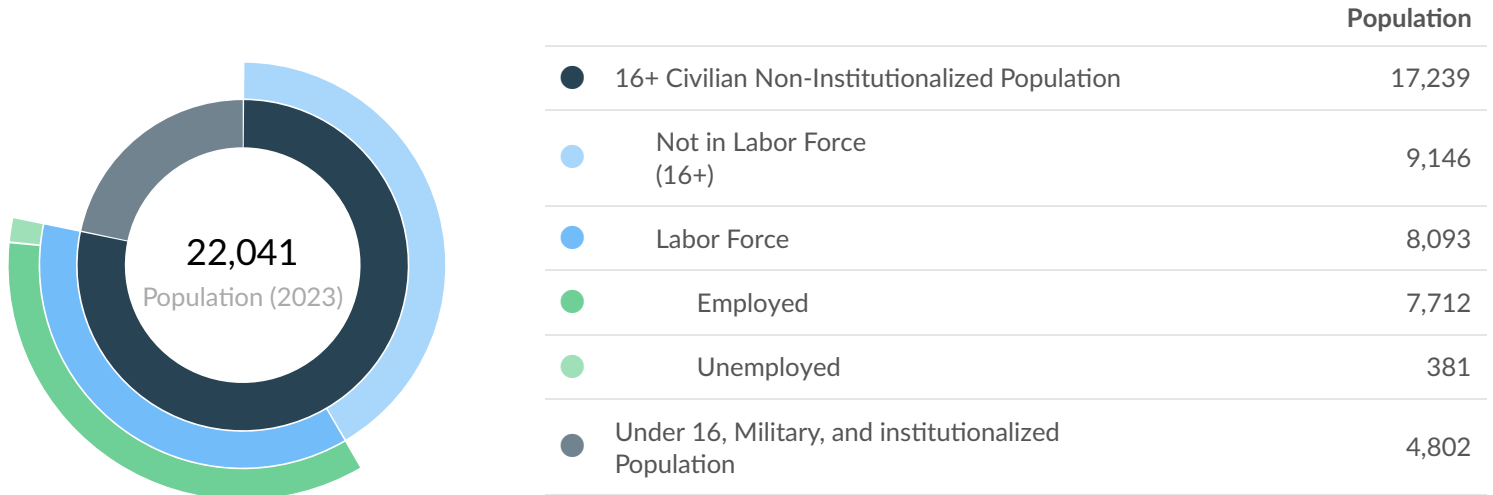
Median household income is **\$30.6K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 0.0%** since 2018, growing by 5. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.7%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 155.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **declined by 1.6%** in Scott County, TN from 6,836 to **6,729**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 5.2%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 48.6% to 46.9% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.5% of Scott County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.6% below the national average), and **6.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Rubber Product Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

