- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 0.9%** since 2019, growing by 193. Population is expected to **increase by 1.6%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 363.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 1.9%** in Scott County, TN from 6,674 to **6,804**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 53.1% to 50.1% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.2% of Scott County, TN residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (15.3% below the national average), and **6.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



Jun 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity






Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Scott County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 5.06%, **decreasing from 7.89%** 5 years before.






Millennials

Scott County, TN has 3,967 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,505.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 6,693 people 55 or older, while there are 6,846 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Scott County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 9,234 racially diverse people, while there are 801 here.




Veterans

Scott County, TN has 2.75 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




