- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 1.2% since 2018, growing by 1,182. Population is expected to increase by 2.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,948.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 8.1% in Sevier County, TN from 52,240 to 56,475. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 67.2% to 69.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Sevier County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.1% below the national average), and **8.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Traveler Accommodation, and Amusement Parks and Arcades.







Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends






Sevier County, TN had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.64%, **decreasing from 3.48%** 5 years before.




Millennials

Sevier County, TN has 17,514 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 20,087.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Sevier County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 29,605 people 55 or older, while there are 35,621 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Sevier County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 40,626 racially diverse people, while there are 11,741 here.




Veterans

Sevier County, TN has 3.38 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Earnings




Median Hourly Earnings