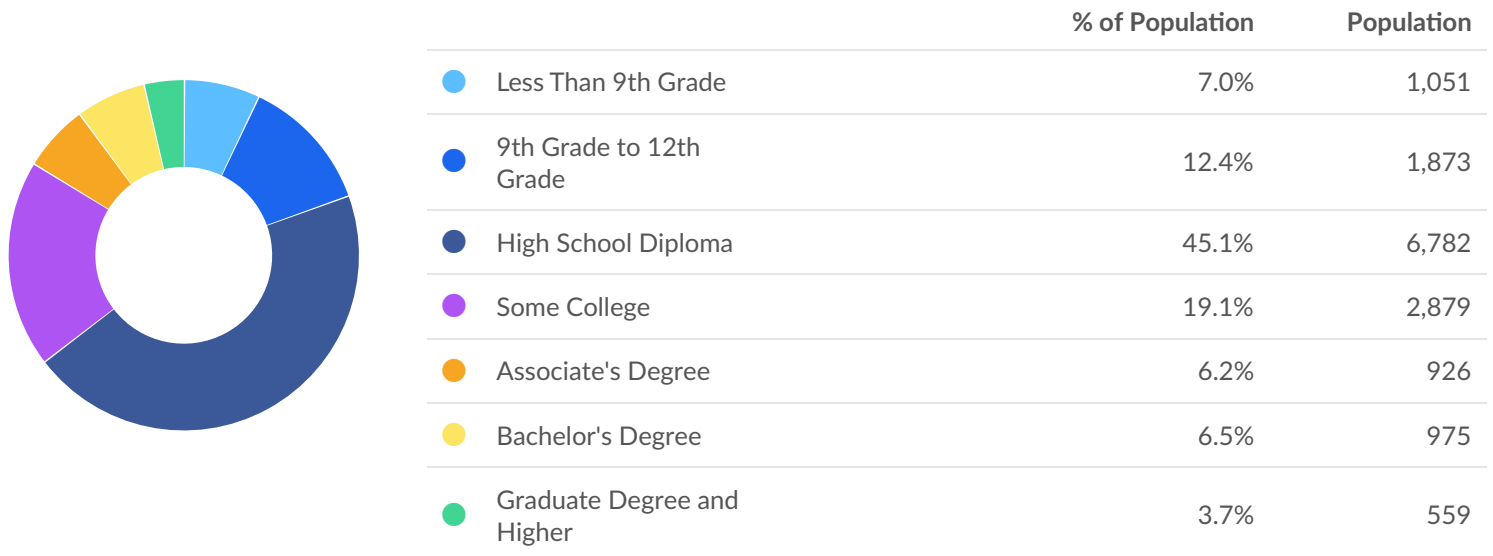

Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



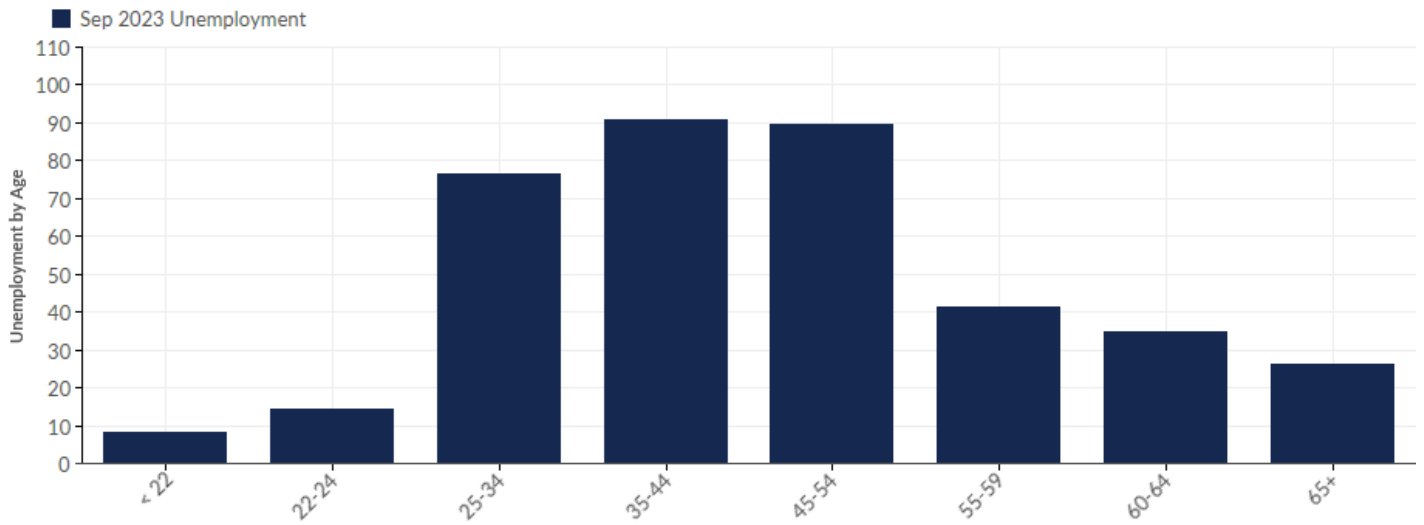
Educational Attainment

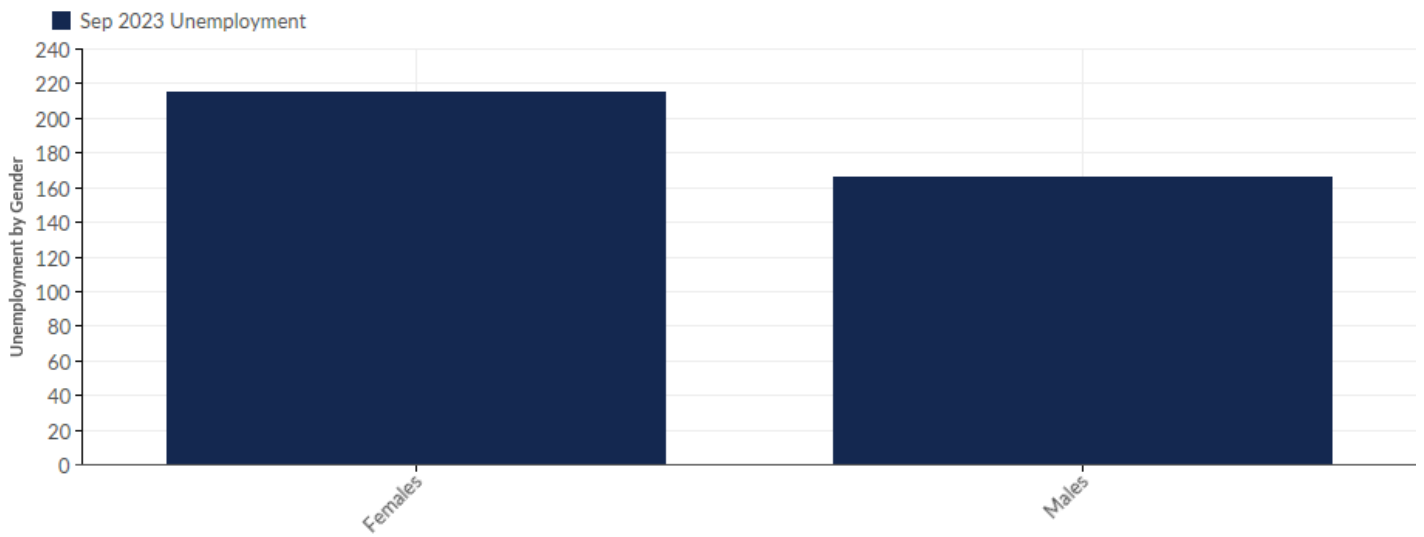

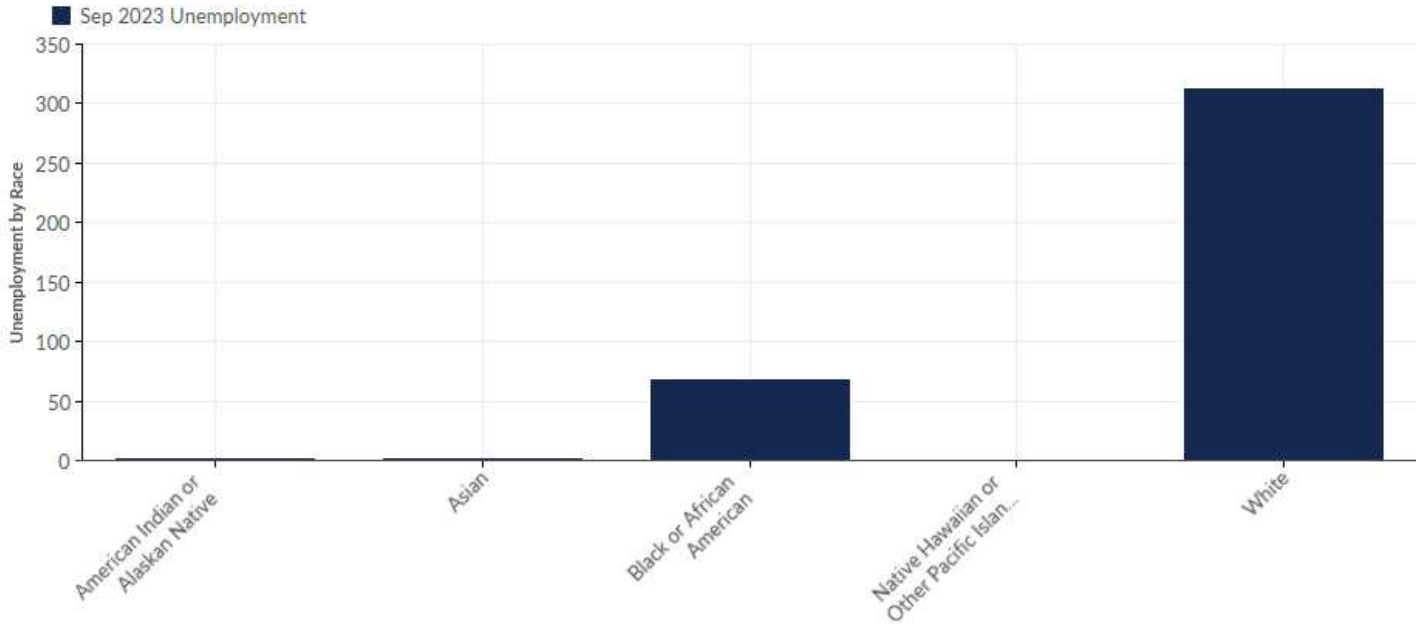

Unemployment by Gender



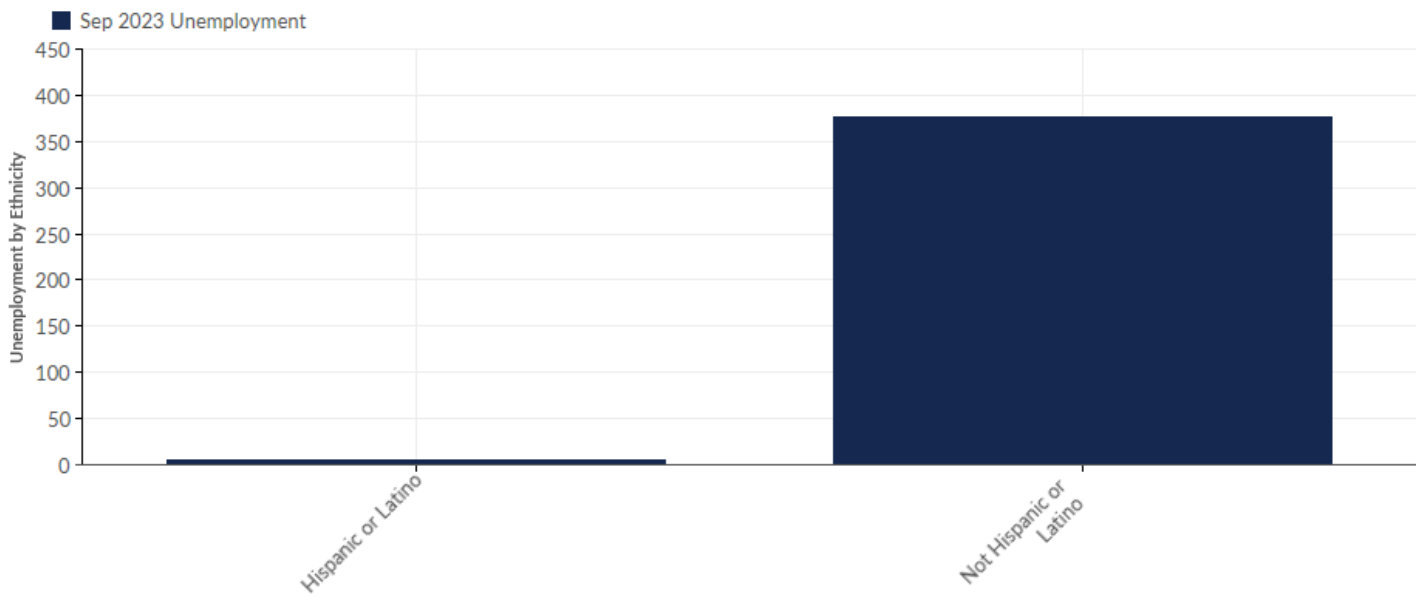

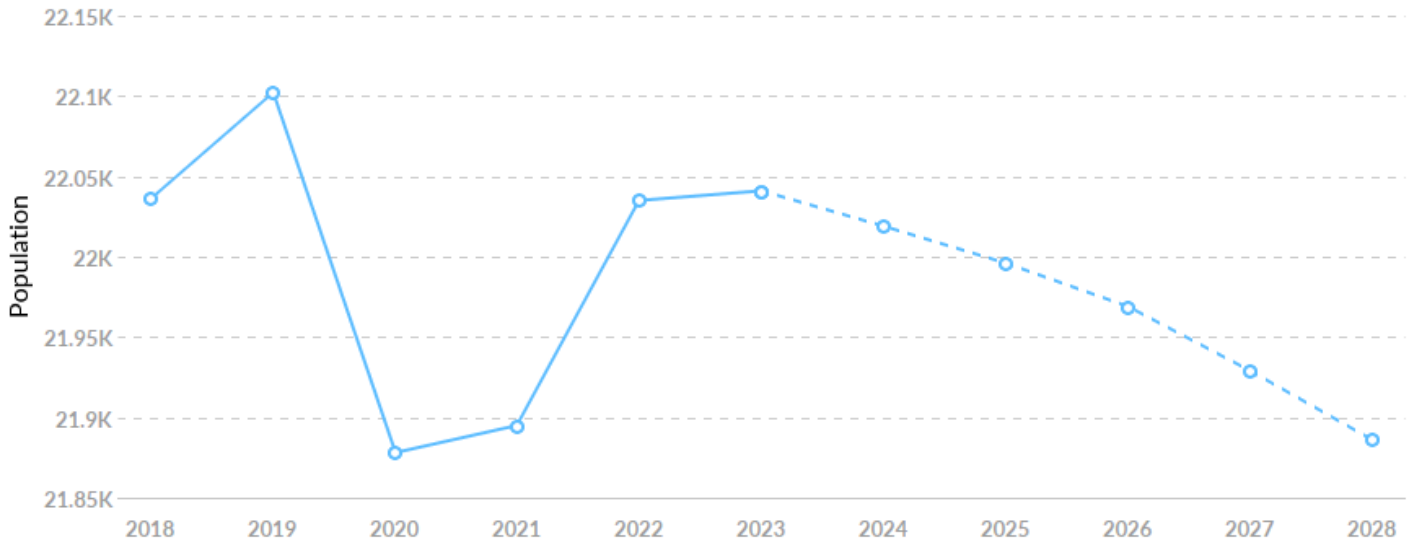

