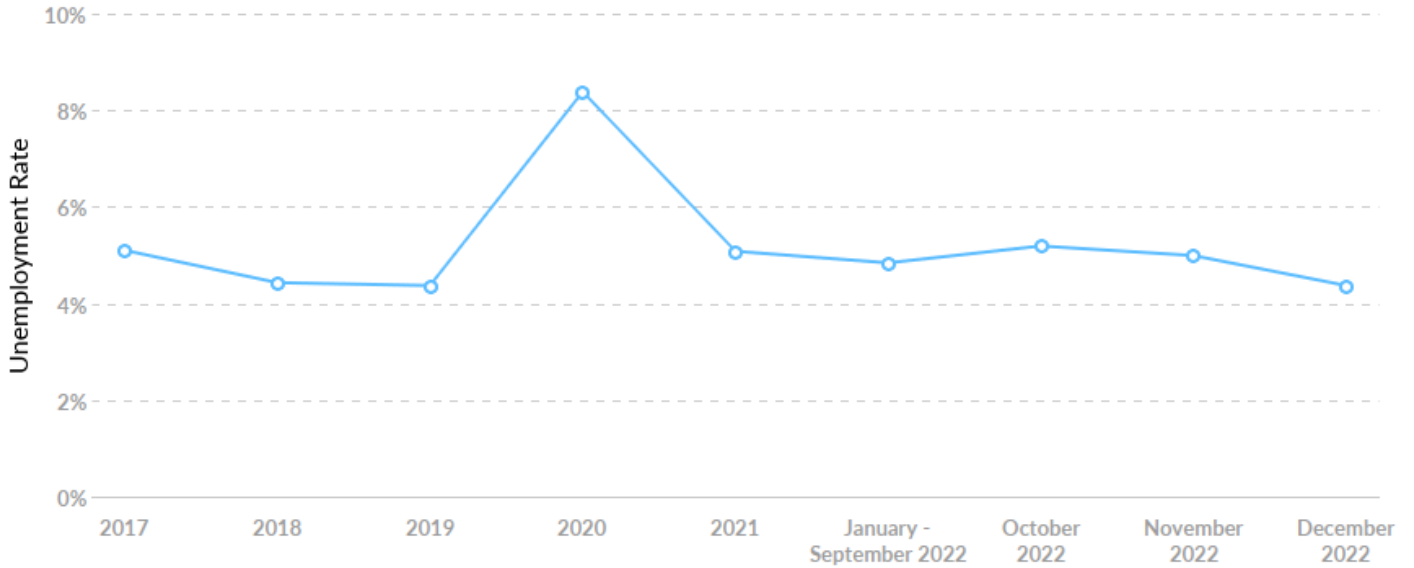

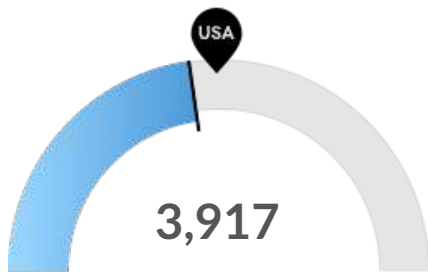
Unemployment Rate Trends

Scott County, TN had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 4.37%, **decreasing from 5.10%** 5 years before.



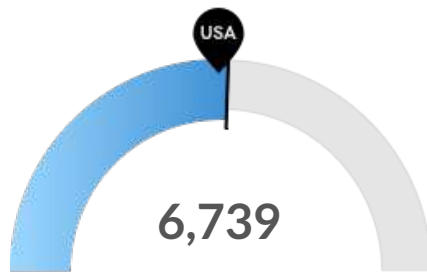

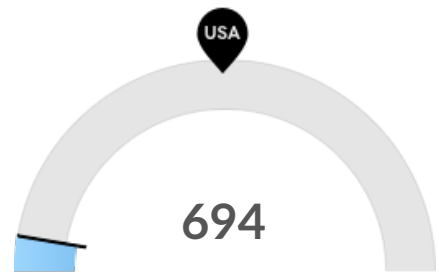
Millennials

Scott County, TN has 3,917 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,477.



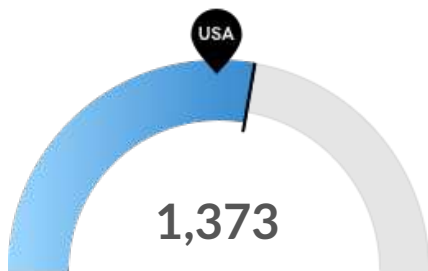
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 6,515 people 55 or older, while there are 6,739 here.



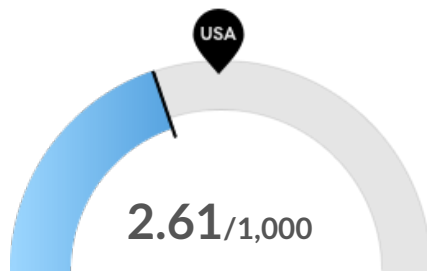
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 8,919 racially diverse people, while there are 694 here.



