
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 0.6% since 2018, growing by 135. Population is expected to increase by 2.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 470.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.4% in Scott County, TN from 6,836 to 6,738. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 5.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.4% to 46.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 6.6% of Scott County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (14.6% below the national average), and 6.8% hold an Associate's Degree (2.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Rubber Product Manufacturing.










Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Scott County, TN had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 4.53%, increasing from 4.30% 5 years before.




Millennials

Scott County, TN has 3,967 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,505.




Veterans

Scott County, TN has 1,287 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,125.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 6,693 people 55 or older, while there are 6,846 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 9,234 racially diverse people, while there are 801 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