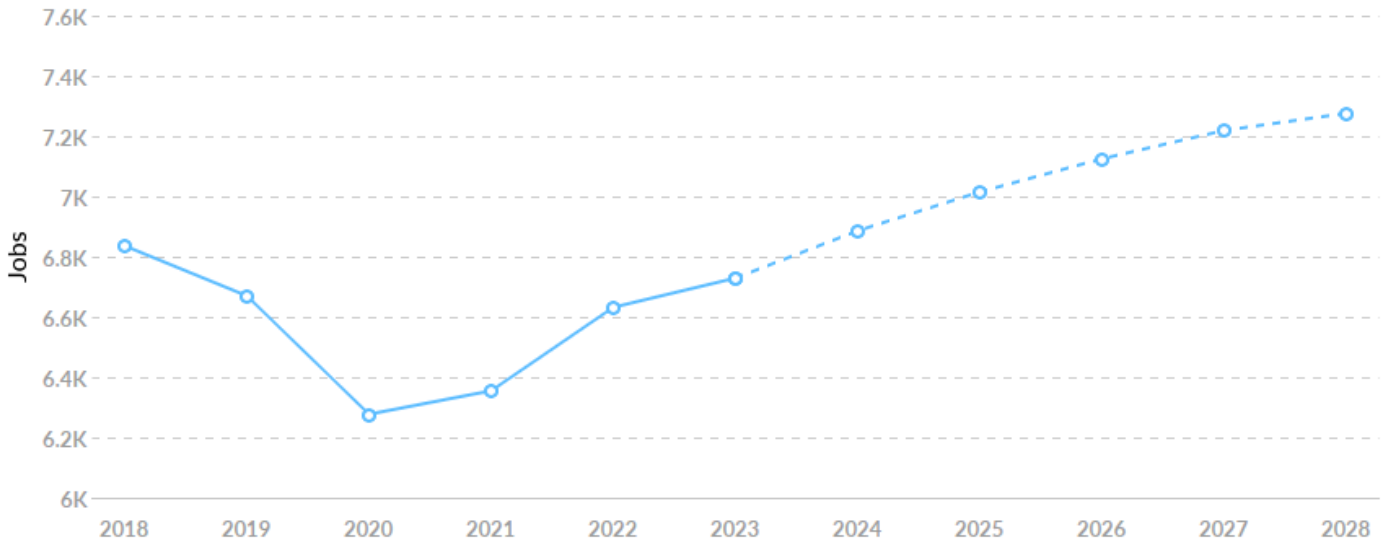

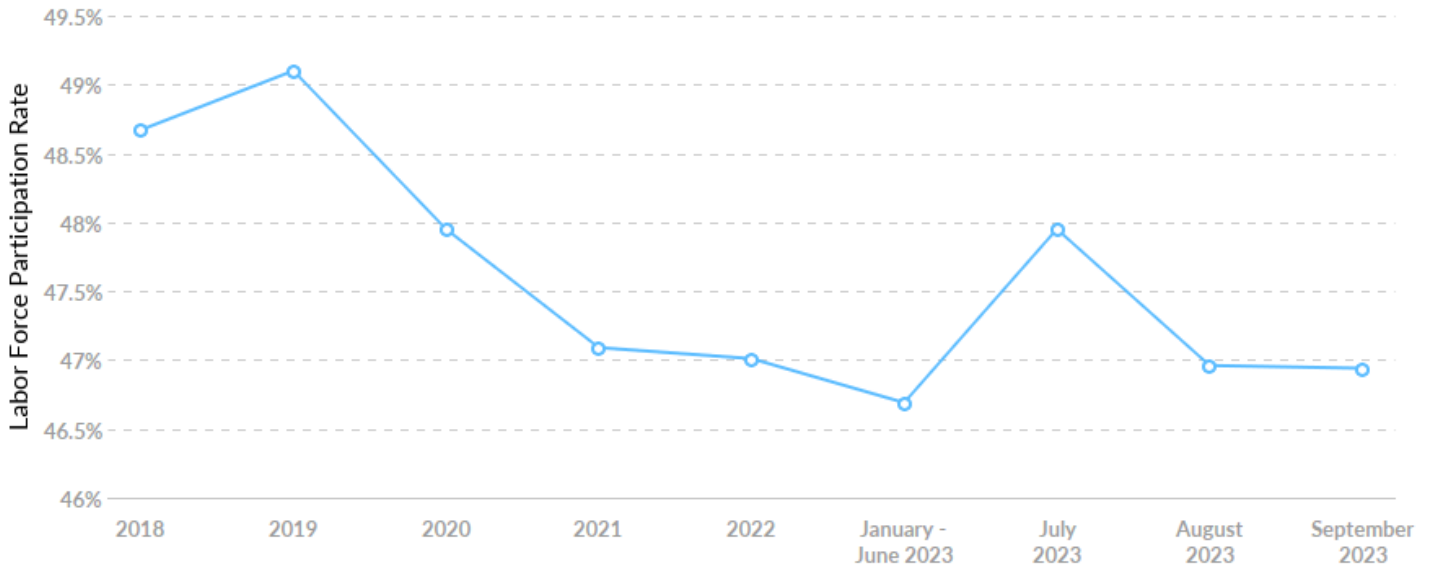
Job Trends

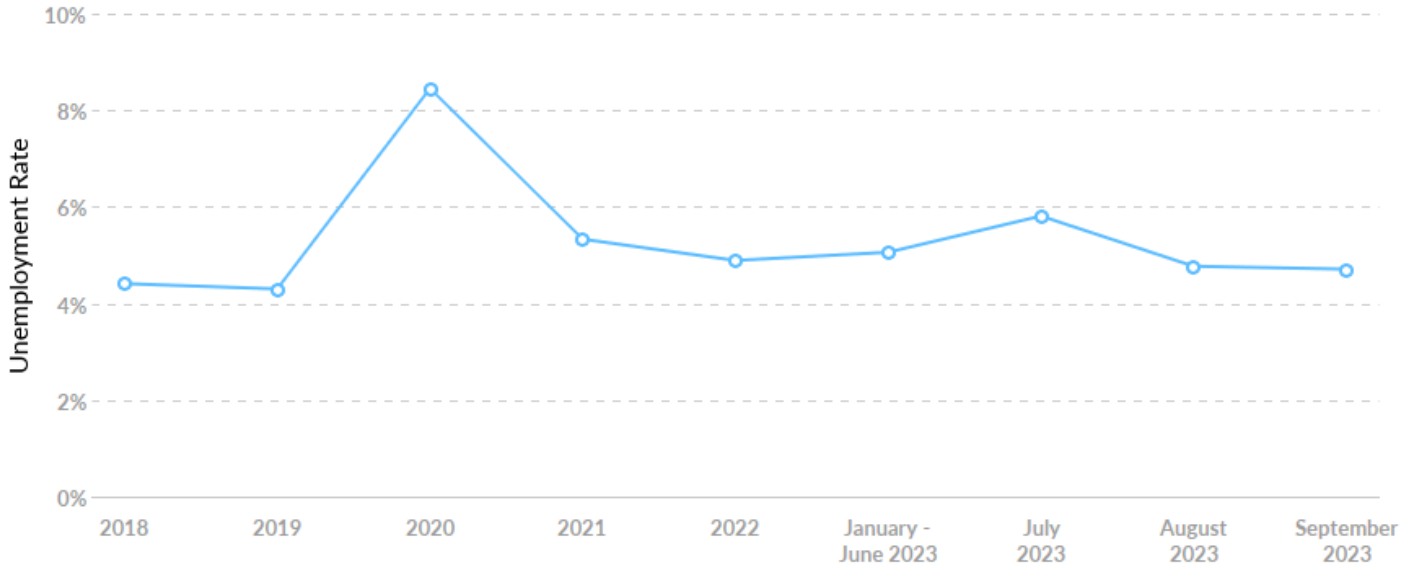

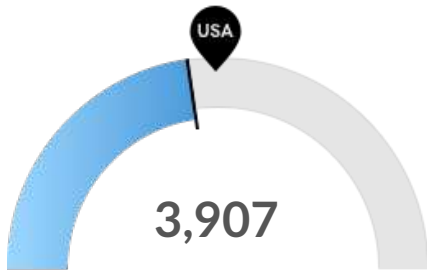
Unemployment Rate Trends

Scott County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 4.71%, **increasing from 4.41% 5 years before.**