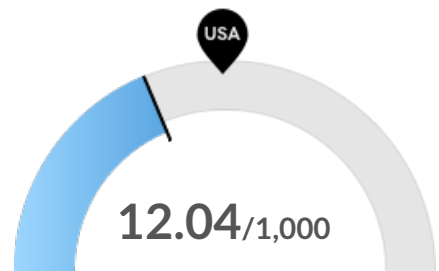
Veterans

Scott County, TN has 2.61 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

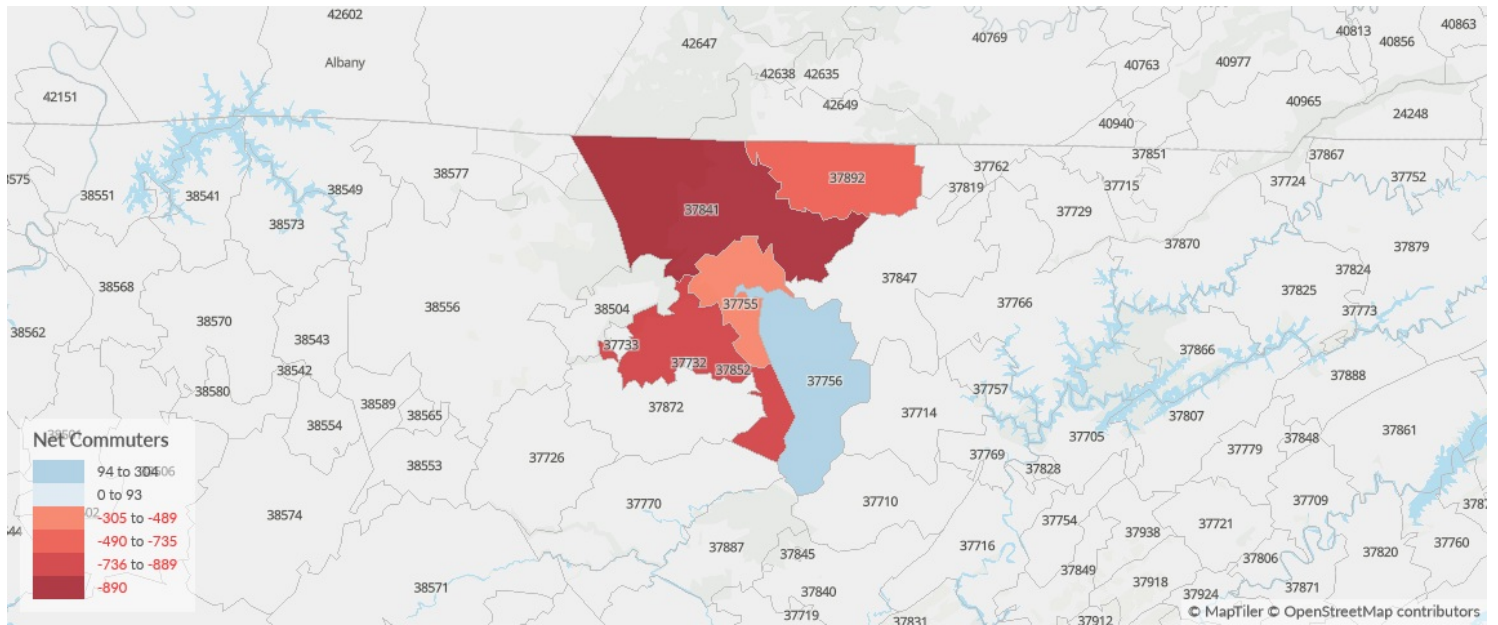


Property Crime

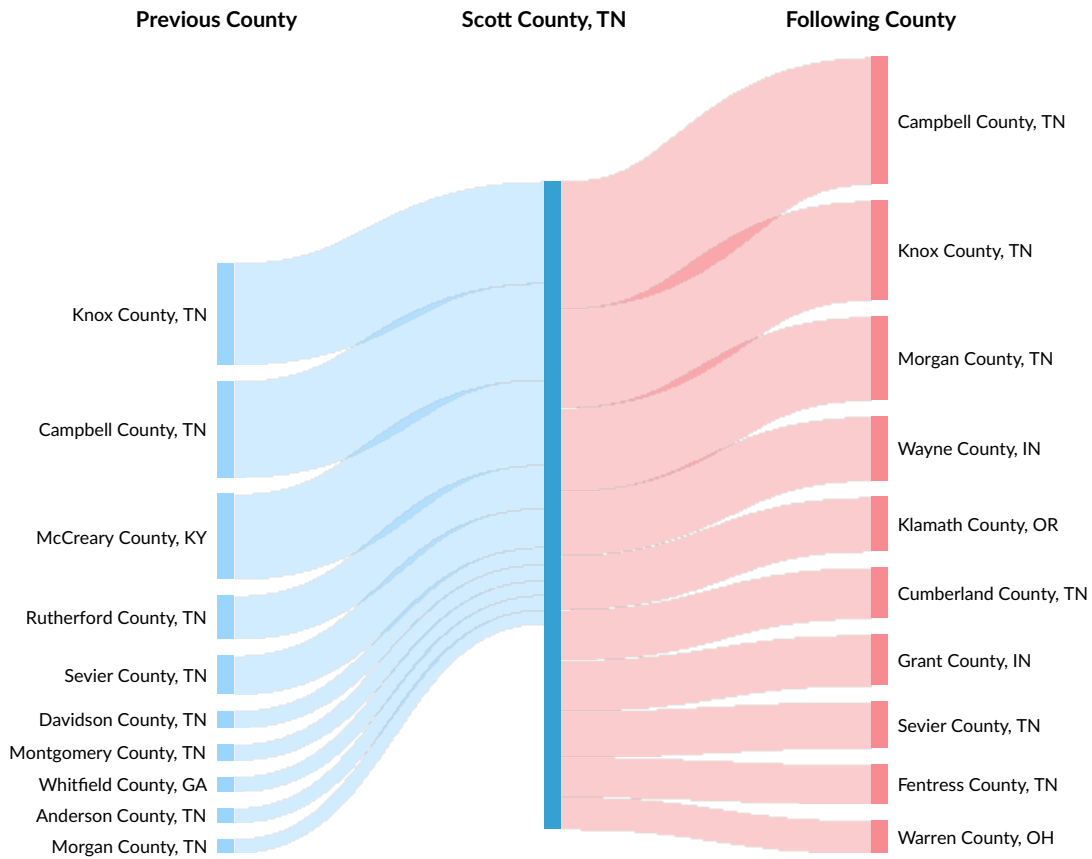

