- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Traveler Accommodation, and Amusement Parks and Arcades.




#### Jun 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



#### **Educational Attainment**













### **Job Trends**






Sevier County, TN had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 3.16%, decreasing from 10.49% 5 years before.


#### Millennials

Sevier County, TN has 17,713 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 20,199.




#### **Veterans**

Sevier County, TN has 7,120 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4,918.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Sevier County, TN. The national average for an area this size is 30,011 people 55 or older, while there are 35,415 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

#### **Property Crime**


Sevier County, TN has 16.13 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.02 per 1,000 people.






## **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