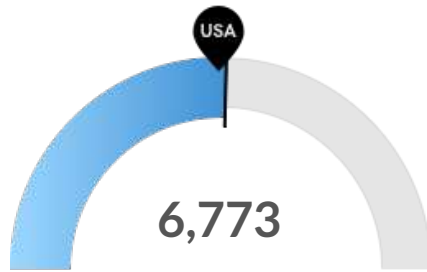

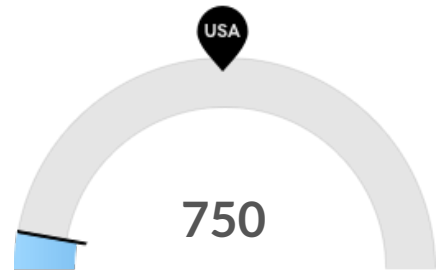
Millennials

Scott County, TN has 3,907 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,481.



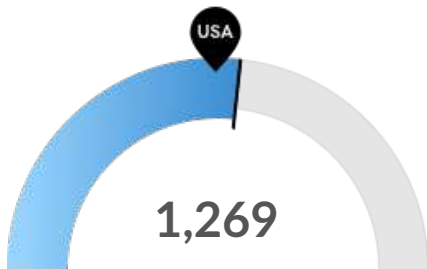
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 6,603 people 55 or older, while there are 6,773 here.



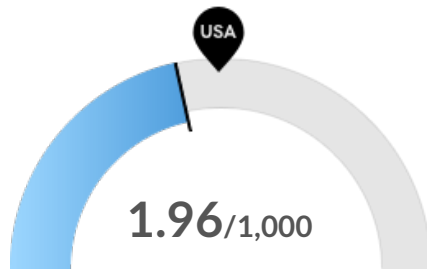
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 9,062 racially diverse people, while there are 750 here.



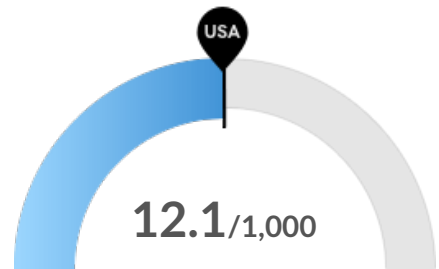
Veterans

Scott County, TN has 1.96 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.