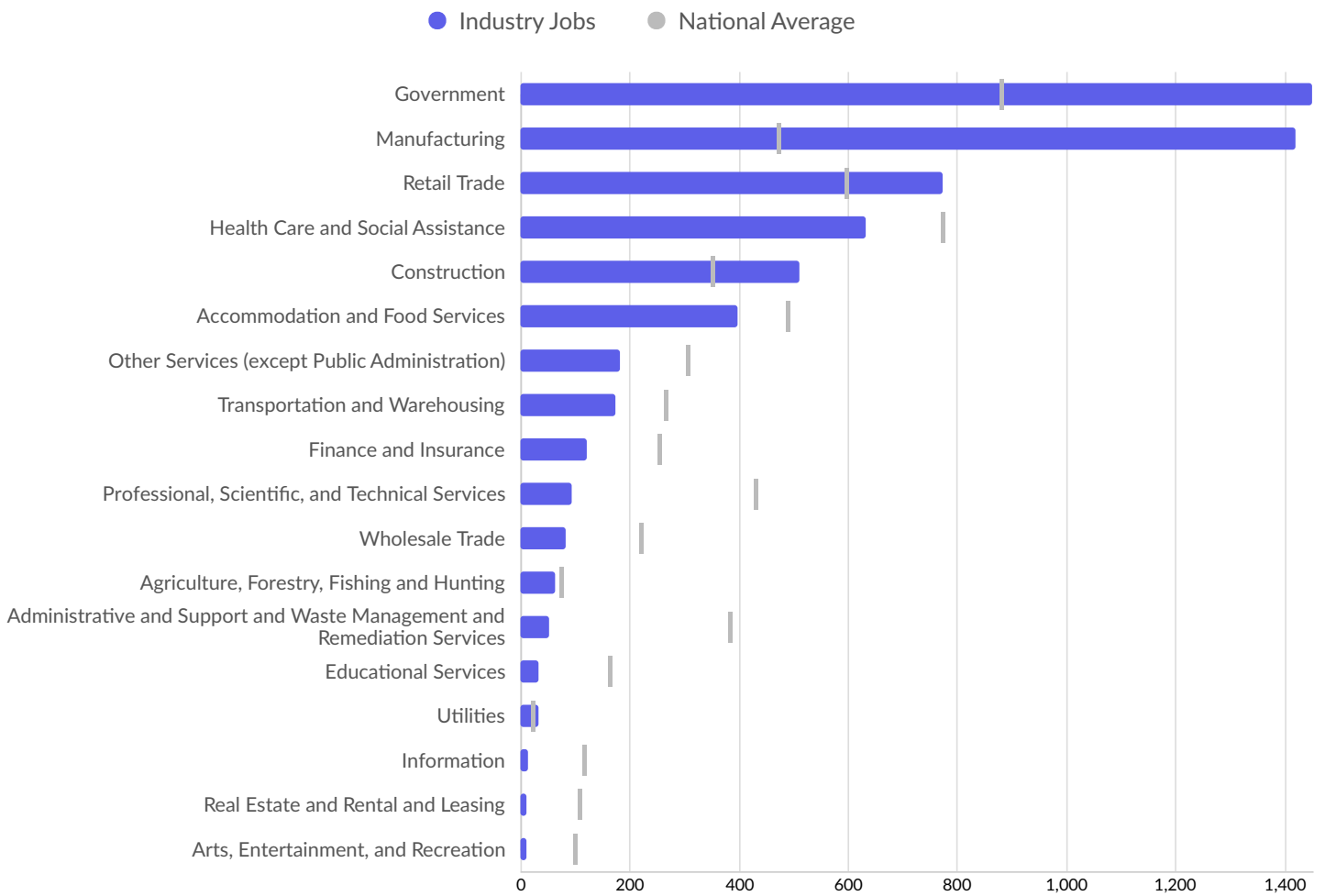

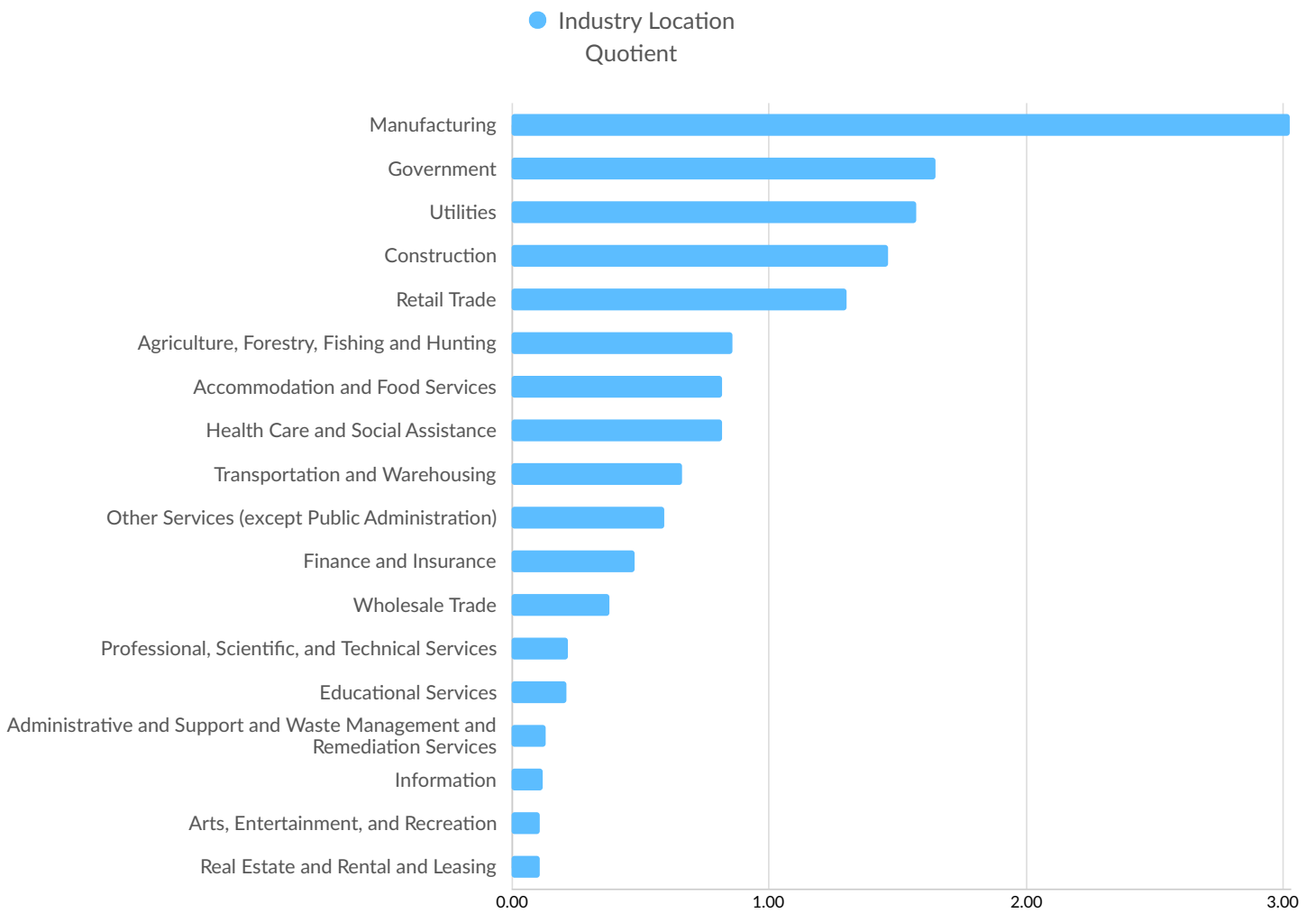

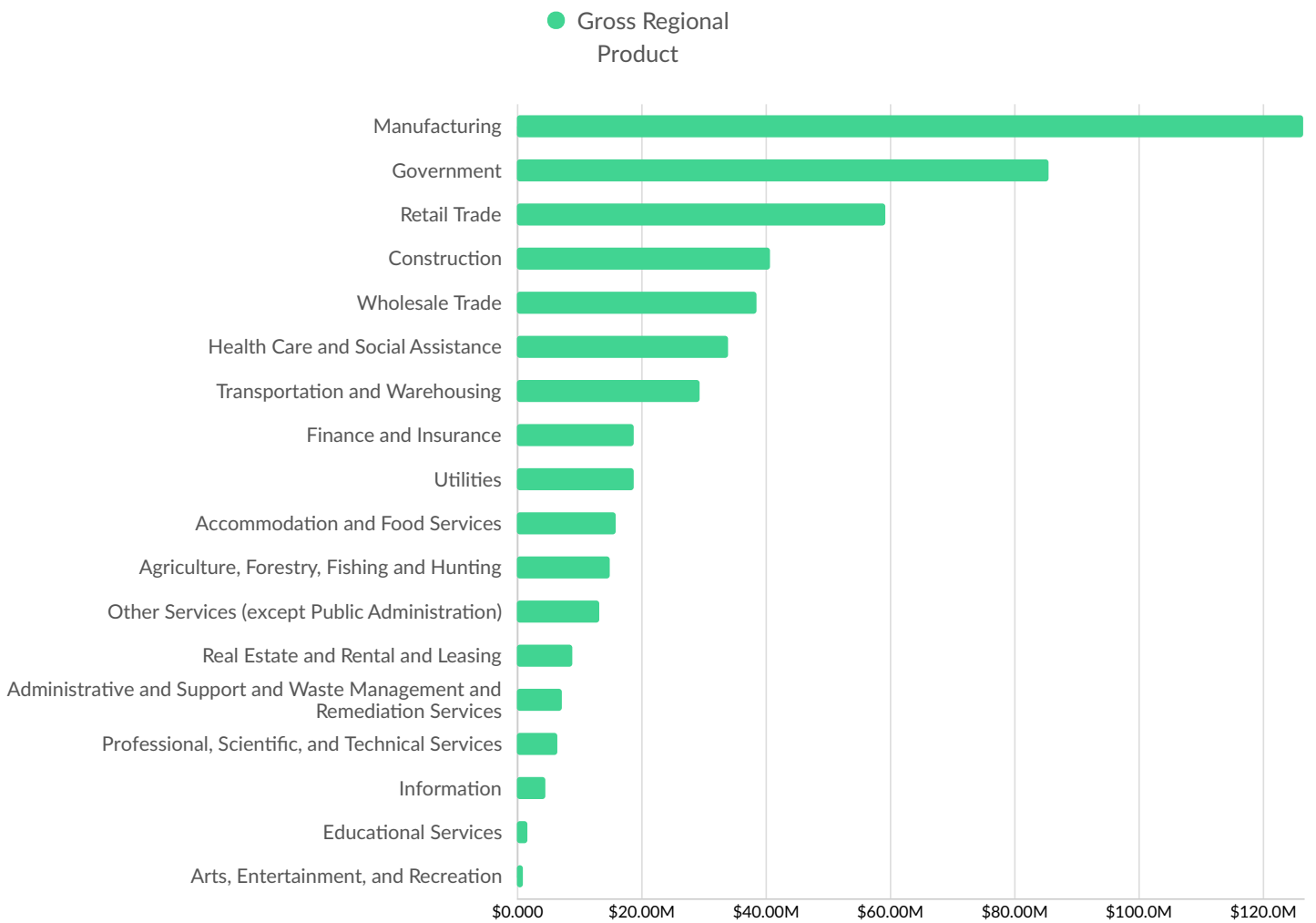
