
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.6% since 2019, growing by 348. Population is expected to increase by 2.7% between 2024 and 2029, adding 583.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 18.9% in Morgan County, TN from 3,714 to 4,416. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 14.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 52.1% to 50.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.1% of Morgan County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.4% below the national average), and **8.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Individual and Family Services.






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Morgan County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 4.59%, decreasing from 6.39% 5 years before.




Millennials

Morgan County, TN has 4,314 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,383.




Veterans

Morgan County, TN has 1,355 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,067.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Morgan County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 6,512 people 55 or older, while there are 7,063 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Morgan County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 8,985 racially diverse people, while there are 1,733 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration