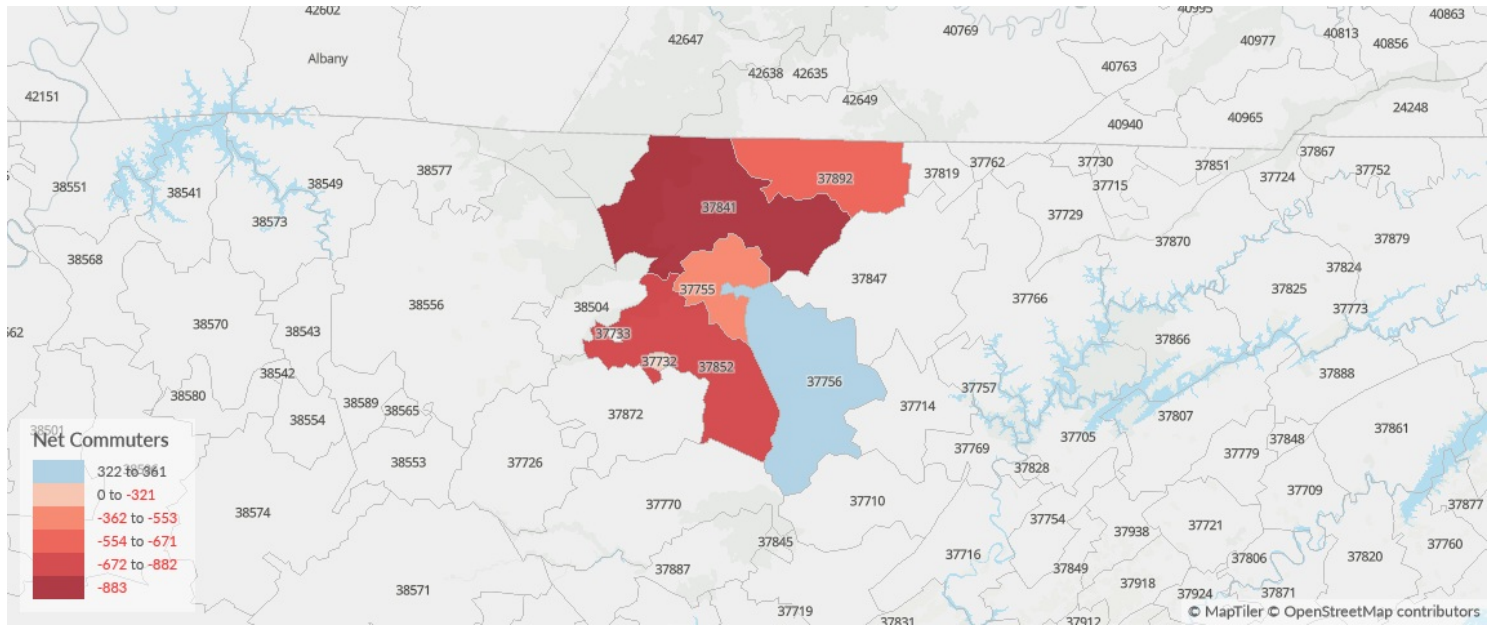


Property Crime

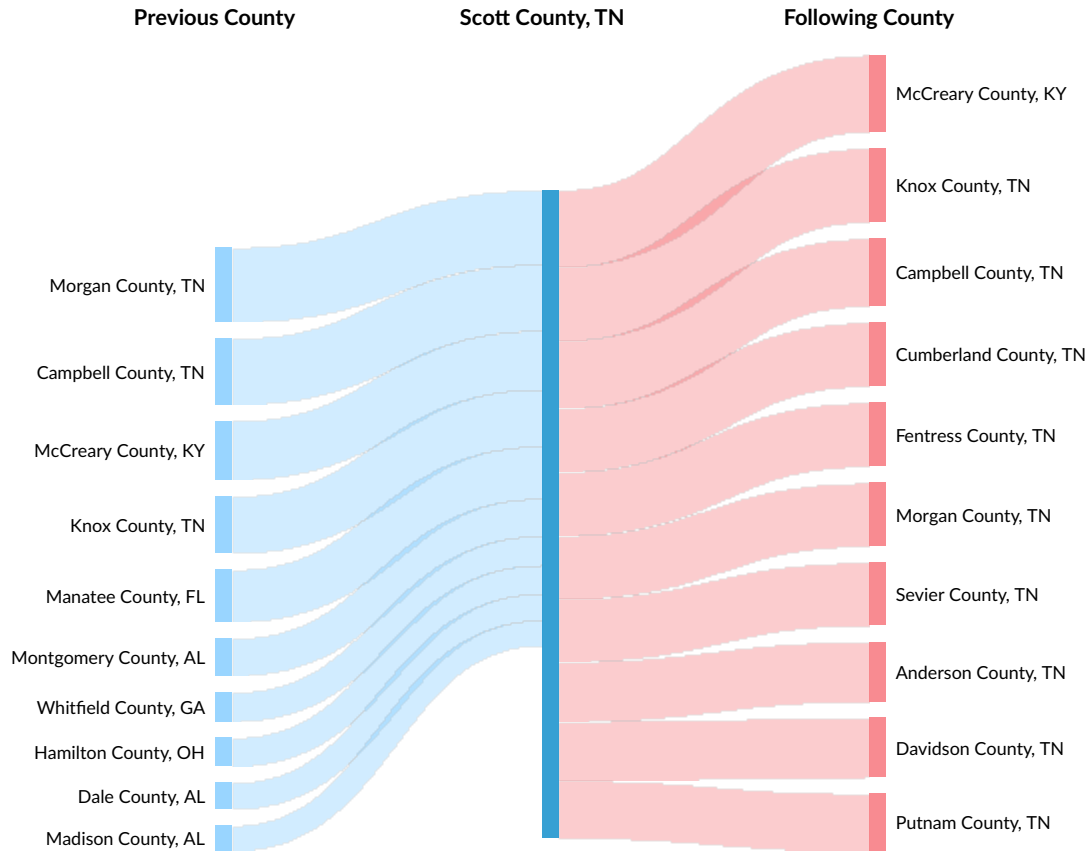

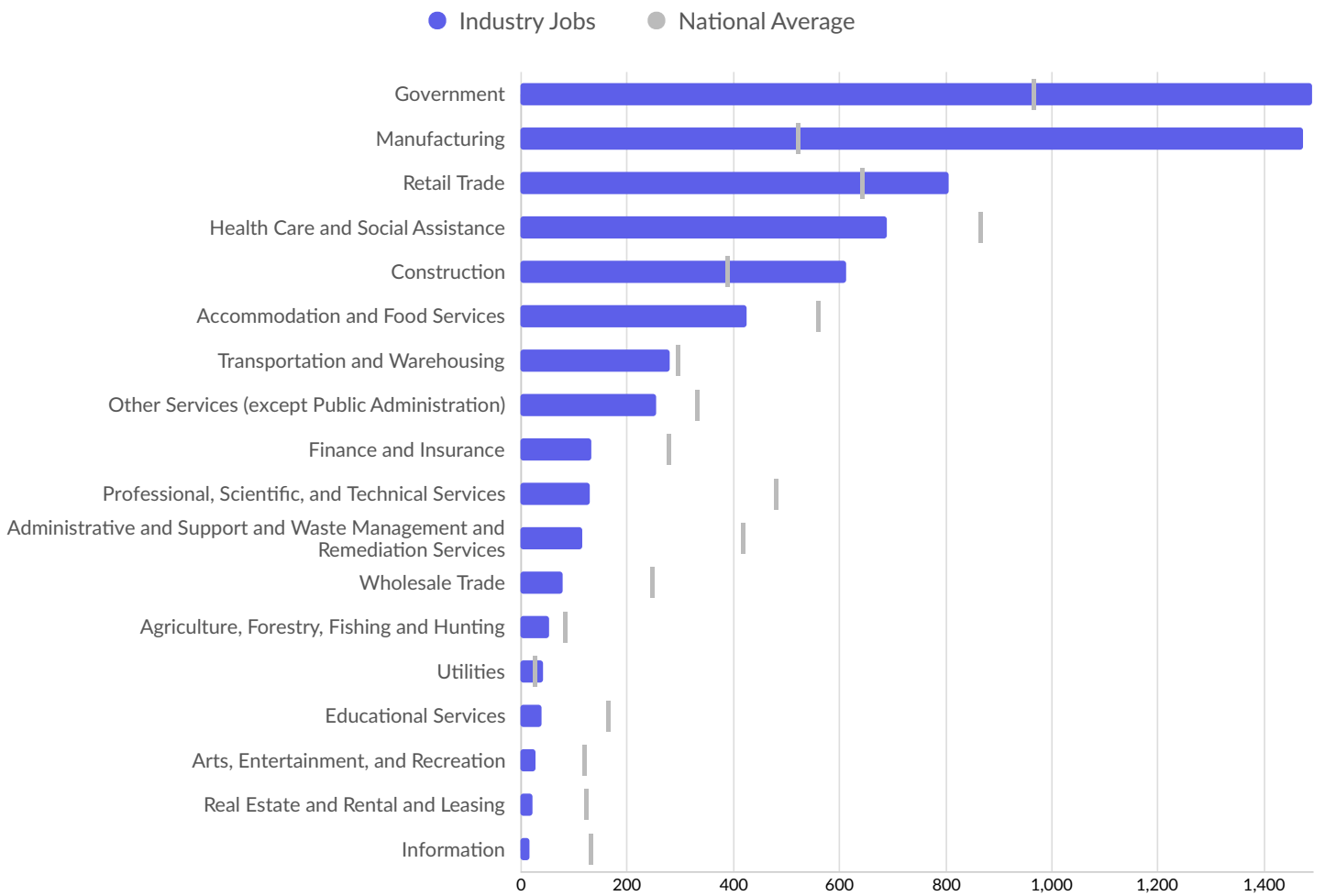

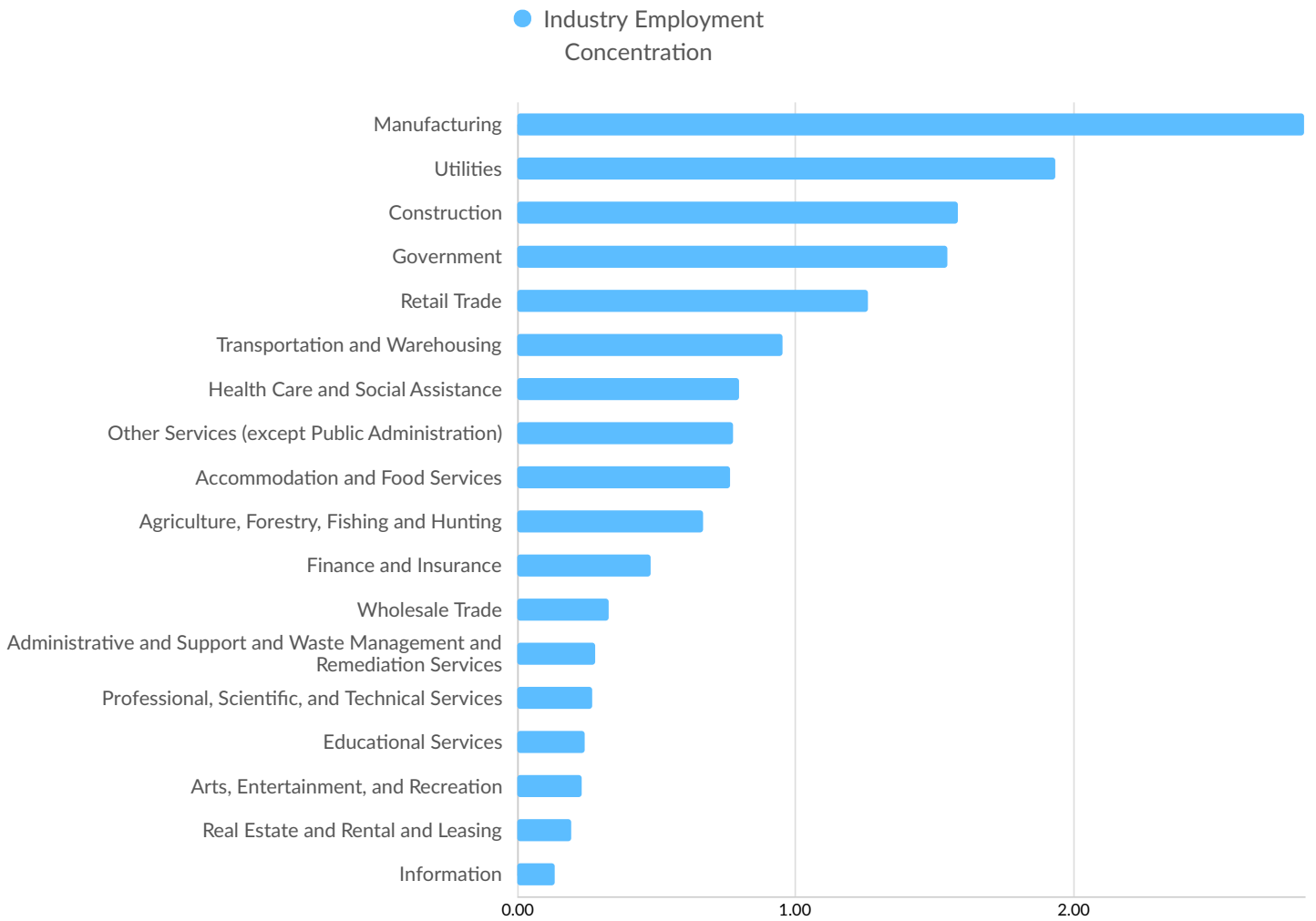