Top Growing Industries



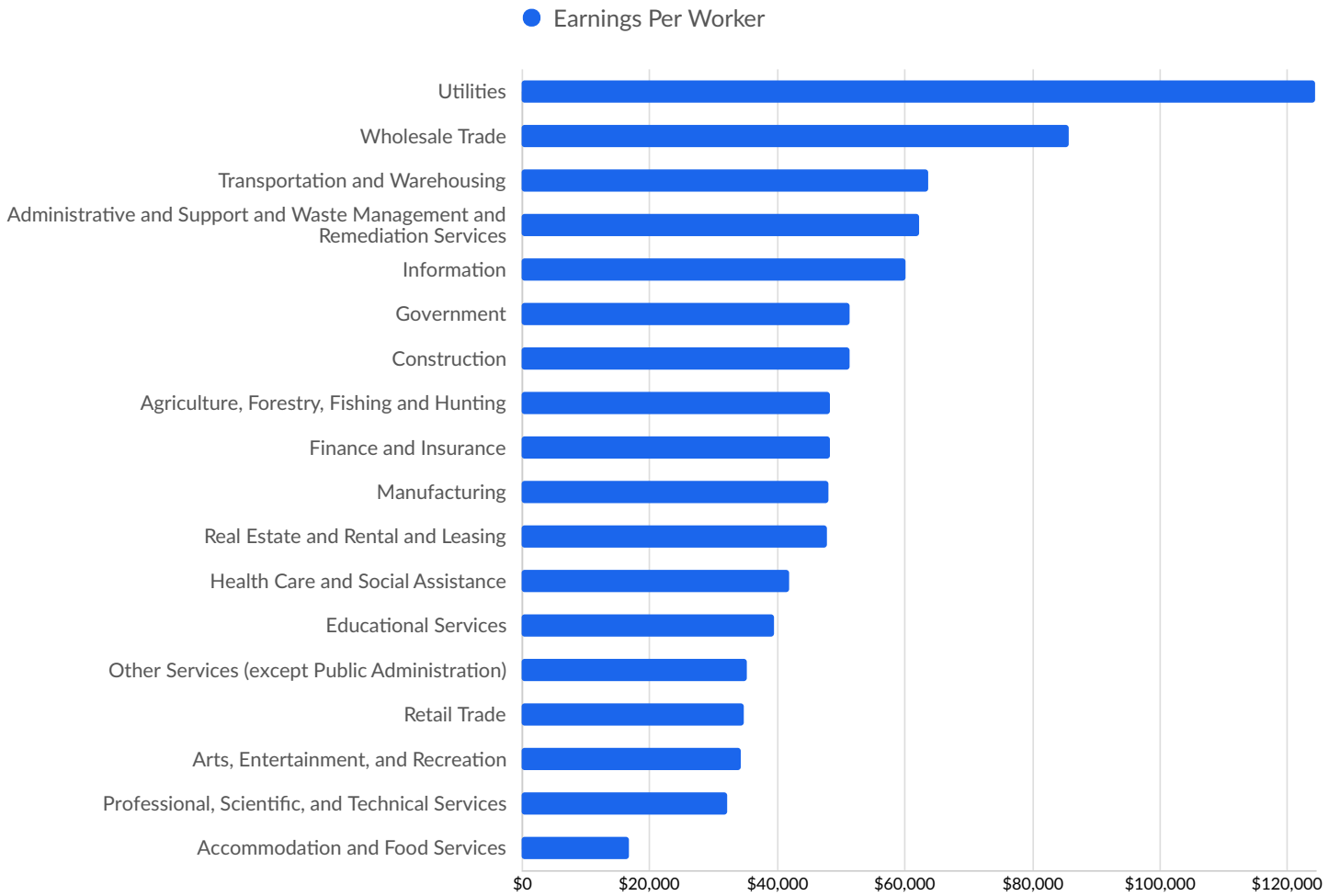
Top Industry Location Quotient