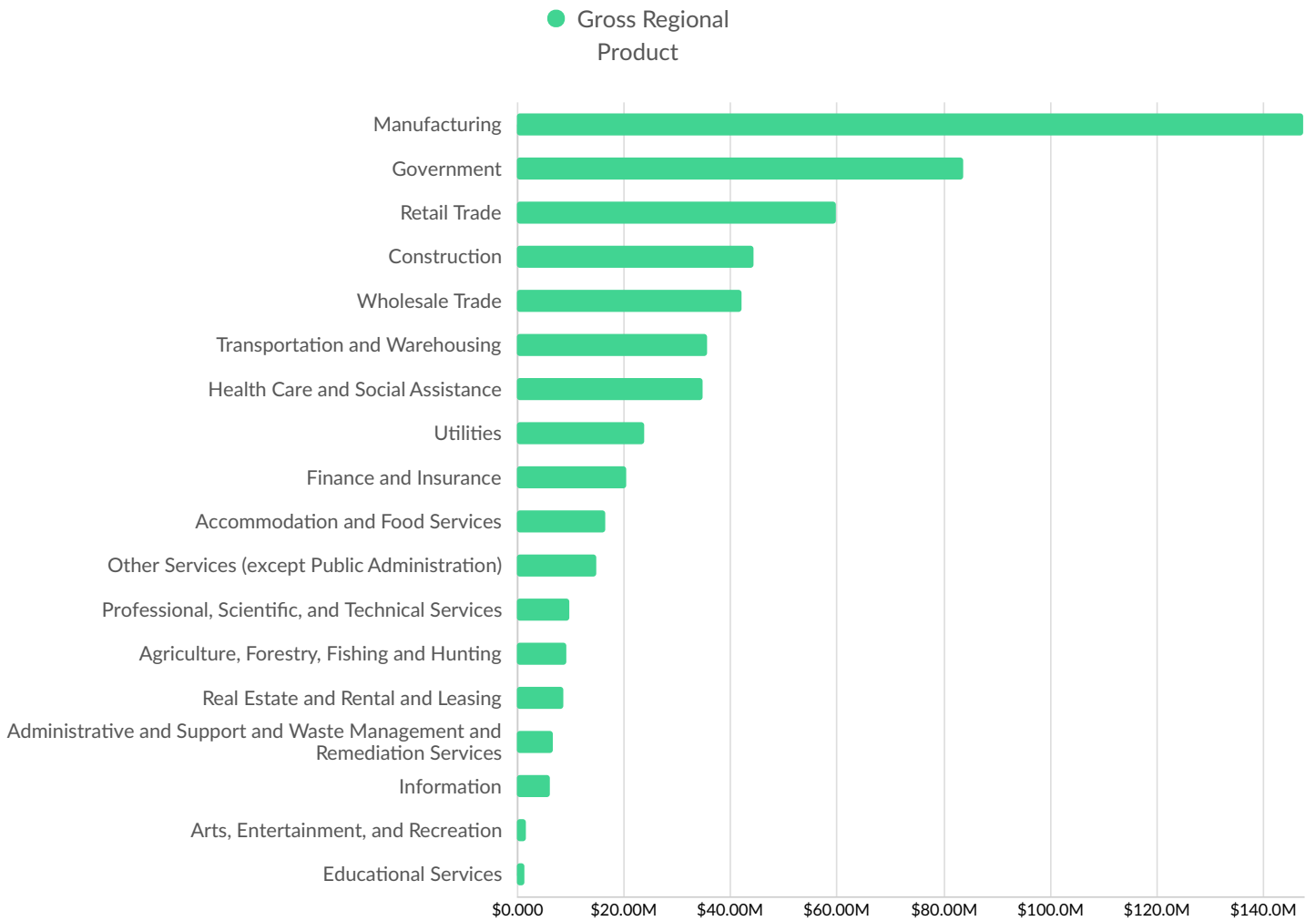
Top Growing Industries



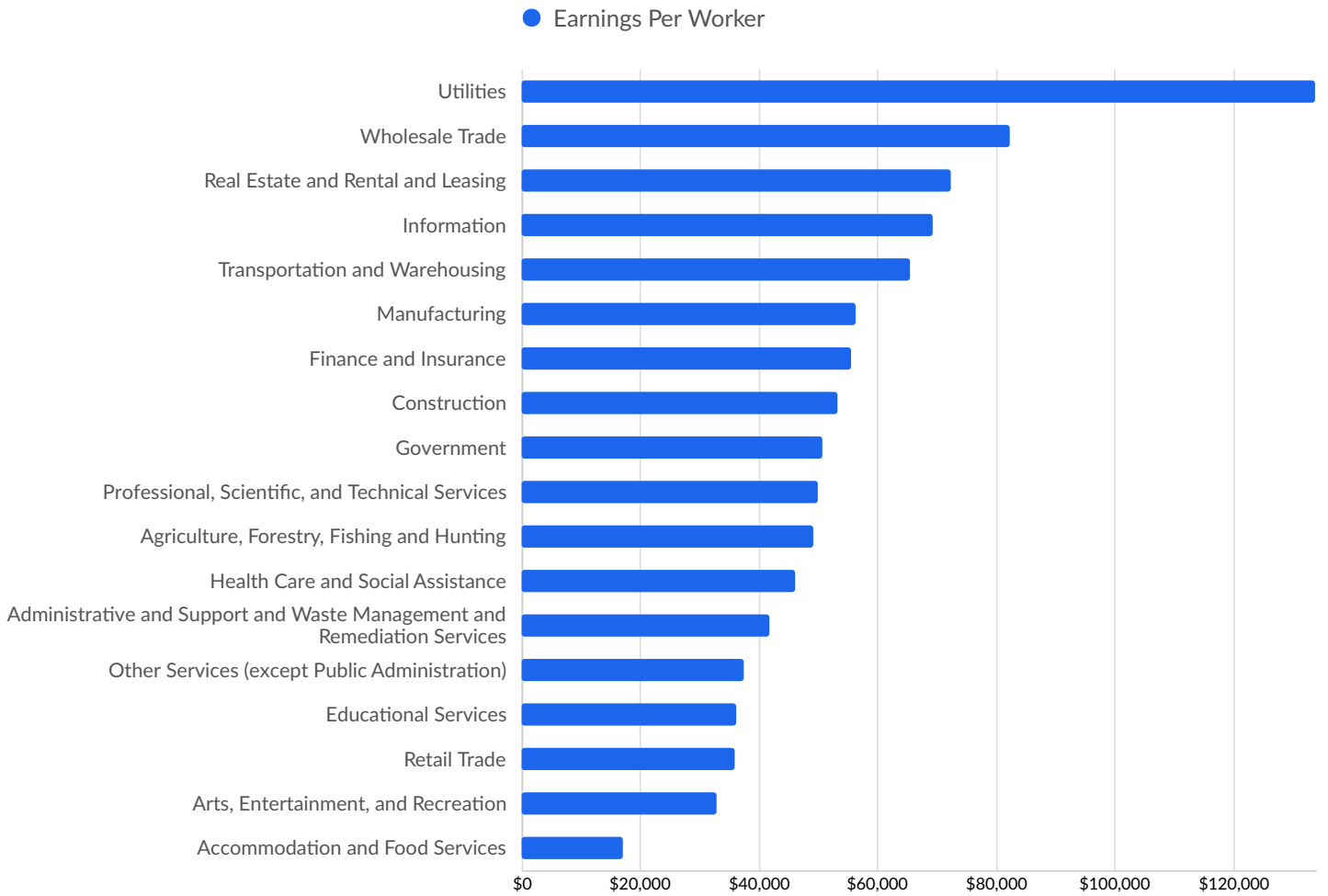
Top Industry Employment Concentration

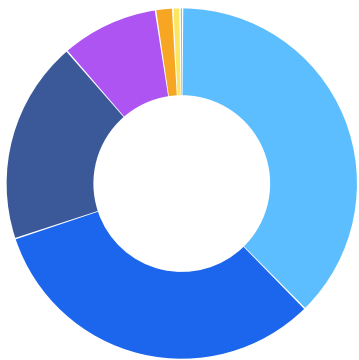

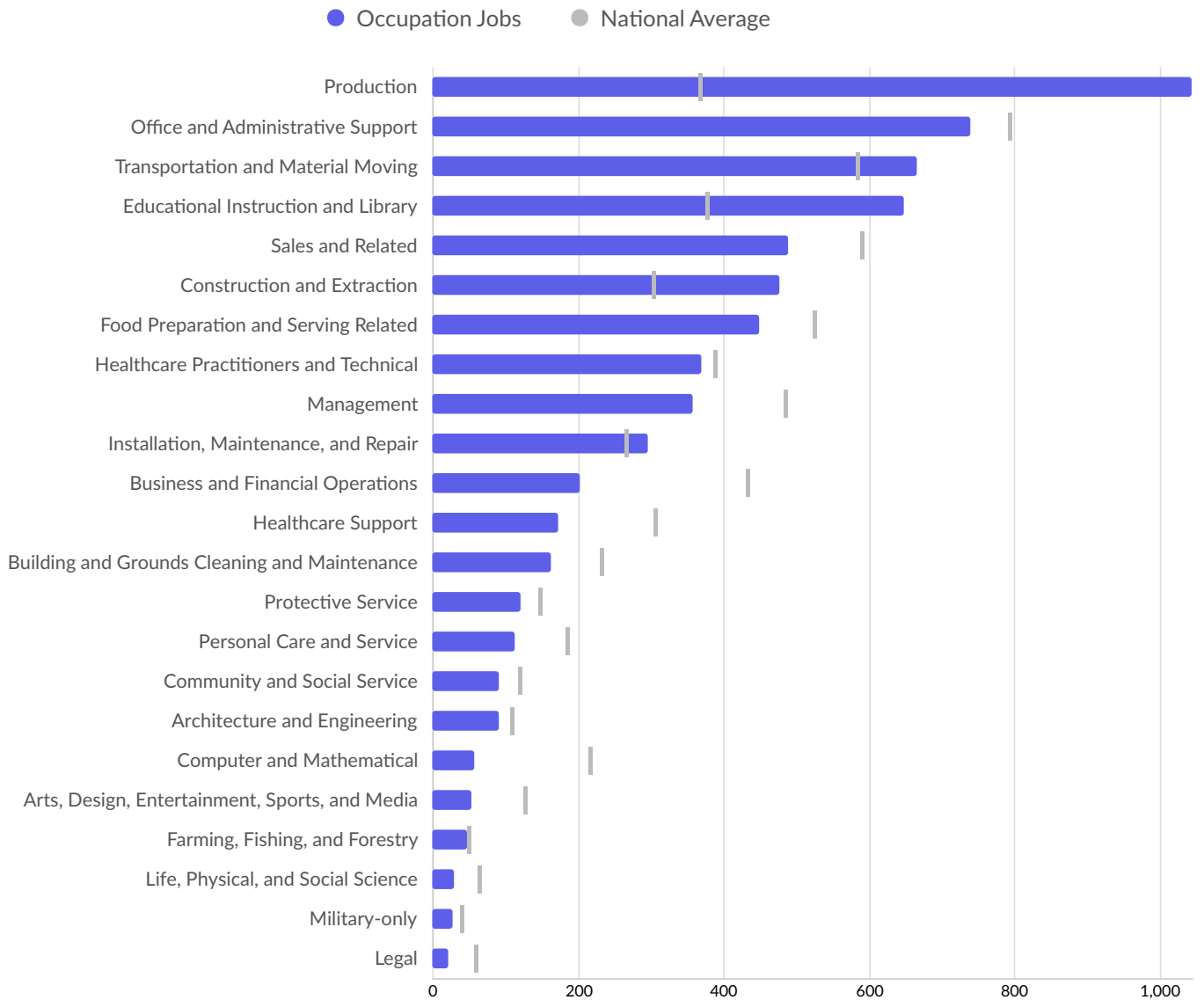

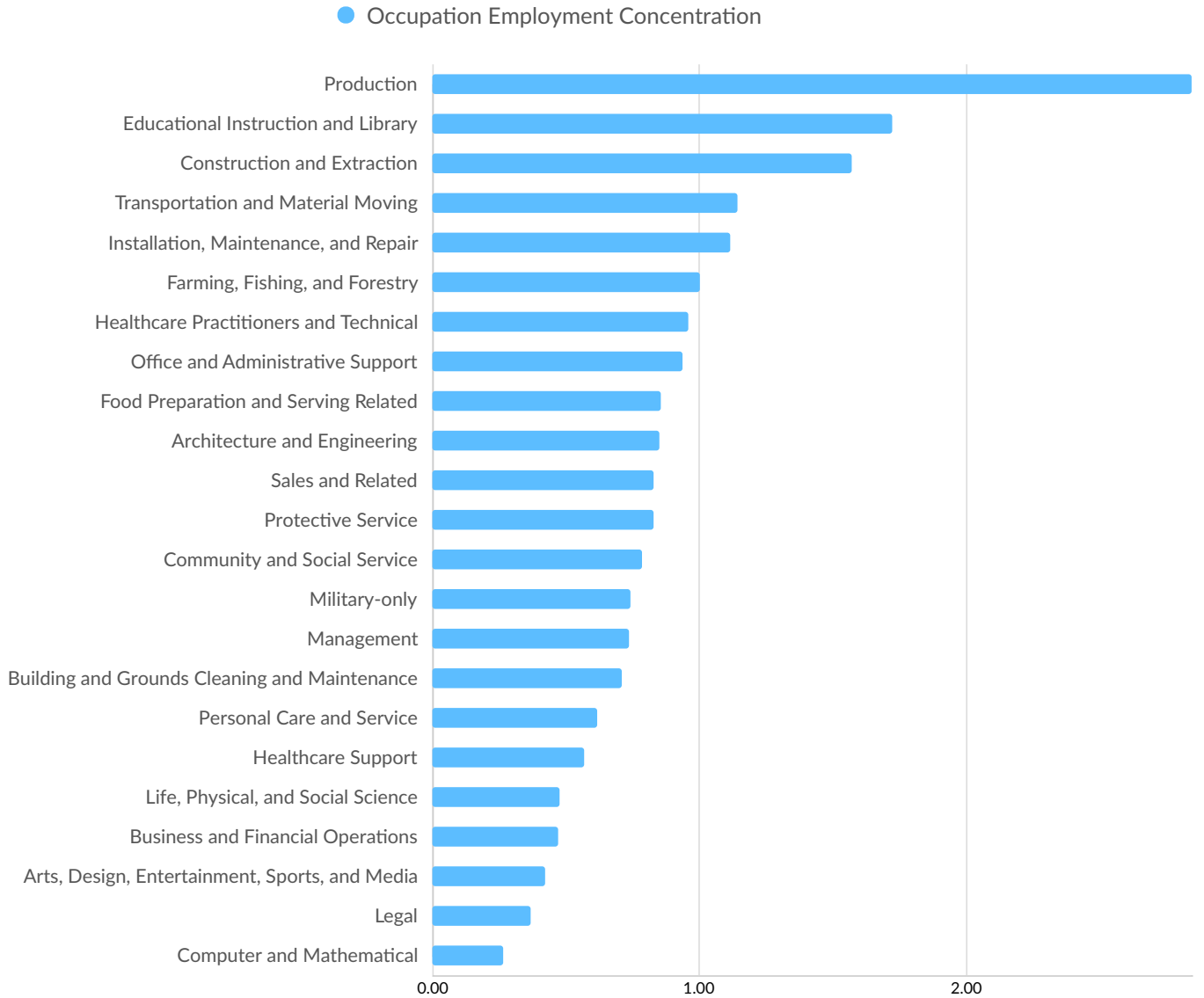

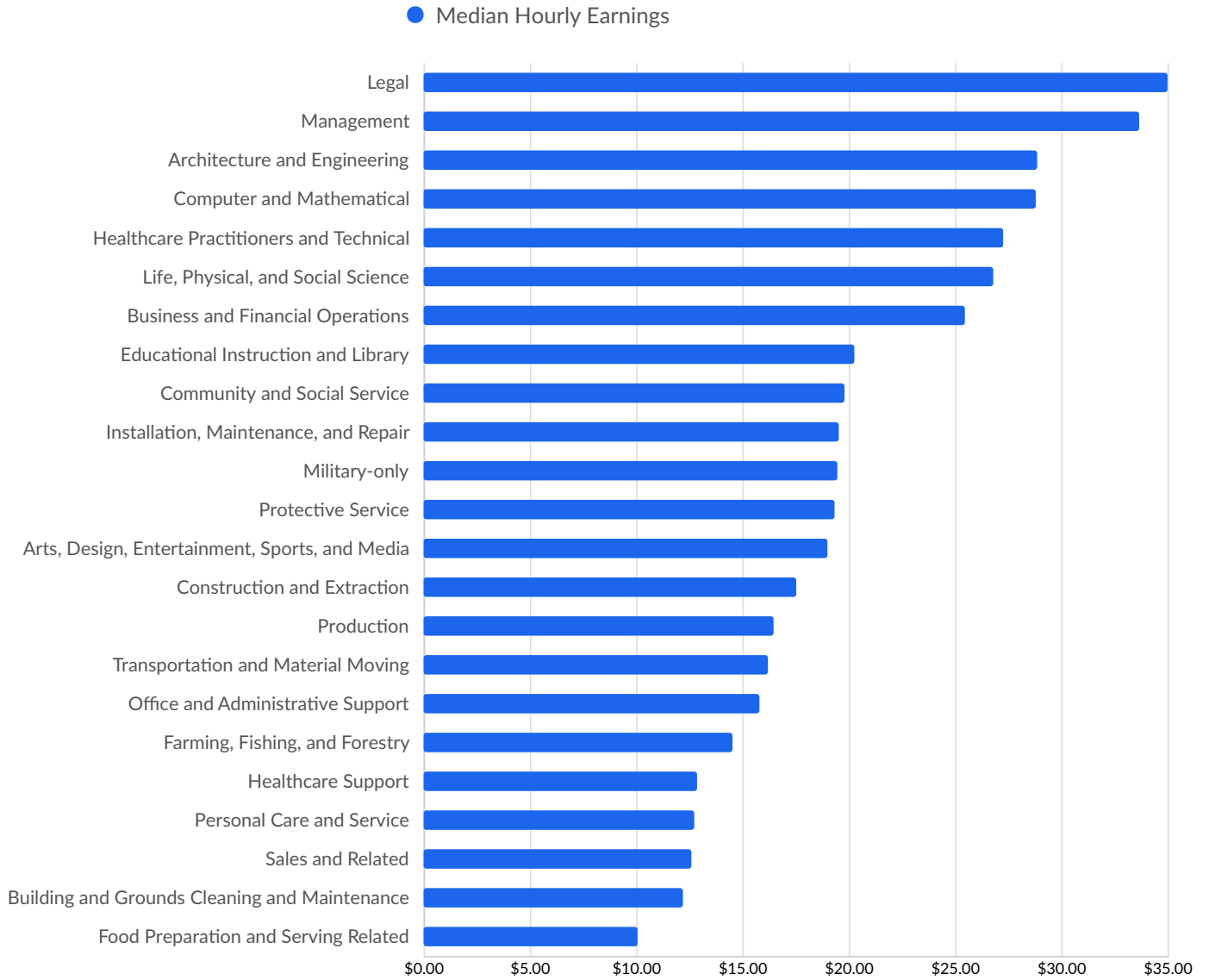
Top Growing Occupations