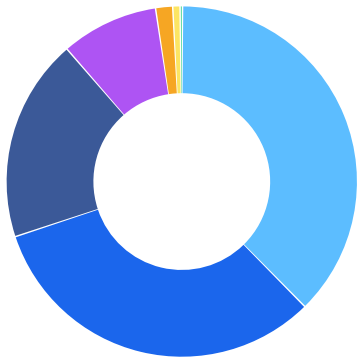

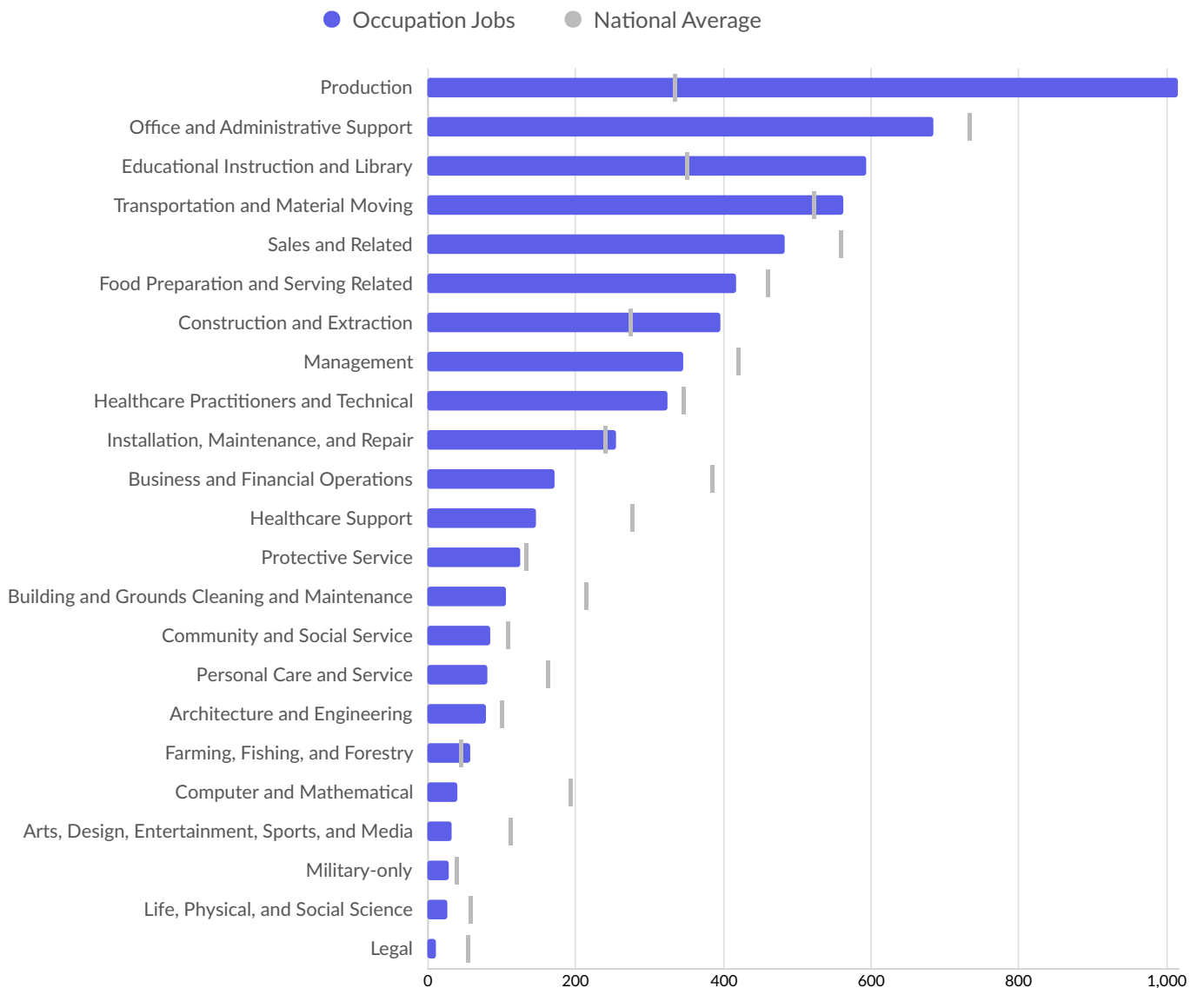

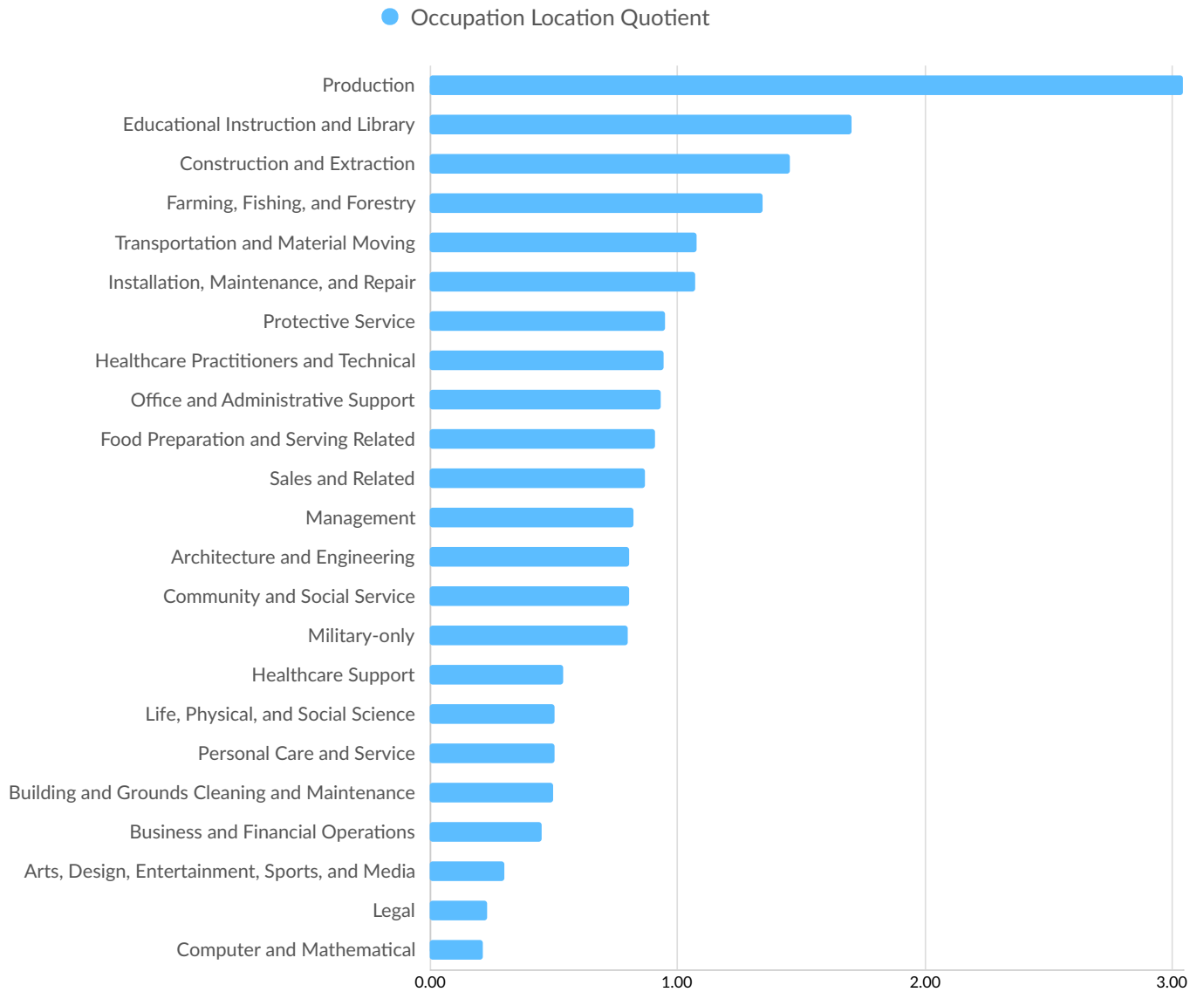

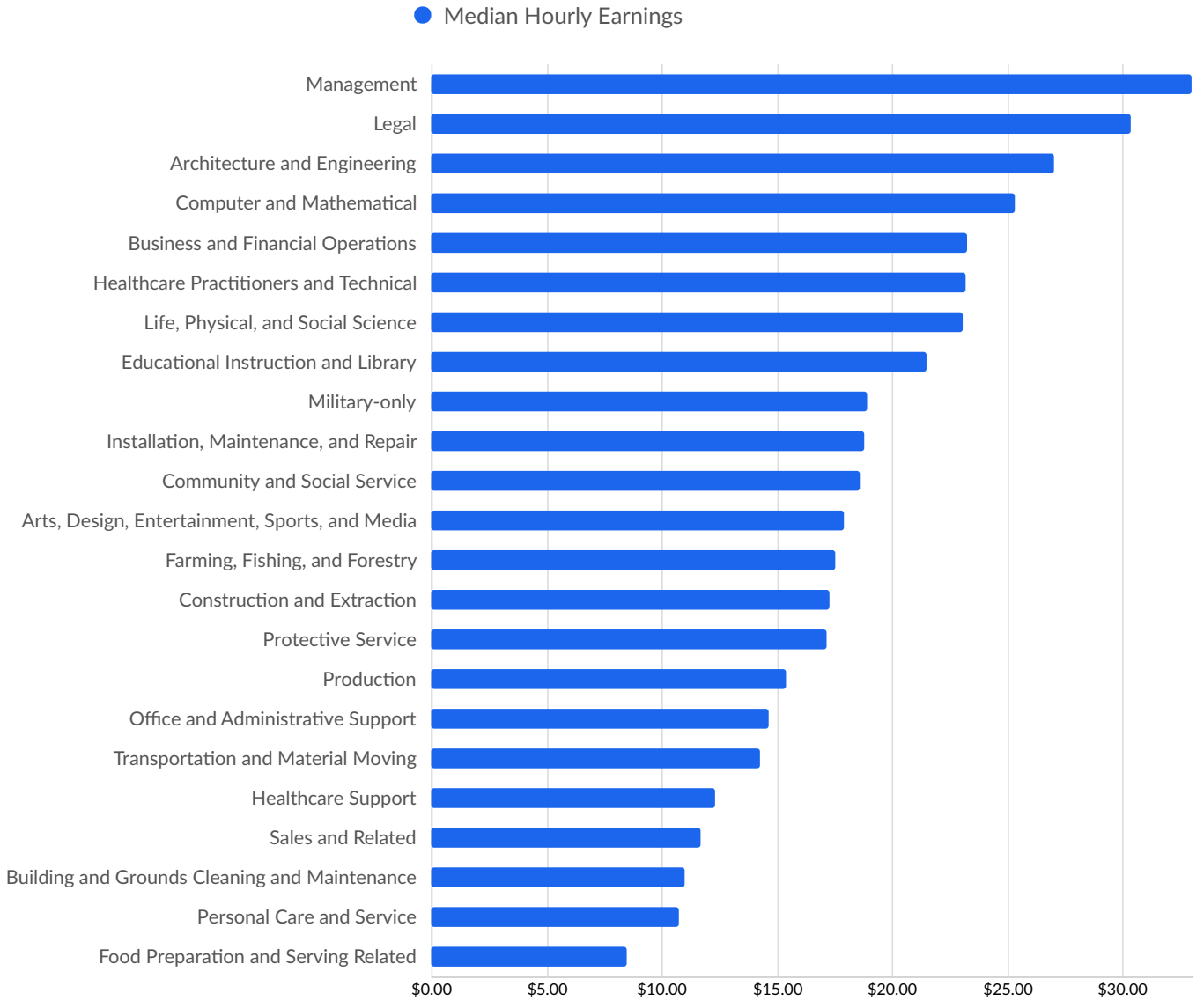
Top Growing Occupations



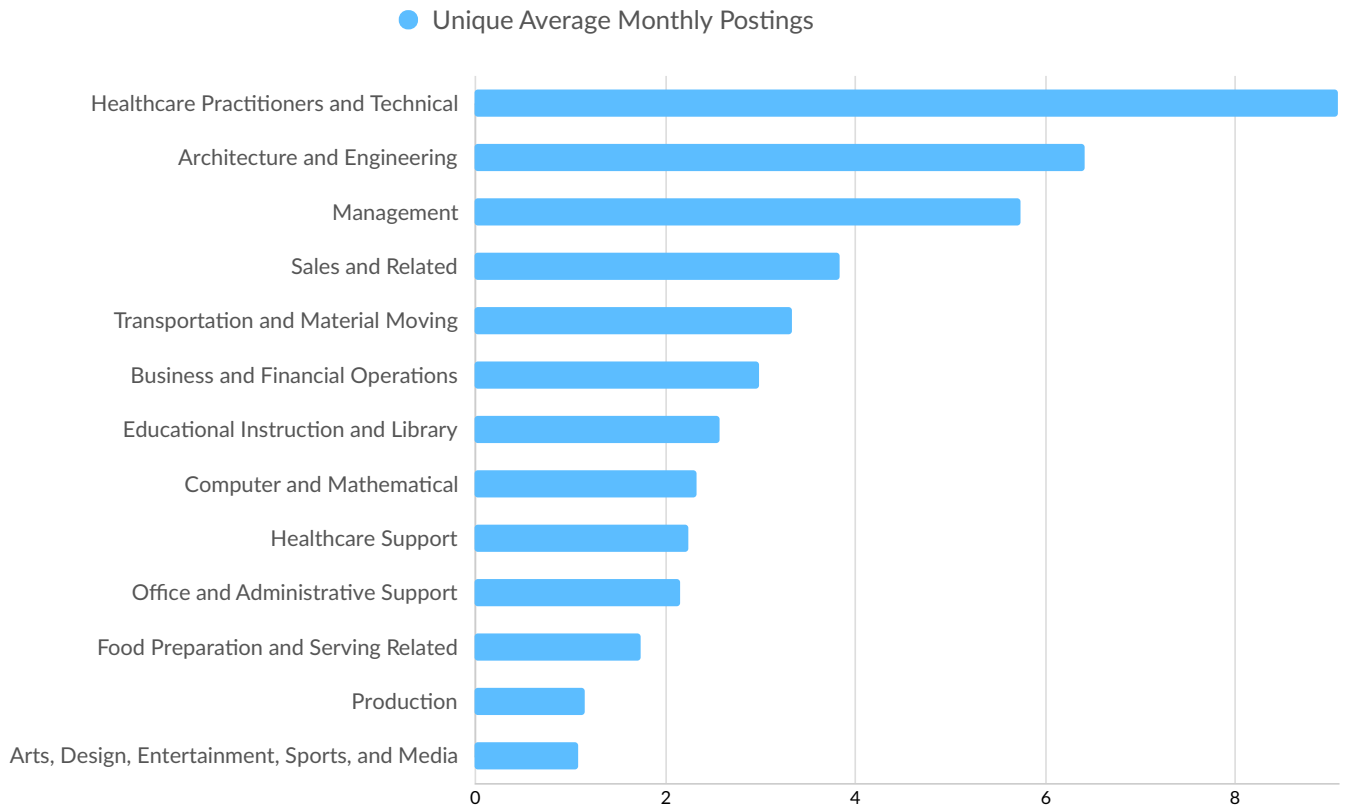