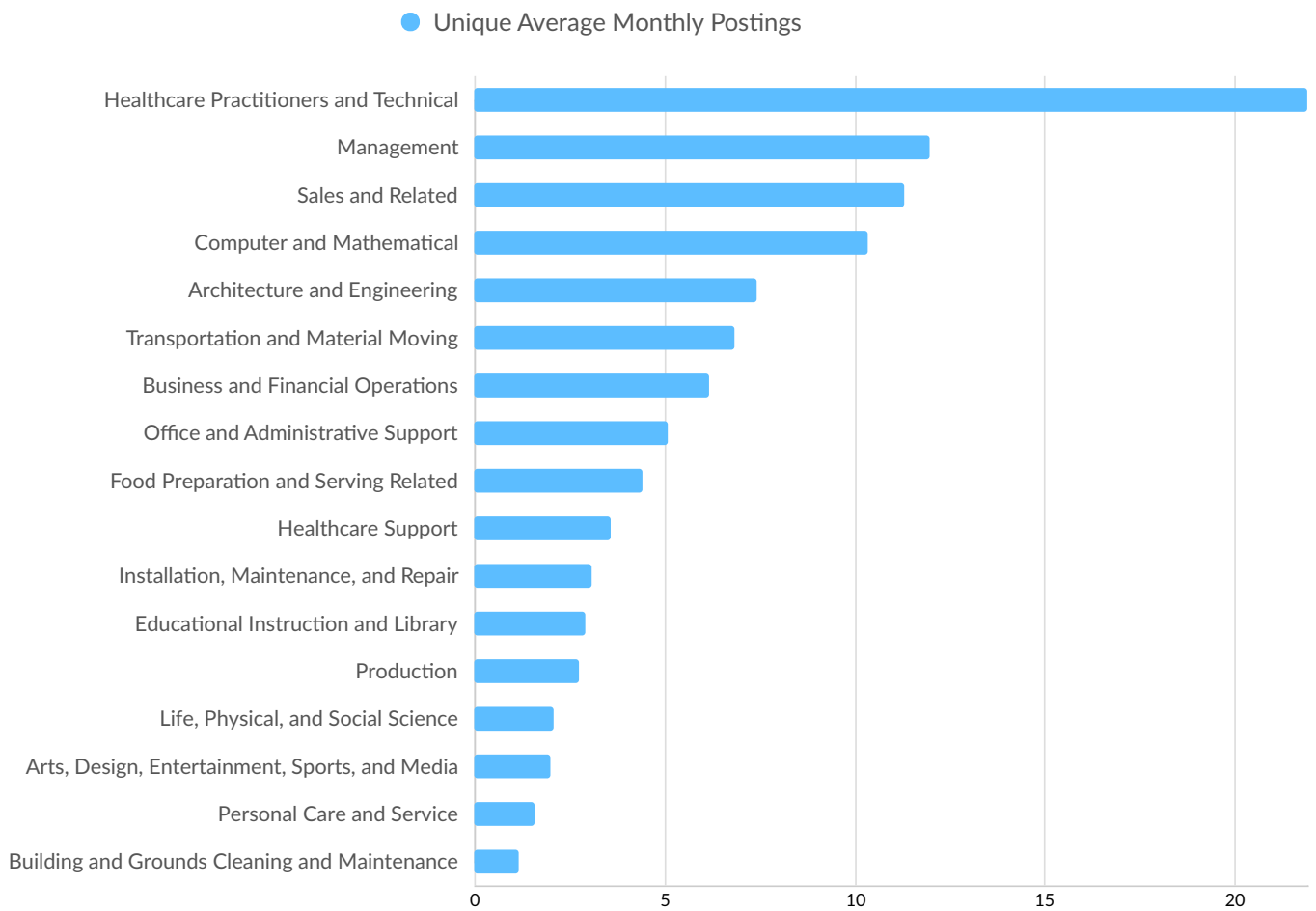
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



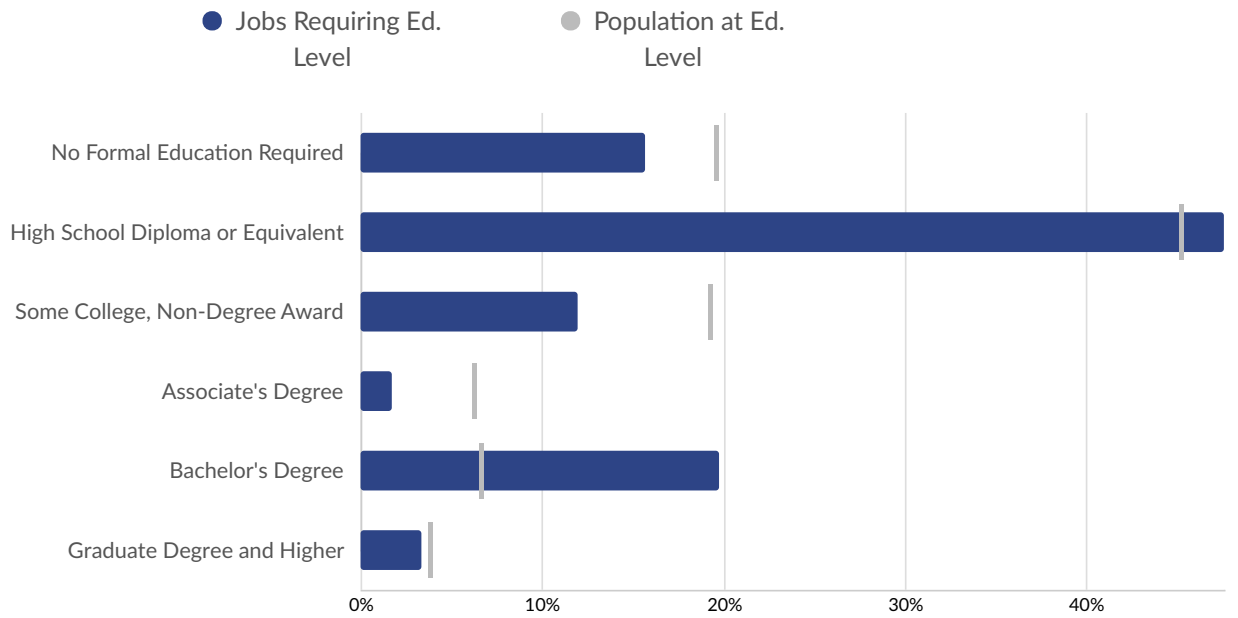
Top Occupation Earnings