Top Occupation Location Quotient



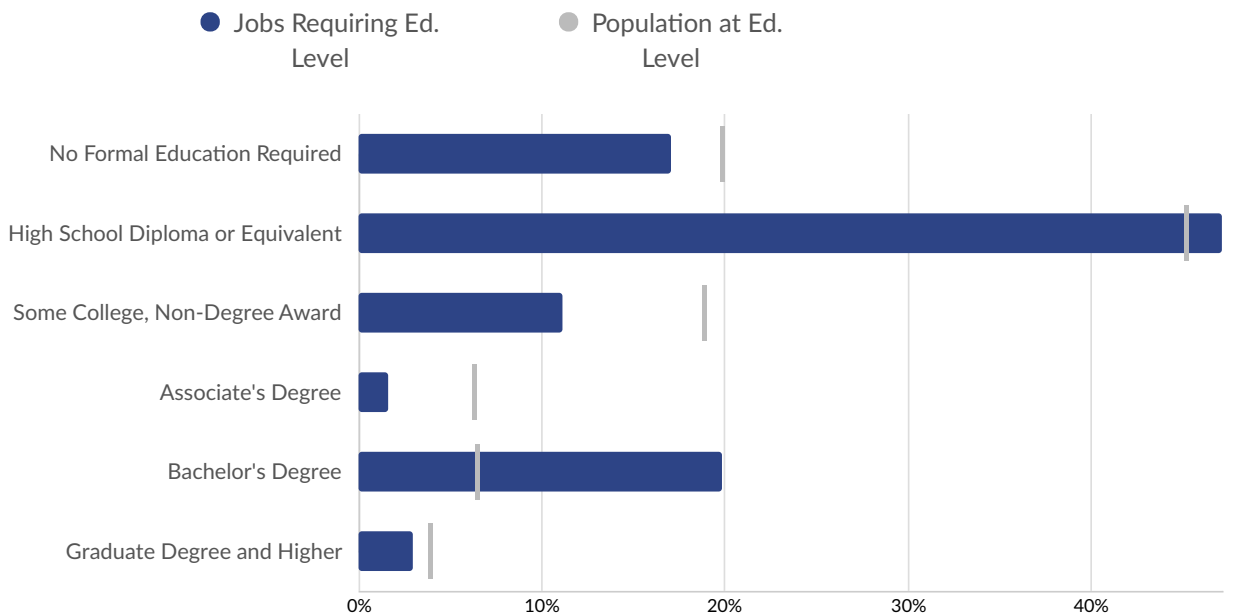
Top Occupation Earnings
